Bible Truth 5 Concept: It Is God's Sustaining Grace... The Word of God Feeds God's People!

When your body is hungry you feed it food. The food makes your body strong to do what you need it to do. But did you know that the spirit God put inside our bodies needs to be fed, too? Not hamburgers or hot dogs, but a spiritual kind of food.

What is this spiritual food? It's the Word of God, the Bible. When God's people read God's Word, the Holy Spirit uses it to feed their spirits. He uses it to help them know God better, to guide them in God's will, and to give them strength to do whatever God wants them to do.

And just like our bodies work best if we feed them each day, God's people know that it is best for their spirits if they read and think about God's Word every day. They know that God uses His Word to sustain them, even through the most difficult times. We can become God's people, too, when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Then, God will use His Word to help us to keep on loving and living for Him, too.

Bible Truth 5 Bible Verse: Deuteronomy 8:3

"He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord."

Learn a Little "Man lives by every word that comes from the Lord."

Meaning

Long ago, the LORD fed the people of Israel on special bread from heaven. This bread was called "manna." He did this for forty years while they lived out in the desert where there was no food. God fed them manna because He didn't want their bodies to starve. They were His people, and He would make sure they had what they needed to live, even if He had to give them bread straight from heaven! But the LORD also gave them this special bread to teach them something. He wanted them to know that even more important than bread to feed your body, was His Word, the Bible, which would give them strength to keep on loving Him and living for Him.

Just like those people of Israel long ago, God's people today still need God's Word to help them love God and live for Him. God uses it to help them know Him and how He wants them to live. He uses it to tell them His will and to comfort them. God can use His Word to help us turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus. This is the best first step in loving God and living for Him.
