

## **Go and Tell Bible Truth Concept Craft**

---

### **Jesus Taught About God and Did Amazing Things**

#### **Craft Description**

The children will decorate a card that reminds them that He taught about God and did amazing things, like heal Peter's mother-in-law.

#### **Materials**

White paper or cardstock  
Markers or crayons  
Prong paper fasteners (aka paper brads) (one per craft)  
Glitter glue/glitter  
Glue

#### **Preparations**

1. Print out the craft pages. The second two pages print out as a two-sided card on the cardstock.
2. Cut out the pictures of Peter's mother-in-law.
3. Fold paper along the long side.
4. Set out markers/crayons, glitter and glue.

#### **Introducing the Craft:**

"Our Big Question is: 'What Did Jesus Come to Do?' We've learned that 'Jesus Came to Bring Us to God... He Taught about God and Did Amazing Things.' That's what our pictures are about today! That's something very good to know, but many people don't know that. So do you know what God wants us to do? He wants us to go and tell others this very important news. So today we are going to make something we can go and tell them, too. Here's what it looks like..." (Hold up example of craft)

#### **Directions**

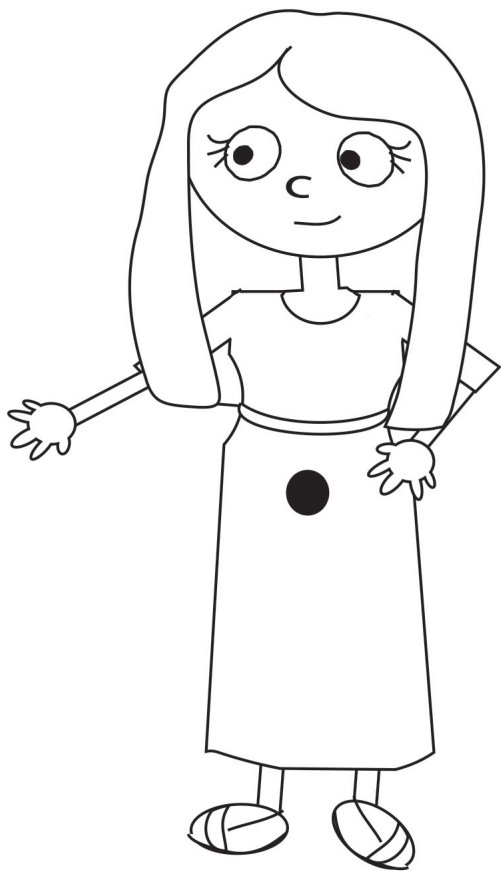
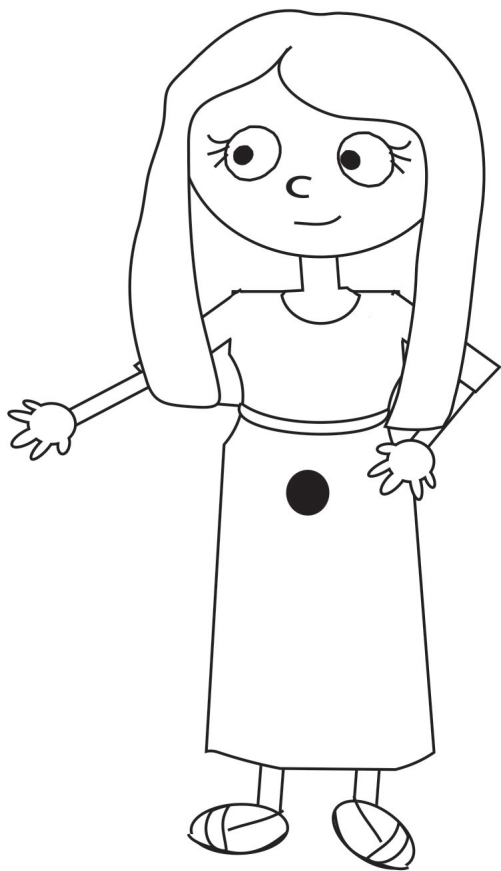
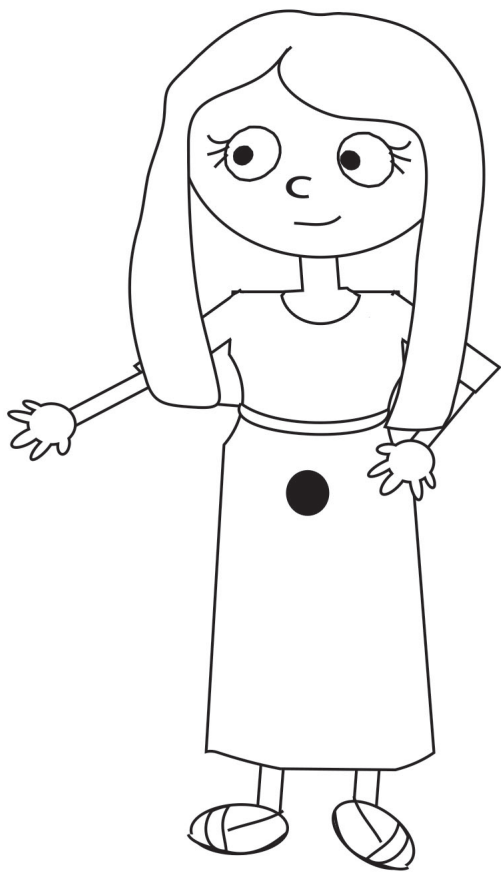
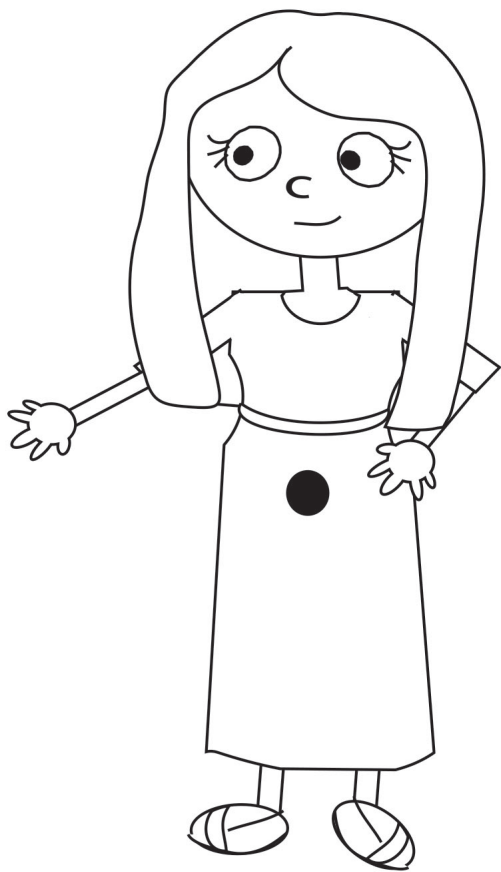
1. Show children your finished craft, reading the words to them.
2. Have the children color in the word "God" on the front of the card and the picture of Jesus and the mat on the inside. Also color in their picture of Peter's mother-in-law. As they color in, ask them/remind them of what Jesus did for her in the story they heard. Also color in the mat on the card.
3. Teacher attaches Peter's mother in law to the mat by poking the paper fastener through the hole in her and in the mat, then opening up the prongs of the fasteners so that she is fairly tightly attached, yet can still swivel to "healed" position.
4. Fold the card across the middle. Add glitter to the shape around the word "God." Let dry.
5. Make sure to write each child's name on their craft.
6. If you have time, you can practice saying the words on the card and opening it up and showing the answer.

#### **Discussion**

This is an especially good time to re-read the key concepts and discuss them. See the Deep Down Discussion Sheet for possible questions to talk about.

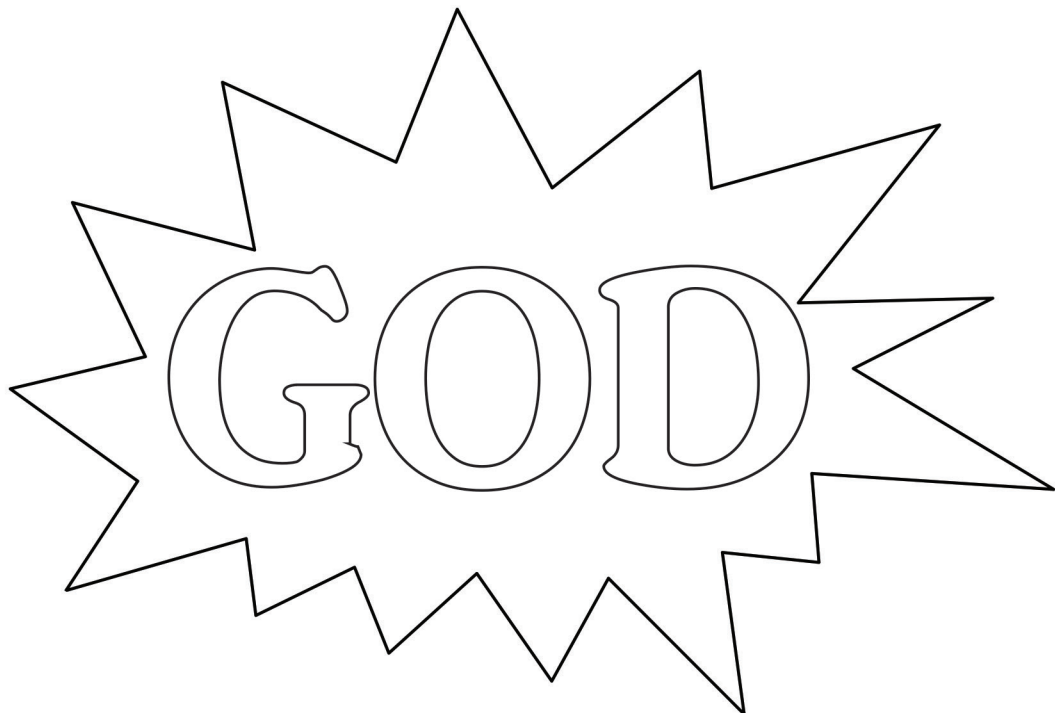
#### **Craft Wrap-Up:**

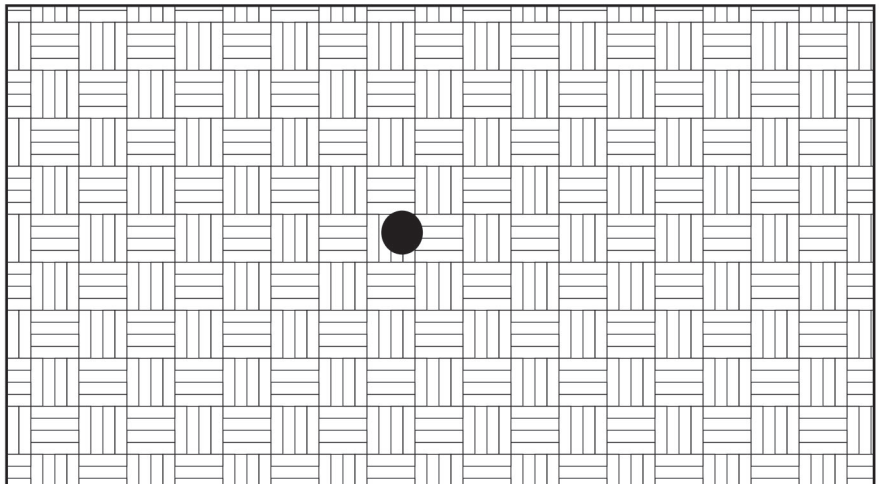

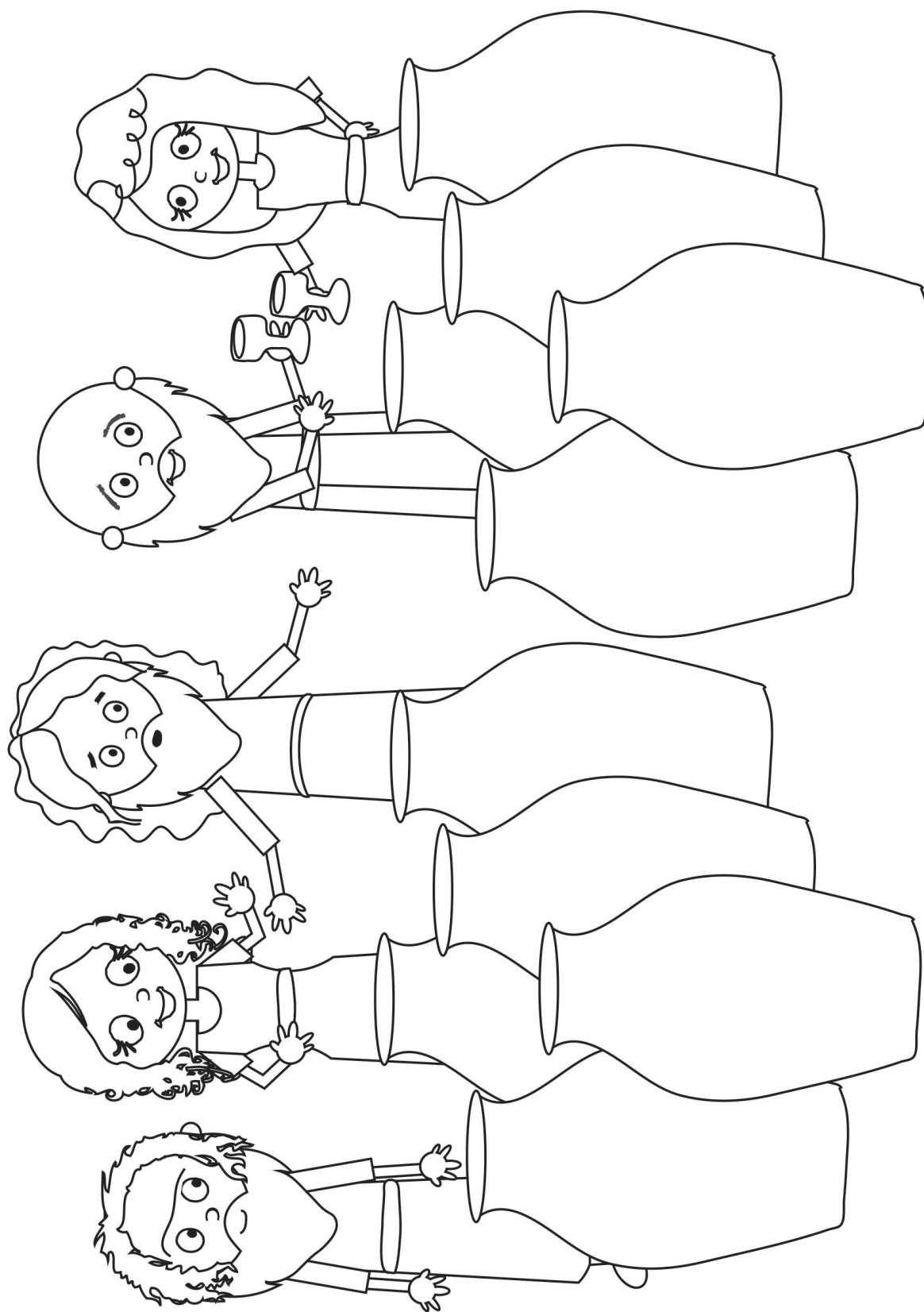
