Pray!



Pray for the Holy Spirit to be at work in your and the children's hearts.

Review



If new to the curriculum, look at the **Getting Started with Deep Down Detectives section of the Core Curriculum book.** (p.5) It will be especially helpful to read through the Deep Down Detectives section of **The Praise Factory Tour: Extended Version Book.** This is a visual way to understand what goes on in the classroom. (A pdf of the book is found in the samples section on the website.)

Look through and Learn the Lesson



Read over **lesson plan**. Practice any **songs or action rhymes** you are using. Choose/make up motions to go with these. Choose less with younger children and more with older preschoolers. **Practice the lesson with the visual aids** and using the Big Question Box/Briefcase.

Read and Rehearse the Bible Story with Pictures



Read the Bible story from the Bible. Read the curriculum version. Practice telling it with the storyboard pictures. (If you have not previously laminated the story pictures, do that now.) Or, rehearse it from the Simple Story Scenes, if you are using those.

Let There Be Music



Download the music and listen to the songs. Choose which of the songs you will use with the children. If using live musicians, make sure they have the sheet music (Appendix A, Core Curriculum book).

Put the Props in Place



- 1. Prepare your Visual Aids. Put the Big Question, Unit Bible Truths, Bible Truth, Bible Verse, and Listening Assignment signs, as well as the Bible Story script in one side of the Bible folder.
- 2. Get out your storyboard. If using Simple Story Scenes, put these in your BIble Folder. Or, if using the individual storyboard figures, put all background pictures in place (they have a BG by the number). Put the rest of the storyboard pictures (these have a SB by the number) in order of use in the other side of the Bible folder.
- 3. Put the DDD Bible Folder as well as the Big Question sign in the Big Question Box/Briefcase and shut it. If your box/briefcase has locks and you want to use the unlocking the box as part of your session, lock it now....but make sure you have the key or know the code first.
- 4. Prepare the music CD or sheet music or mp3 device for use in your session.

Set Out Free Play Activities



Choose and set up free time activities you will use with the children. Choose a variety of different activities that will be enjoyed by different types of children. Rotate the activities you provide to keep them interesting and fresh to your children. (Suggestions in Appendix D, Core Curriculum books.)

Prepare Any Activities



Choose which (if any) of the Bible Truth games and crafts activities you want to use in the session. Bear in mind your time frame as well as the developmental abilities and attention span of your children as you decide which/how many to prepare. **Look over the Discussion Sheet** and choose a few questions you might use to spark discussion with the children as they do their activities (especially good for ages 3's+). Pray for God to give you opportunities to talk about these things with the children.

Let Them Take It with Them



Make copies of the craft/take home sheets, if you are not already using them as one of your activities. You may also want to make copies of the story (see take-home version of each story included in Appendix C with the other take home resources) to have for parents to use with their children at home. There's a link on each craft/take home sheet to the story, if you don't make hard copies.

Store It



After your session is over, collect the resources and store them for future use. This curriculum can be used over and over for years to come.

People look for a god to worship: someone or something that they honor as best; who is most important to them; who they will love most of all; and, serve. And, someone or thing they can depend on to take care of them.

Sometimes, people make their own gods. They cut them out of wood or stone and worship them. Sometimes, people make things their god. They make having many nice things most important. They trust in their money to take care of them. They never seem to have enough of it. Sometimes people worship other people or even themselves! People are most important to them. They change what they say and do to please them, even if it's wrong. What others think of them matters to them too much.

Money, people, and even wood and stone are all good things, but they were not meant to be worshipped. There is really only one SOMEONE we are made to worship: it is the LORD, the one, true God. The LORD made heaven and earth and everything in it... even us! He is all-loving and all-good. He knows everything there is to know and He can do whatever He wants to do. He's the one who can we can depend on to take care of us. He is the only one who is really worthy of our worship. There is no one like Him.

Seek after the LORD! Live for Him! He promises that all who seek Him will find Him. How wonderful it is to know and live for the LORD, the one, true God!

"He's not like anyone else" is a good beginning, but there's so more to learn. So it's time for us to dig down even deeper for more answers to our Big Question about God. We're going to be learning **EIGHT** Bible truths that all tell us more about what the God is like.

Who would like to hand me the picture with our eight Bible truths on it? It's in the Big Question Box/Briefcase." Choose a child to get it and hand it to you, then hold it up and show them the pictures of the eight truths they will be learning.

Bible Truth Clue Sign, front side VISUAL AID After everyone has had a good look, say...

"Ok, we've learned one truth about what the LORD is like. It's this one: "He is a Glorious Spirit" (point to pictures as you identify each Bible Truth). Now let's look at our Bible Truth Clue sign and see if we can figure out which of these eight truths we will be learning about today. Who would like to get it out of the Big Question Briefcase for me?"

Choose a child to open the briefcase, take out the Bible Truth Clue sign and hand it to you. Hold up the front side for the children to see. Cover up the answer, written along the bottom, and say:

"Can Anybody Tell Me What the LORD Is Like?

He's Not Like Anyone Else! He Is the ???? True God!"

We're missing one word. Here's the hint to what the missing word is. It says: "How many true Gods are there? It starts with an "o" and it rhymes with "done."

Hint

Can you guess? It's "One."

So the Bible Truth we are learning today is:

(uncover answer from bottom of sign, show it to them and say:)

"Can Anybody Tell Me What the LORD Is Like?

He's Not Like Anyone Else!

He Is the ONE, True God!"

Bible Truth Meaning

And here is what this Bible Truth means: (read the meaning off of the back of the sign, say:)

People look for a god to worship: someone or something that they honor as best; who is most important to them; who they will love most of all; and, serve. And, someone or thing they can depend on to take care of them.

Sometimes, people make their own gods. They cut them out of wood or stone and worship them. Sometimes, people make things their god. They make having many nice things most important. They trust in their money to take care of them. They never seem to have enough of it. Sometimes people worship other people or even themselves! People are most important to them. They change what they say and do to please them, even if it's wrong. What others think of them matters to them too much.

Money, people, and even wood and stone are all good things, but they were not meant to be worshipped. There is really only one SOMEONE we are made to worship: it is the LORD, the one, true God. The LORD made heaven and earth and everything in it... even us! He is all-loving and all-good. He knows everything there is to know and He can do whatever He wants to do. He's the one who can we can depend on to take care of us. He is the only one who is really worthy of our worship. There is no one like Him.

Seek after the LORD! Live for Him! He promises that all who seek Him will find Him. How wonderful it is to know and live for the LORD, the one, true God!

The LORD and the people of Israel made big promises to each other.

The LORD promised that He would always love them and take care of them. He would keep them safe and give them everything they needed to be happy. Best of all, He would give them Himself to know and enjoy forever.

The people of Israel promised the LORD something in return, too. Can you guess what that might be?

Can you guess?

They promised to love the LORD.

Now, that might sound very simple at first. But the love the LORD wanted His people to have for Him was not a little, tiny love—like a love that wakes up in the morning and says "Good morning, LORD! I love you," but then forgets Him the rest of the day.

No, the kind of love the LORD asked for was a love that loved Him with their whole lives, through the whole day, in everything they did and said and even thought. It meant obeying all of His good laws and worshipping Him as the One, True God.It meant obeying His good laws about loving others, too. So you see, this was a very BIG love that the LORD asked the people to promise Him... and they happily promised Him they would.

But it is one thing to make promises and it's another thing to keep them, especially big promises like the ones the LORD and the people of Israel made to each other. And while the LORD kept His promises to the people of Israel. the people did NOT.

They forgot Him as they lived each day. They broke His good laws. They stopped worshipping Him as the One, True God and turned to worship other, fake gods instead....especially the fake god that their neighbors worshipped: a fake god named Baal. And their king--King Ahab--led the way.

Baal was supposed to be the god who gave people rain, good crops, and big families. Those were the three, big things that the people especially cared about then. Can you guess what the three things might be?

Can you guess?

They were rain, good crops, and big families!

Now you might think of three OTHER things you especially care about, but back in those days there were no grocery stores or hospitals. You needed rain to grow your food and keep you and your animals alive. And since there weren't really doctors back then, getting sick was very scary. Rain, big families, and good crops meant LIFE to these people! Rain, big families and good food meant LIFE to these people! Who could want to worship Baal if he could give them that!

But what about the people of Israel? Didn't they need rain, big families, and good food to live, too? Yes, they did! But they SHOULDN'T have turned to Baal for them. Who SHOULD they have turned to instead?

Can you tell me?

They SHOULD have turned to the LORD. He had already made big promises to always love them and take care of them. Hadn't He always provided them with rain, big families, and good food in the past? Wouldn't He keep on giving these good gifts to them? Of course, He would! The LORD never breaks His promises!

But, the people of Israel chose to forget all of this. They chose to worship the fake god, Baal, instead. Their king,

This was sad news! This was BAD news! The people of Israel had turned away from the LORD. They had broken their promises to Him. What would the LORD do? Would He turn away from them and stop caring for them, as they deserved?

What do you think the LORD did?

The LORD COULD have done that, but He did not. He chose to go on loving them. He would bring them back to Him. He would show them in a mighty way that Baal was just a fake, and that He, the LORD, was the one, true God. And He would do it by stopping the very thing that Baal was supposed to be in charge of: the rain.

The LORD sent His special messenger, Elijah, to tell King Ahab and the people what He was going to do.

"The LORD says: 'You have broken your promise to love Me," Elijah told them. ""You have chosen to worship Baal as giver of rain, big families, and good food, but he isn't. He is just a fake god. He is not the One True God. I am, as I am going to show you!" the LORD told the people.

"I am going to take away all the rain. I am going to take away all the good food from you...the food you need so you can have big families. And no matter how much anyone prays to Baal, there will be no more rain or good food until I say so. Then you will see that I, not Baal, am the One True God," the LORD warned the people through Elijah.

Those were big words. Could the LORD really do this? Could He really stop Baal's power? Everyone waited and watched.

What do you think happened?

Sure enough, day after day after day went by and there was no rain.

The water in the streams dried up. The good food that should have grown in the fields, died. The big families and their animals grew hungry and thirsty. They took their worship gifts to Baal and prayed, "Oh, Baal, send us the rain we need to grow good food and feed our big families."

But for one, two, THREE whole years, no matter how much anyone prayed to Baal, there was no rain or good food. Oh, how sad the neighbors were! Oh, how sad the people of Israel were!

At last, the LORD knew the people had learned enough from their suffering. They were ready for the great showdown. The big fight with fire that would make it clear to them and their neighbors who the one, true God really was.

Elijah went back to King Ahab with a new message: "The LORD says: 'For three years I've taken away your rain and good food. It has been hard to feed your big families. I did this because the people and you chose to stop worshipping Me and obeying My good laws. I wanted you to see that I am the one, true God, not Baal," the LORD said.

"I'm not done yet. There's more thing I want to do. Gather all of the people and all of the messengers of Baal on top of Mount Carmel. There, you will see who really is the One, True God," the LORD promised.

King Ahab obeyed. Up, up, up to the top of dry Mount Carmel went Elijah, with King Ahab, the people of Israel, and the messengers of Baal. It was time for the big showdown.

Elijah gathered them all together and said, "The time has come to see who is the One, True God. If it is Baal, follow him. If it is the LORD, follow Him."

"I am the only messenger of the LORD here, but Baal has many messengers," Elijah told them. "We will each give a worship gift of a bull to our god. Baal's messengers will give Baal their worship gift; and I will give my worship gift to the LORD," Elijah explained.

"But we're going to make this a fight with fire between the LORD and Baal," Elijah said. "We won't light the wood under the worship gifts, like we usually do. We will leave that to the One, True God. We will ask Him to send down fire from heaven to burn up the worship offering," Elijah told them.

"This shouldn't be hard for Baal. He's the rain god. He can throw down one of his lightning bolts and set the worship gift on fire," Elijah said. "I will even let the messengers of Baal go first."

Everyone agreed. The messengers of Baal took a bull and set it on top of some stones and firewood. Their worship offering was ready. They began shouting their prayers to Baal: "O great Baal, show that you are the One, True God! Accept our worship gift! Send fire to burn it up!" they prayed.

Nothing happened at all. But Baal's messengers didn't give up. Next, they tried shouting louder and dancing a worship dance to Baal. But still, nothing happened. On and on, all day, Baal's messengers tried many things; but still no fire came down.

At last they gave up. it was Elijah's turn. With twelve, big stones, Elijah rebuilt the altar to the LORD. He put lots of wood. on it, and the bull on top of the wood. He had men pour lots and lots of water on the everything to make it even harder to burn up.

Elijah bowed down low to the ground, with his face between his knees, and prayed to the LORD. The skies soon grew black with clouds and a great rain began to fall. All the people rejoiced in the rain and the good food that would grow again now. And which God did they thank?

Can you tell me?

They thanked the LORD! For now it was very, very clear: Baal was only a fake god; and the LORD was the One, True God. There was no other God, and there never will be.

Cracking the Case: (story wrap-up for Listening Assignments)

It's time to see how we did with our Listening Assignment.

Detective Dan's Lesson #1 Listening Assignment: I need to know:

- **1. What was the fight about?** Who was the real One, True God.
- **2. Who won the fight?** How did He use fire to show He had won? The LORD won. He sent down fire from heaven and burned up the worship gifts.

For You and Me:

The LORD was the one, true God long ago when this story took place. He is STILL the one, true God today! He wants us to know Him and obey Him, just like He wanted the people of Israel to, long ago. How can we do this? By turning away from our sins and trusting in Jesus as our Savior. Ask God to help you! He loves to answer these prayers!

Detective Dan's Lesson #2 Listening Assignment:

Our Bible Verse is Psalm 86:8,10:

"There is none like you among the gods, O LORD, nor are there any works like yours...For you are great and do wondrous things; you alone are God."

I need to know:

- **1. What wondrous thing did the LORD do with fire?** He sent down fire from heaven and burned up the worship gifts.
- 2. Who had to agree that there is no god like the LORD? Everyone!

For You and Me:

Everyone was amazed when the LORD sent fire down to burn up the worship gifts and even the rocks around the altar! The people had to agree that there was no god like the LORD. He was the one, true God, then and He is still, today! And the LORD is still doing amazing deeds. The most amazing of all is His offer to be our Savior. Yes! Even though we have all disobeyed Him and deserve His punishment, He offers us His forgiveness and to make us His people. How? When we turn from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Ask Him to help you! He loves to do this!

Detective Dan's Lesson #3 Listening Assignment:

I found six clues, but two of them are **NOT** in the story. They are: a bull; a god named Baal; a bush; dancing men; a pan; and, fire.

Hold each of them up for the children to see as you identify them.

I need to know:

- 1. Which four belong in the story and which two don't? The bull, the god named Baal, the dancing men and the fire belong. The bush and the pan do not.
- **2.** Who praised the LORD for being the one, true **God?** Elijah and all the people of Israel.

For You and Me:

The people of Israel turned away from worshipping Baal and returned to praise the LORD after they saw Him sent fire down from heaven. He was the one, true God. There was no other god they should ever worship besides Him! There is no god we should worship other than the LORD, too. We can start to worship Him by turning away from our sins and trusting in Jesus as our Savior. Ask God to help you! He loves to answer these prayers!

The Gospel (story wrap-up if NOT using Listening Assignments)

Our Bible Truth is:

Can Anybody Tell Me What the LORD Is Like? He's Not Like Anyone Else... He Is the One, True God!

The people of Israel are not the only people who disobey the LORD and choose to worship other things. We have all chosen to disobey Him. We have all chosen to worship other things besides Him. How we deserve His punishment!

But how kind is the LORD! He offers us forgiveness through His Son, Jesus! Jesus suffered and died on the cross as the perfect payment for our sins. He rose from the dead on the third day, showing He had really beaten sin and death for us. How can Jesus be OUR Savior? By turning away from our sins and trusting in Jesus as our Savior. If we do, we become God's people. We will know special closeness with Him in our hearts now. And one day, we will go to live with Him forever. God loves to help us trust in Jesus! Ask Him!

BIBLE TRUTH

He's Not Like Anyone Else..He Is the One, True God!

Meaning

People look for a god to worship: someone or something that they honor as best; who is most important to them; who they will love most of all; and, serve. And, someone or thing they can depend on to take care of them.

Sometimes, people make their own gods. They cut them out of wood or stone and worship them. Sometimes, people make things their god. They make having many nice things most important. They trust in their money to take care of them. They never seem to have enough of it. Sometimes people worship other people or even themselves! People are most important to them. They change what they say and do to please them, even if it's wrong. What others think of them matters to them too much.

Money, people, and even wood and stone are all good things, but they were not meant to be worshipped. There is really only one SOMEONE we are made to worship: it is the LORD, the one, true God. The LORD made heaven and earth and everything in it... even us! He is all-loving and all-good. He knows everything there is to know and He can do whatever He wants to do. He's the one who can we can depend on to take care of us. He is the only one who is really worthy of our worship. There is no one like Him.

Seek after the LORD! Live for Him! He promises that all who seek Him will find Him. How wonderful it is to know and live for the LORD, the one, true God!

Learn a Little: "O LORD ... you alone are God."

Meaning

This verse tells us that there is no one like the LORD. If we compare anyone else's deeds to the LORD's, it is easy to see just how great He is. He alone is God and worthy of our worship!
