Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

We Are All Sinners, We All Need Jesus

Craft Description

The children will decorate a picture reminding them that we are all sinners who need a Savior.

Materials

White cardstock or paper Pictures on following pages Sandpaper Cinnamon Sticks, 1 piece per child Markers or crayons Glue Glue sticks and Glue Gun (optional; teacher's use only)

Preparations

Make a copy of the background picture onto white paper, preferably cardstock. Also print out five circles for each child: two of "Sin", two of "Forgiven" and one of the "Jesus' Perfect Life." Cut out these circles.
Use cross pattern as guide to cut out cross shapes from the sandpaper, one per child.
Set out supplies.

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "How Did Bad Things Come to God's Good World? We've learned that "Bad Things Came from Sin...When It Spread to the Whole World." That's something very important to know. We all need to know that we are all sinners, so that we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Many people don't know this very important thing, so do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like...(Hold up example of craft)."

Directions

1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.

2. Have the children color in the children on the card.

3. Give the children the sandpaper crosses. Show the children how to color in the sandpaper cross by rubbing it with the cinnamon stick.

4. Glue the cross to the middle of the card. (You might want to use a glue gun for a firmer hold.)

5a. Give out two "Sin" circles to each child. Read to them the word "Sin" on the top two children. Tell them to color that circle in a dark color and glue it in place on top of the two children at the top of the page. Sin makes us sad. 5b. Give out two "Forgiven" circles. Have the children glue these on without coloring them at all. Tell them that God offers to forgive our sins and makes us happy and close to Him again.

5c. Give out the one "Jesus' Perfect Life" circle. Have the children color it in red and glue it in place on the cross. Tell them that it's because Jesus gave up his perfect life as the full payment for sins that we can be forgiven by God. He is how our sins are forgiven.


6. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.

This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.


Craft Wrap Up:






