Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

God's Ten, Big Rules

Craft Description

The children will make a booklet that reminds them of some of the things God made when He created everything, in the beginning.

Materials

Manilla file folder, 1 per child White paper or cardstock Marker Glue

Sequins, Glitter/glitter glue, and/or hole punch dots from colored paper Crayons or markers

Preparations

- 1. Print out the front cover and the two inner pages for the craft and copy them onto white paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut out along the lines of the three tablet pieces.
- 3. Print and cut out the Tablet Template. Place it on top of the closed manilla file folder, open sides of the folder to the right and the folded edge to the left. Place the left edge of the Template on top of the manilla file folder, so that the bottom and the left edges of the Template line up with the bottom and left edge of the folder. Cut out the folder, using the Template as a guide. You should have a folder in the shape of a tablet that opens up into two tablets, connected along the middle fold. Repeat for each child's craft.
- 4. Set out glue on paper plates (or glue sticks), as well as any decorating supplies.

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "What Are God's Laws Like? We've learned that "God's Laws Are Perfect...They Are Written in the Bible, God's Word." That's something very good to know. But many people don't know that. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like...(Hold up example of craft)"

Directions


- 1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
- 2. Let the children color the numbers on sheets for the inside of the tablet and the front of the tablet.
- 3. Help the children glue down the two inside pieces and the front piece onto their manilla folder tablets.
- 4. Let the children finish their craft by decorating the front of the tablet using the other decorating supplies.
- 5. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.

Discussion

This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See the Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.

Craft Wrap-Up:

At the end of our time together today, you get to take home your Go and Tell crafts. And what are you going to do with them? Show and tell someone the important news you've learned today. Hold up the cards and say the words together, if desired.


