Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft

God Will Always Take Care of His People

Craft Description

The children will decorate a picture reminding them of how God is the good shepherd who always takes care of His people.

Materials

White paper or cardstock Markers or crayons Q-tips (about 10 -20 per craft) Glue Jiggly eyes

Preparations

- 1. Print out the craft pages as a two-sided sheet onto the white paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut the ends off of the Q-tips, throwing away stick section and reserving the wooly tips.
- 3. Set out markers/crayons and the glue.

Introducing the Craft:

"Our Big Question is: "What Is God's Love for His People Like?" We've learned that "It's More than They Could Ever Deserve" and "God Always Takes Care of Them." That's something very good to know, but many people don't know that. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can go and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like...(Hold up example of craft)

Directions

- 1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
- 2. Have the children color in and glue the people picture on the inside of the card.
- 3. Have the children glue first the jiggly eyes, then the Q-tips to the sheep picture on the front of the card.
- 4. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.
- 5. Allow crafts to dry.

Discussion


This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See the Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.




