Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

There Is No Sin in God: He is Perfectly Holy Purely Good Sign

Craft Description

The children will decorate a two-sided sign that reminds them that God is holy and has no sin.

Materials White Cardstock Yellow crayons/markers...enough for every child to use them at the same time

Any other color crayons, markers

Golden glitter and glue/glitter glue

Preparations

1. Print out the two sides of the sign as a double-sided sign. Cut out sign. Cut out two cross pieces of the "X." 2. Set out glue sticks and crayons/markers and glitter glue.

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "Can Anyone Tell Me What the LORD is Like? We've learned that "He's Not Like Anyone Else... He is Perfectly Holy, Purely Good." That's something very good to know. But many people don't know that. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like...(Hold up example of craft)

Directions

1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.

- 2. Have the children color in the two signs.
- 3. Have the children glue the cross pieces of the "X" over the word "sin."
- 4. Have the children add glitter on the "God is Holy" side of the sign.
- 5. The children can twirl the sign to show them what both sides say about the LORD.


Discussion

This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See the Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.


Craft Wrap-Up:
