Listening Assignments for Big Question 6 Bible Story: "The Case of the Terrible, Terrible Day" Genesis 3-4

(Note: These questions are most appropriate for older preschoolers)

Detective Dan's Lesson #1 Listening Assignment:

I need to find out:

1. What made this day so terrible?
2. What did God promise to do to rescue us from what happened that day?

Detective Dan's Lesson #2 Listening Assignment:

Our Bible verse is Romans 5:12: "Sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned."

As you listen to the story, see if you can figure out:

1. Who did sin come into the world through?
2. How did their sin hurt all of God's good world?

Detective Dan's Lesson #3 Listening Assignment:

I found four clues, but one of them is NOT in the story.

They are: A serpent; Jesus; fruit; and, ice cream.

Hold up each of the four pictures for the children to see as you identify them. Better yet, put them up on your flannelgraph board, off to one side.

I need to know:

1. Which of these things was not in our story today?
2. How were the other three things important in our story?

As you listen to the story, see if you can figure out:

1. Who was sorry for their sins and looked for hope in God?
2. How did God show them kindness, even though they disobeyed Him?

Detective Dan's Lesson #5 Listening Assignment:

As you listen to the story, see if you can figure out:

1. What did Adam and Eve do that brought sin into God's good world?
2. What good news did God give Adam and Eve that day?

Read the questions, THEN SAY,

"Ok, Hide 'n' Seeker! Put on your best listening ears and see if you can hear the answers to Detective Dan's questions. When I finish telling the story, we will see if we can answer all the questions."

Adam and Eve were the first people. God, Himself, made them in the very beginning, long ago. He gave them a wonderful home in a beautiful garden.

God loved Adam and Eve. Adam and Eve loved God. And everything was happy, happy, happy!

Can you show me your happiest face?

But then something very bad happened...

God’s enemy, Satan, came. He wanted to spoil God’s perfectly wonderful world. He especially wanted to spoil the perfect happiness and wonderful friendship that God had with people. So he tricked Adam and Eve.

Satan used the serpent to trick Adam and Eve into wanting to disobey God... and they did! They took fruit from the one tree in their garden home God had told them NOT to eat... and they ate it!

Now everything was sad, sad, sad! Sin had come into God’s good world!

Can you show me your saddest face? This was a very, very, VERY sad and bad thing that happened!

This was a terrible day for all of us. We are all in Adam and Eve's family and we all disobey God, just like they did. How good it is that God sent Jesus to rescue us! He will save us from our sins when turn away from our sins and trust in Him as our Savior.
