Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

God Is Our King

Craft Description

The children will make a crown out of a paper plate and decorate it.

Materials

Sturdy paper plate with rim, one per child Copy paper Markers, colored pencils, crayons Cotton balls, glitter glue, stick-on jewels, and/or buttons Glue

Preparations

- 1. Fold plate in half.
- 2. Mark and cut along lines as shown in the diagram on next page.
- 3. Unfold plate. Fold up points to crown.
- 4. Write words "God Is Our King" on the front brim of each crown.
- 5. Set out glue on paper plates (or glue sticks).

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "What is the gospel?" We've learned that "It's salvation through faith in Jesus Christ...God made us and we should obey Him!" That's something very good to know. But many people don't know that. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like...(Hold up example of craft)

Directions

- 1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
- 2. Have children do any decorating with markers/crayons/colored pencils first.
- 3. Let them add the glue-related extra bits sticky jewels, cotton balls, glitter glue, etc on last. Let dry.
- 4. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.


Discussion

This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.


Craft Wrap-Up:


Appendix C: Crafts and Take Home Sheets, Unit 3, Bible Truth 1: Extra Crafts



1. Fold plate in half



2. Make cuts as shown, making sure not to cut through the plate entirely, just to the rim.



3. Unfold plate. Fold up triangles to make points on crown. Decorate rim and crown points. Add words.
