
Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

Adam and Eve, Before and After Disobeying God

Craft Description

The children will make a booklet that reminds them of what happened when Adam and Eve chose to disobey God.

Materials

White cardstock or construction paper

Markers, Colored pencils, crayons

Pictures on following pages

Easter egg plastic "grass" (or little strips of green construction paper

Hay (Obtainable from craft stores in little bales) or little strips of brown construction paper

Glue

Preparations

1. Make a 2-sided card onto cardstock, one per child.
2. If using strips of construction paper instead of grass and weeds, cut tiny, 1/8' wide strips.
3. Set out decorating supplies

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "How Did Bad Things Come to God's Good World? We've learned that "Bad Things Came from Sin...When Adam and Eve Chose to Disobey God." That's something very important to know. But many people don't know it. They need to know that we all are sinners who deserve God's punishment for our sins. They need to know that they can say sorry to God for their sins and trust Jesus to save them. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like... (Hold up example of craft)."

Directions

1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
2. Let the children color in all of the pictures on the front and back of the card.
3. Glue the green grass around the happy Adam and Eve. Glue more grass around the tree on the inside of the card and then the hay (weeds and thorns) around the sad Adam and Eve.
4. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.

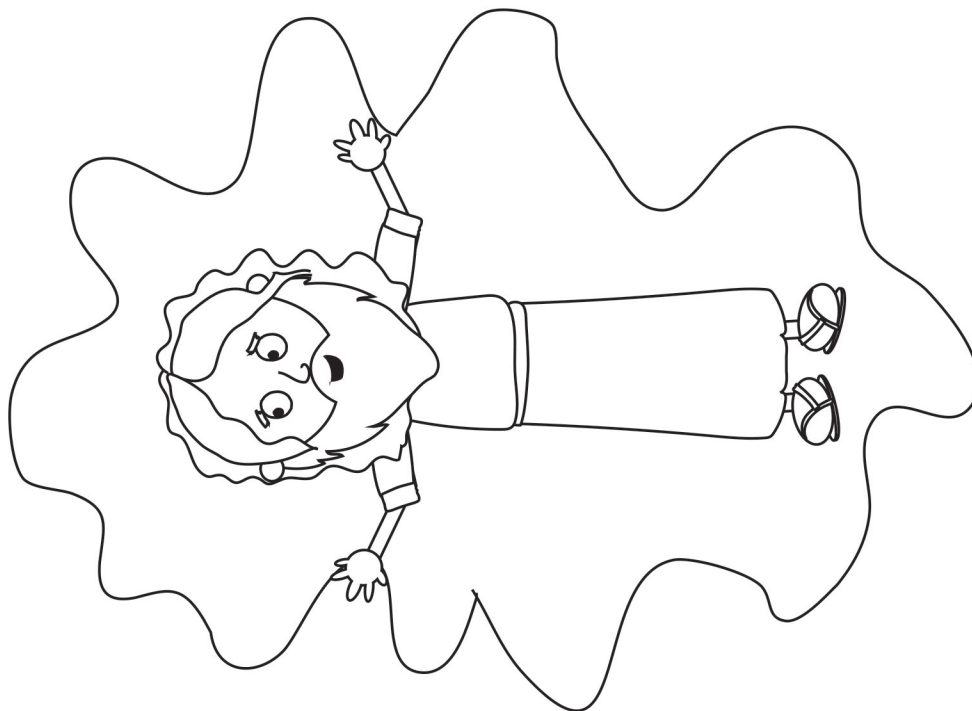
Discussion

This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See the Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.

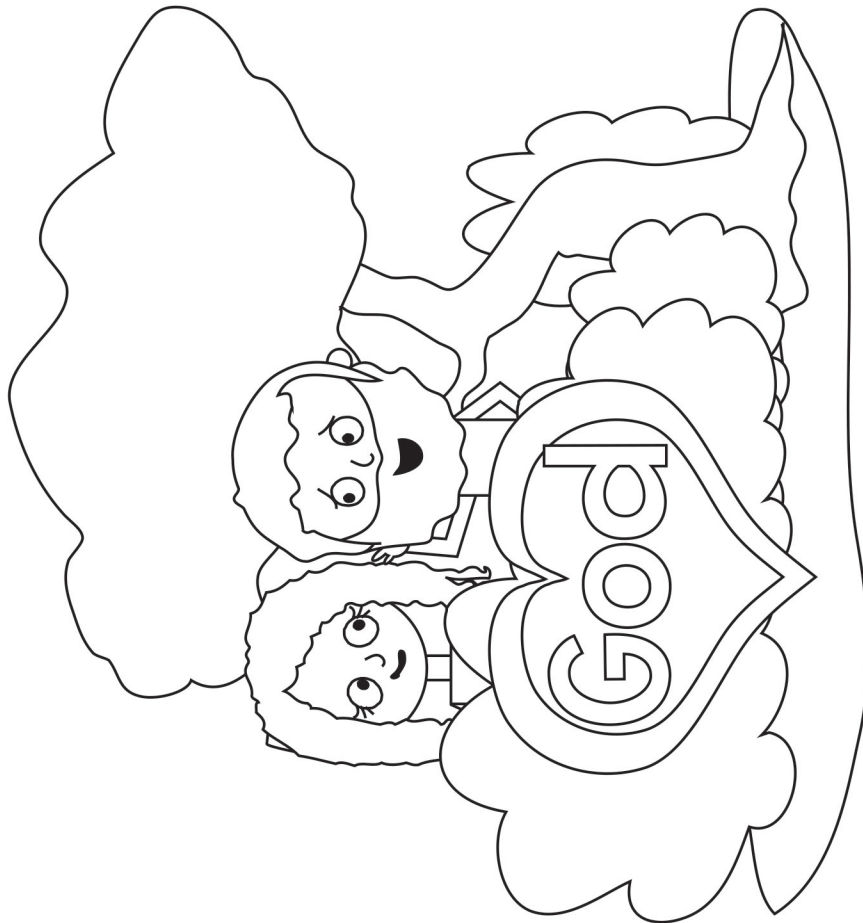
Craft Wrap-Up:

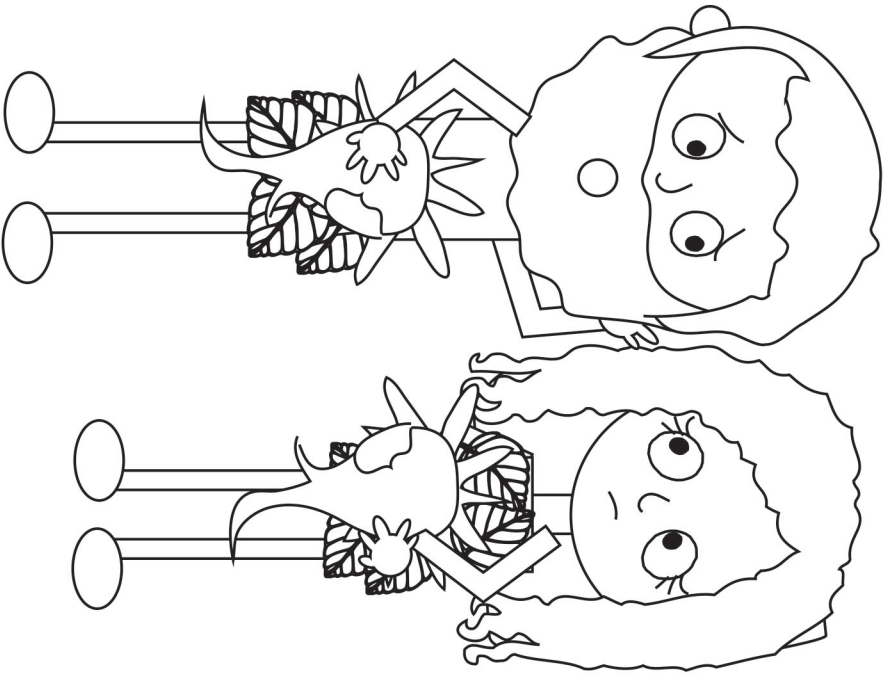
**In the beginning,

one day. And He did! It was JESUS!**

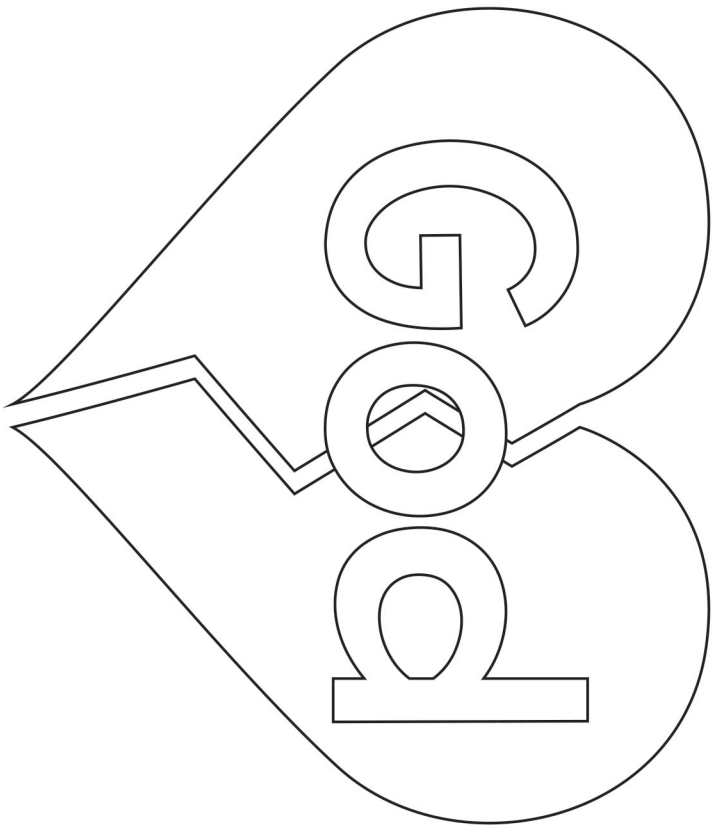
**He made people in a special way,

when Adam and Eve chose to disobey God!**

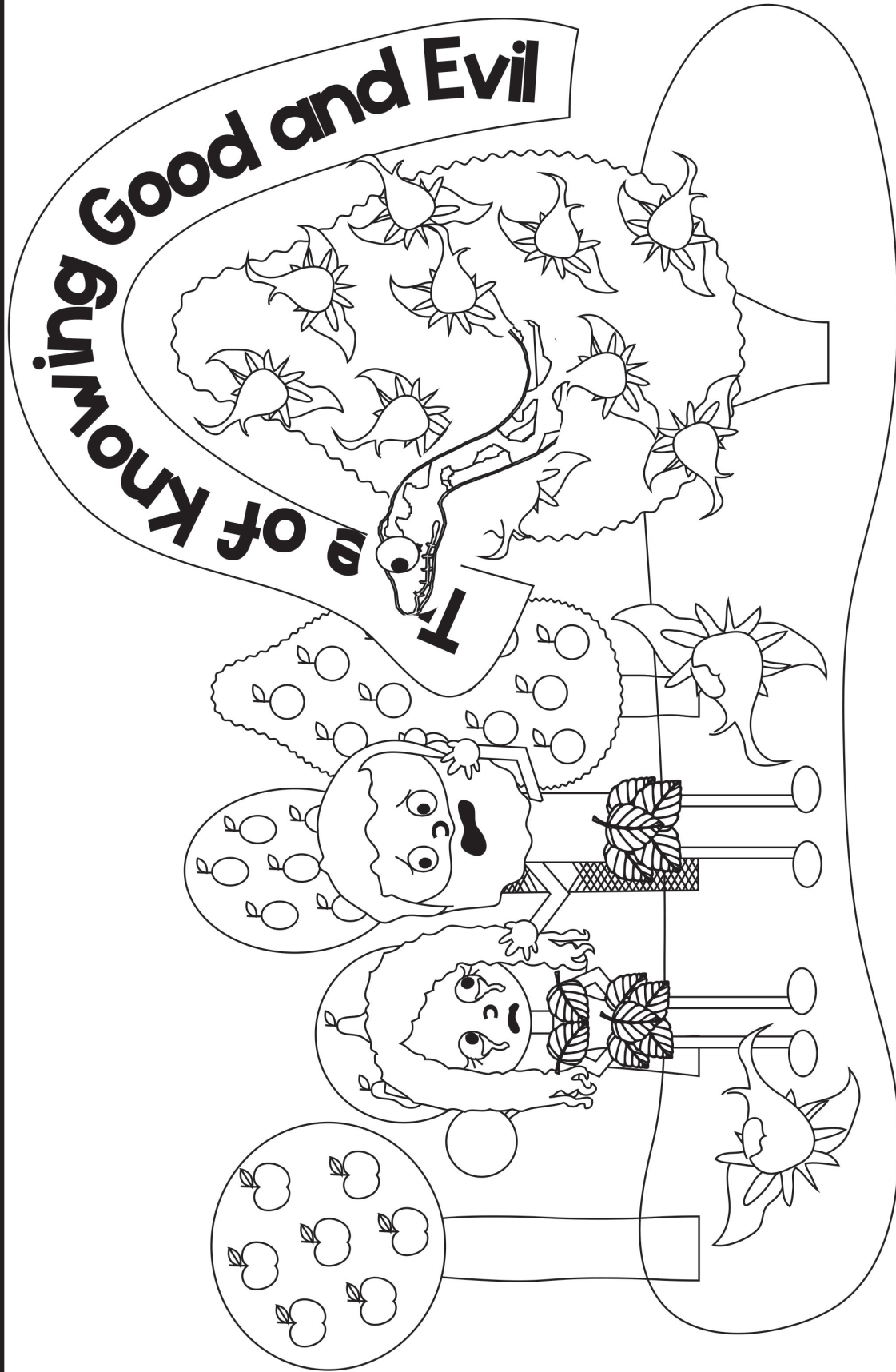


Their sin hurt all of God's good world.
