
Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

God Is Always Faithful to His People, Day and Night

Craft Description

The children will create a card with a flap that flips up to remind them that God is always faithful, all day and all night.

Materials

Cardstock/Paper

Crayons/Markers

Clear, strong tape (such as packing tape)

Optional: Sticky stars, glitter glue or other fun decorating supplies

Preparations

1. Make copies of the card and of the flap portion.
2. Cut out the flap portion.
3. Set out crayons/markers, paper.
4. Make a sample copy of the craft.

Introducing the Craft:

“Our Big Question is: ‘Can Anybody Tell Me What the LORD Is Like?’ We’ve learned that He’s Not Like Anyone Else... He Is Always Faithful, through and through.” That’s something very good to know. But many people don’t know it! So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. Today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here’s what it looks like...” (Hold up example of craft)

Directions

1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
2. Have children color in the sun on the flap piece and the moon and stars on the main card.
3. If desired, add sticky stars, glitter glue or other decorating supplies to the pictures.
4. Tape the flap piece with the sun on it along the line right above the moon and stars on the main card so that the moon and stars (and words) are hidden.
5. Make sure to write each child’s name on their craft.

Discussion

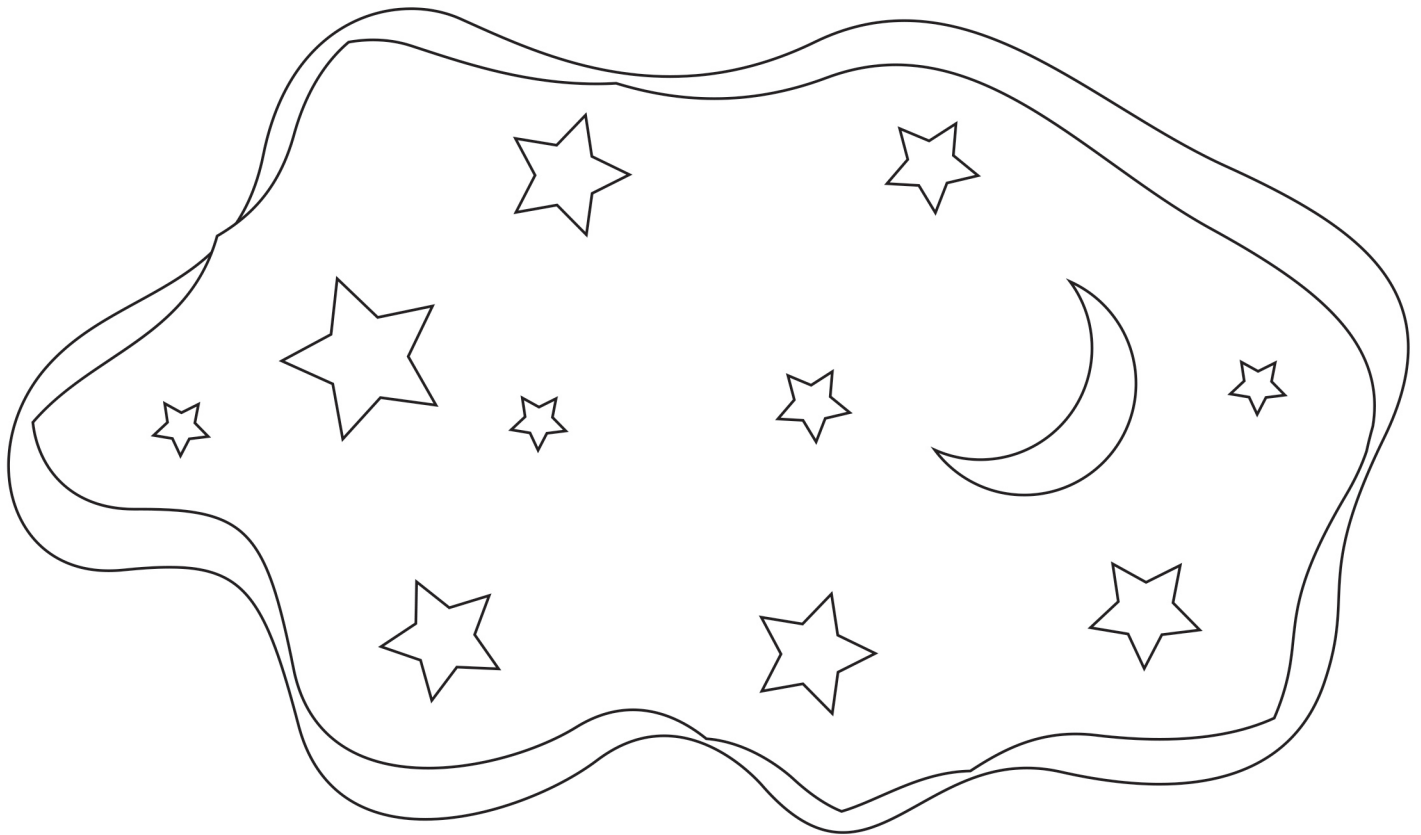
This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them as the children work on their craft. See Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.

Craft Wrap Up:

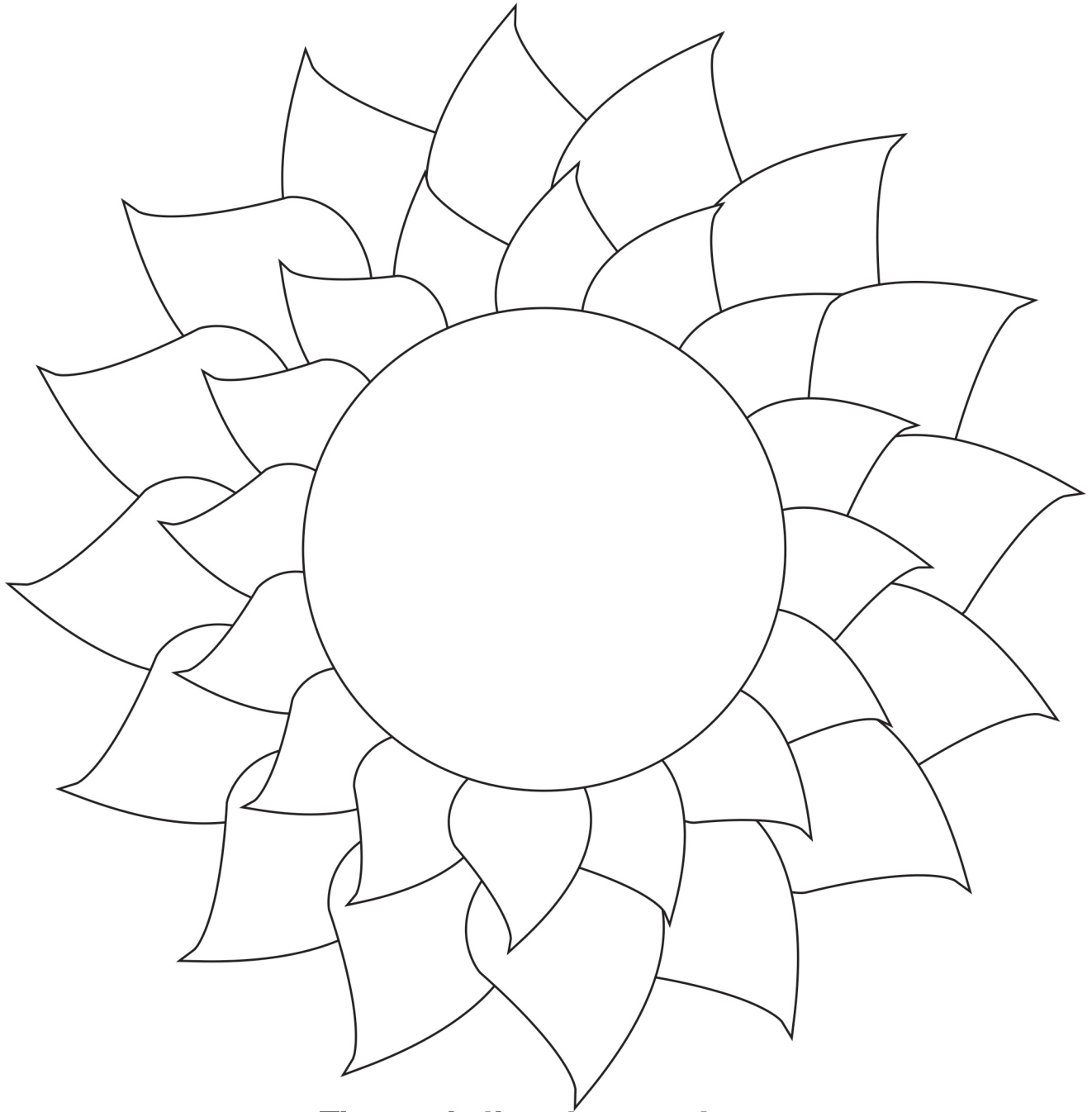
“At the end of our time together today, you get to take home your Go and Tell crafts. And what are you going to do with them? Show and tell someone the important news you’ve learned today.”

Practice saying the words on the card, lifting the flap, as you say the “through the night” portion.

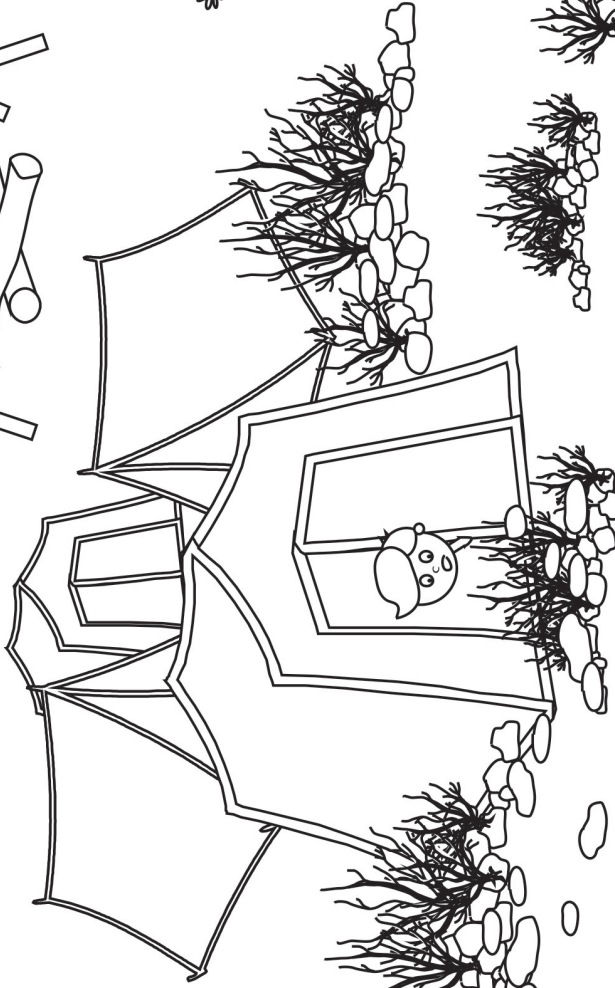
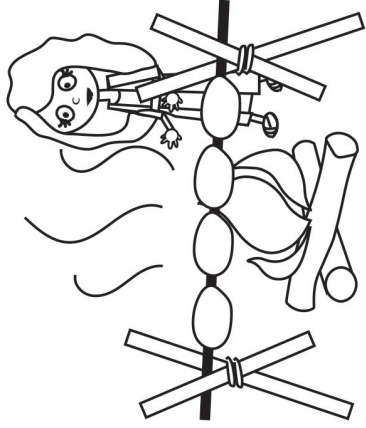
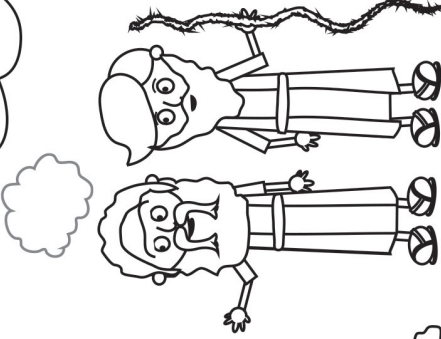
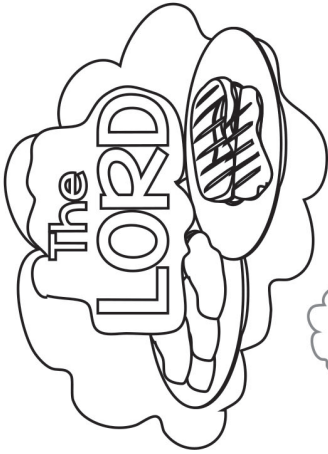
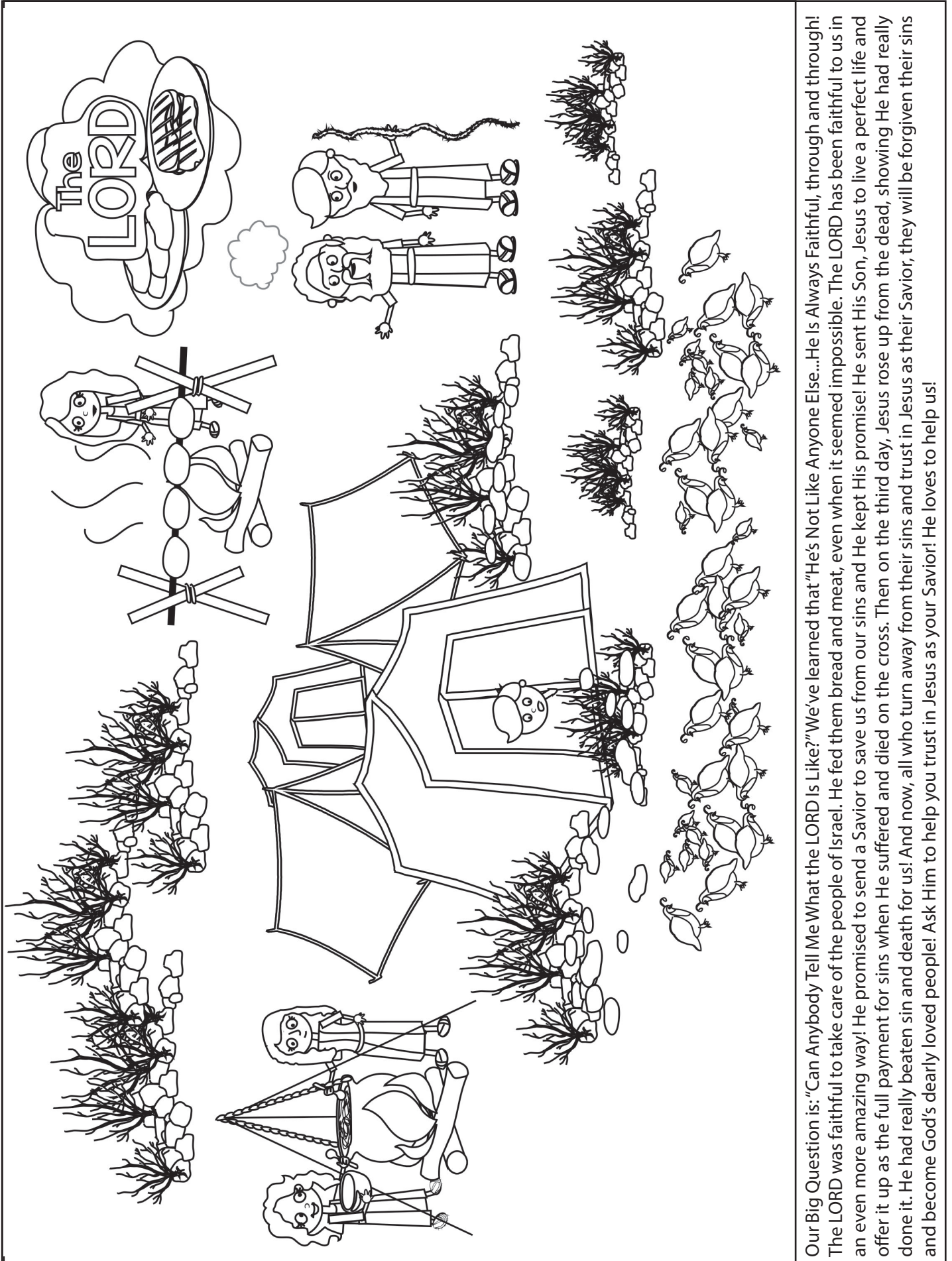
