
Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

God's Laws Tell Us How to Love God and Others

Craft Description

The children will make a booklet that reminds them of what happened They Tell Us How to Love God and Others.

Materials

Manilla file folder, 1 per child

White paper or cardstock

Marker

Glue

Red sequins; or, red foil paper or tissue paper (cut into little squares)

Crayons or markers

Preparations

1. Print out the front cover and the inner page for the craft and copy them onto white paper or cardstock.
2. Cut out the front cover piece. Cut out around the pieces for the inner page so that they are all one piece.
3. Print and cut out the Tablet Template. Place it on top of the closed manilla file folder, open sides of the folder to the right and the folded edge to the left. Place the left edge of the Template on top of the manilla file folder, so that the bottom and the left edges of the Template line up with the bottom and left edge of the folder. Cut out the folder, using the Template as a guide. You should have a folder in the shape of a tablet that opens up into two tablets, connected along the middle fold. Repeat for each child's craft.
4. Set out glue on paper plates (or glue sticks), as well as the decorating supplies.

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "What Are God's Laws Like? We've learned that "God's Laws Are Perfect... They Tell Us How to Love God and Others." That's something very important to know. But many people don't know it. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can show and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like... (Hold up example of craft)."

Directions

1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
2. Let the children color in the words on the front page and on the inside page (God, others).
3. Help the children glue down the inside page (so that the center lines up with the fold) and the front piece onto their manilla folder tablets.
4. Let the children finish their craft by decorating the heart with either the red sequins or pieces of red foil paper.
5. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.

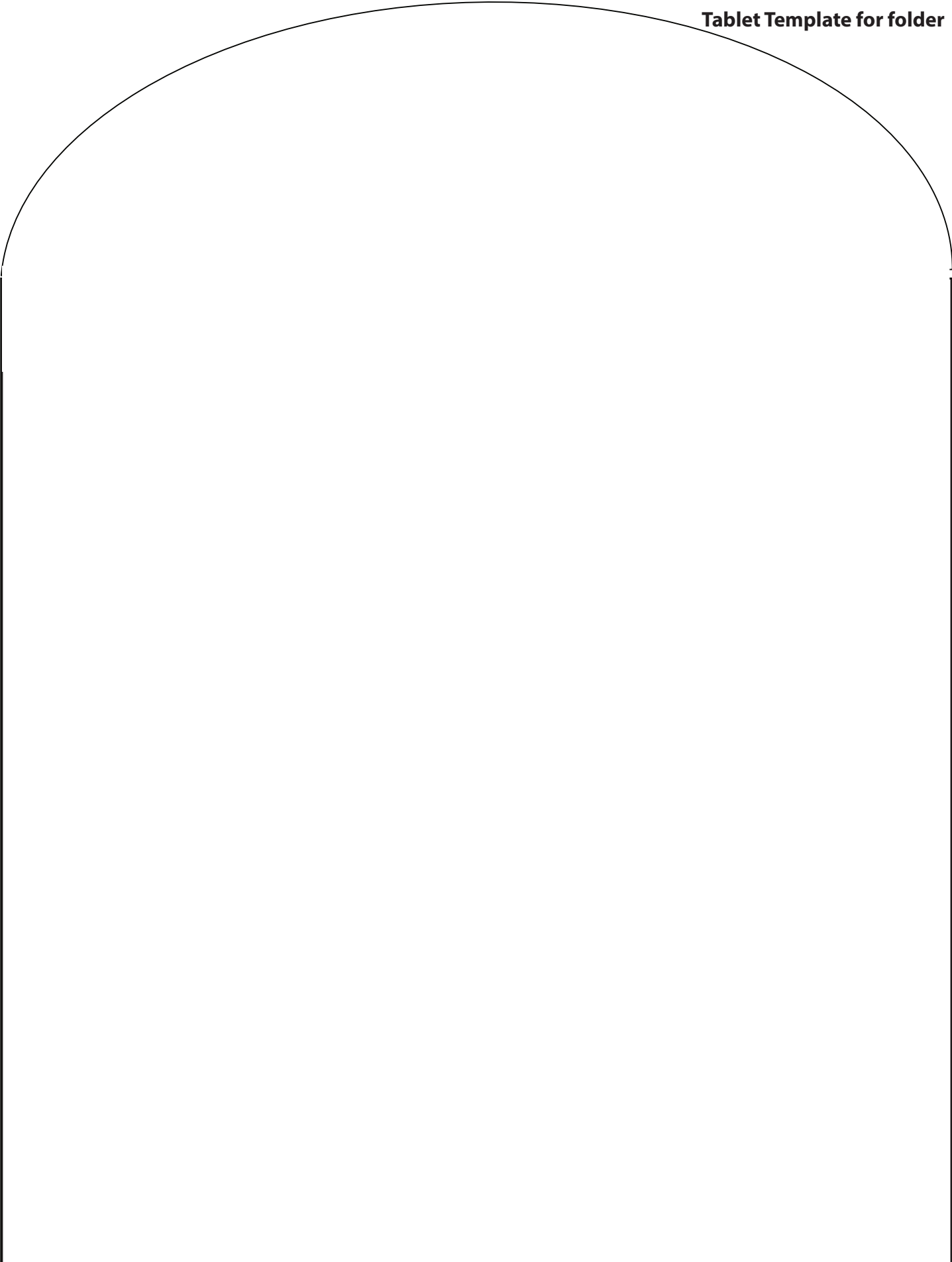
Discussion

Craft Wrap-Up:

At the end of our time together today, you get to take home your Go and Tell crafts. And what are you going to do with them? "This is a picture of God's laws. God's laws are perfect... they tell us how to..." then you can open up your laws and show them the answer: "love God and others." Let's practice! Now you are ready to go tell someone else this good news today!" Lead the children in practicing with their craft a few times (after it has dried.)

Tablet front cover

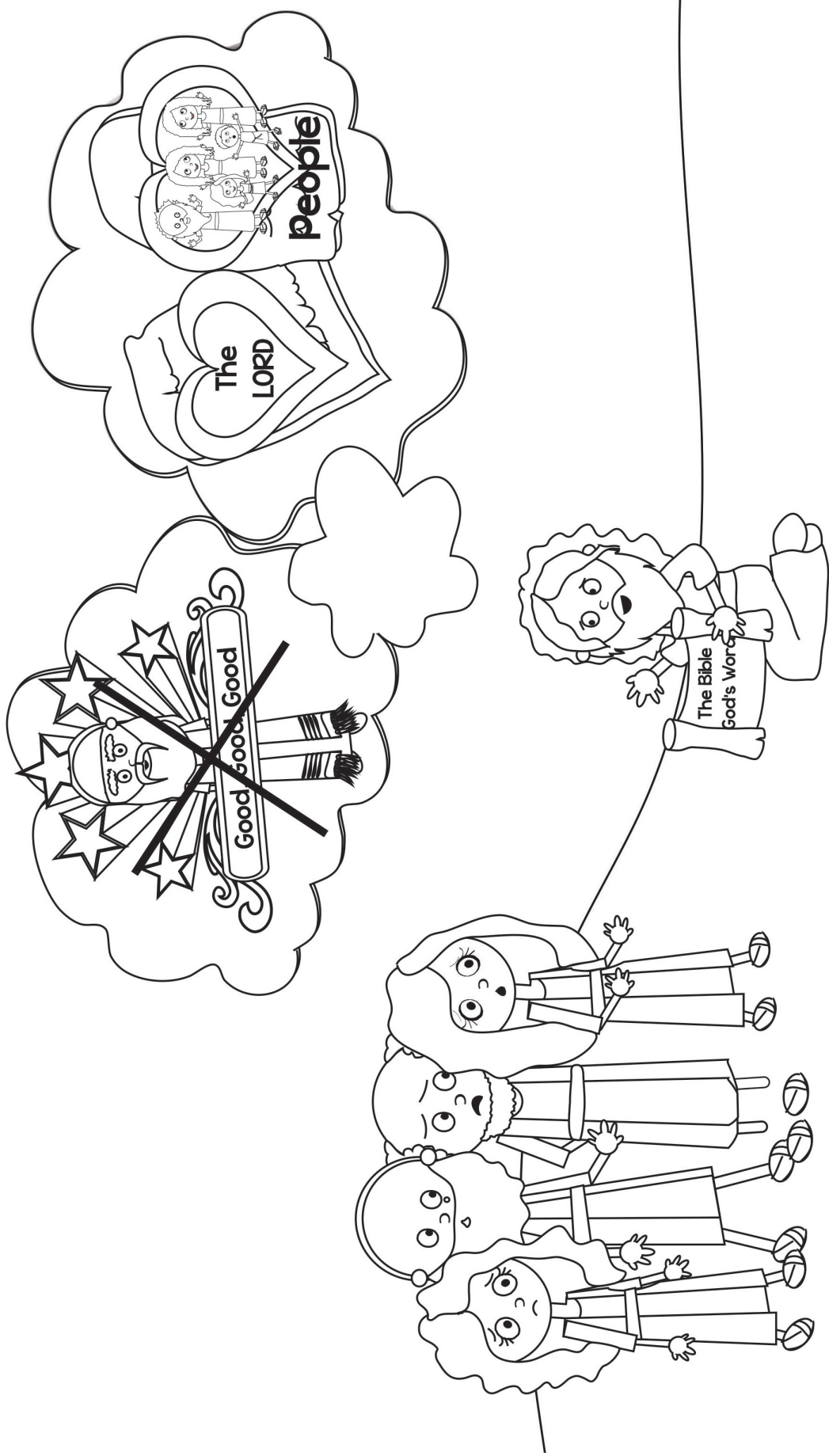
