Using Simple Story Scenes as a Curriculum

Introduce the Key Concept and Bible Verse

Simple Story Scenes give you the basics for the core of your lesson. You can use the overview sheet to introduce and explain the key concept and Bible verse.

Give the Case Assignment

Give the children a Detective Dan listening assignment. Two are provided. You can add a third using the ideas on the bonus, third take-home sheet, if desired. Each listening assignment, let's you teach the story with a different learning emphasis.

Show & Tell the Story

Hold up the pictures and tell the story from the story scenes. Alternatively, you can find in the and Pieces section for this unit at praisefactory.org, these same listening assignments and story scenes, gospel and ACTS prayer modified for view on a screen. Simply download them or open them online and show through your own monitor (tablet, big screen, whatever).

Solve the Case

Repeat Detective Dan's listening assignment question and discuss the answer.

Share the Gospel

Share the gospel tie-in with the kids.

Close in ACTS Prayer

Pray the ACTS prayer with the kids. If using the curriculum with older children, give them a chance to think up their own ACTS tie-ins to the story, using the one provided as cues/ideas for you.

Review Time

Give out the take-home sheet (there are three: two that correlates to the two Detective Dan assignments in the Story Scenes, and a bonus third one.) As the children are coloring, use the take-home sheet discussion questions or your own questions to further review and apply the key concepts, Bible verse, and story truths to the children.

UNIT 1: The God Who Reveals Himself

Unit Big Question (and Answer): “How Can I Know What God Is Like? He Shows Me What He’s Like!”

Unit Bible Verse: “He who forms the mountains, creates the wind, and reveals his thoughts to man...the LORD God Almighty is his name.” Amos 4:13

Bible Truth 4 Concept: God Shows Me What He’s Like...through His very own Son, Jesus Christ!

When Jesus came to earth, He showed us what God is like. Jesus never, ever disobeyed God. He showed that God is perfectly good. Jesus always told people what was true and right. He showed that God is perfectly wise. He could heal people and calm big storms with just His word. He showed us that God is all-powerful. Jesus suffered and died on the cross for the sins of God’s people. He showed that God hates sin, but is full of love and mercy. Jesus shows us what God is like more than anything else because Jesus is God.

Bible Truth 4 Bible Verse: John 14:9

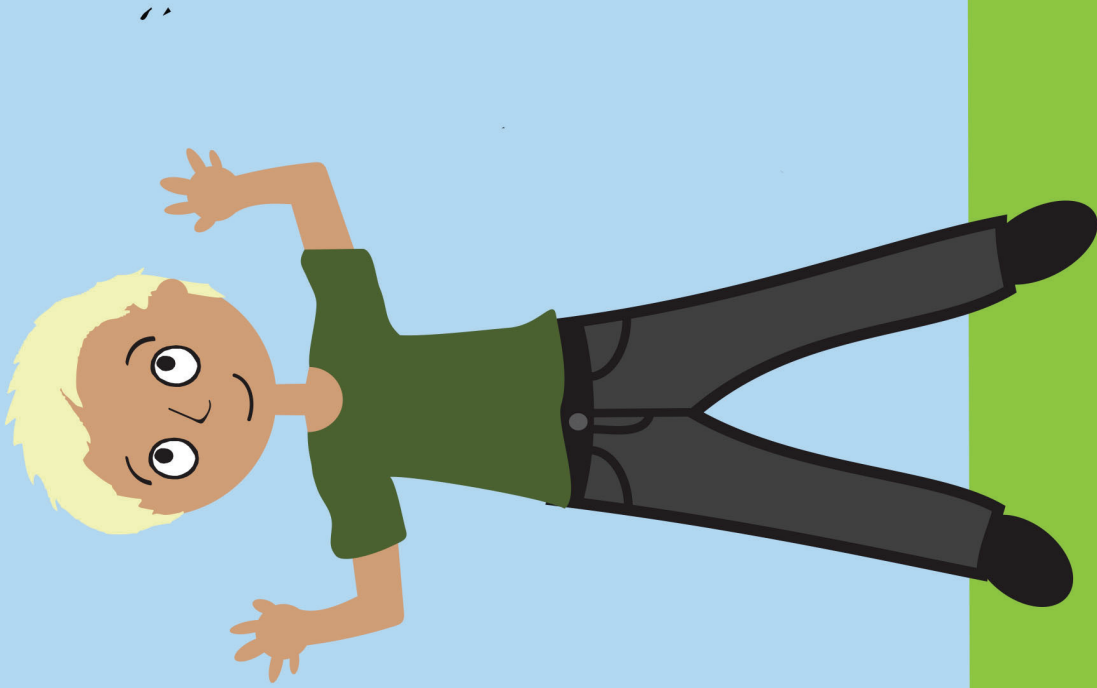

The Big Question

*Hold up the Big Question sign for all the children to see,
and say:*

The Big Question we are investigating today is

Big Question Number 1:

How Can I Know What God Is Like?

and the Answer is:

He Shows Me What He's Like!

Meaning:

"God made us. He wants us to know what He is like so we can know Him, love Him, and praise Him.

God shows us what He is like by the heart He gave us to know and love Him; through all of His creations we see around us; through His Word, the Bible; and most of all, through His very own Son, Jesus Christ."

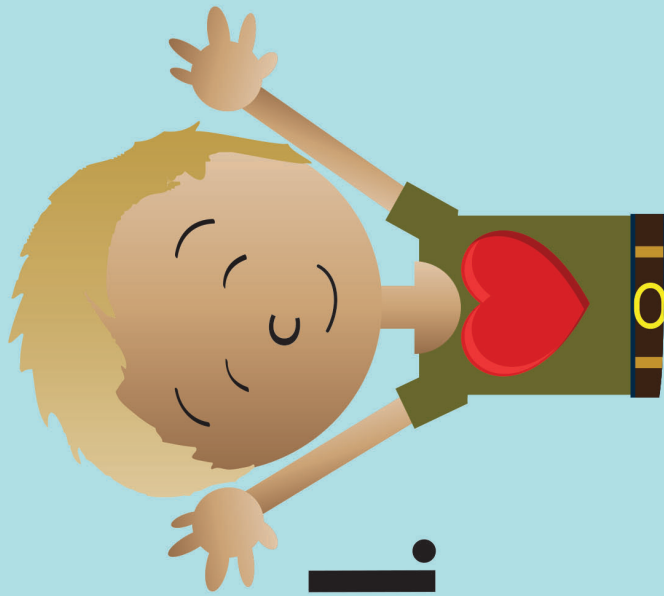

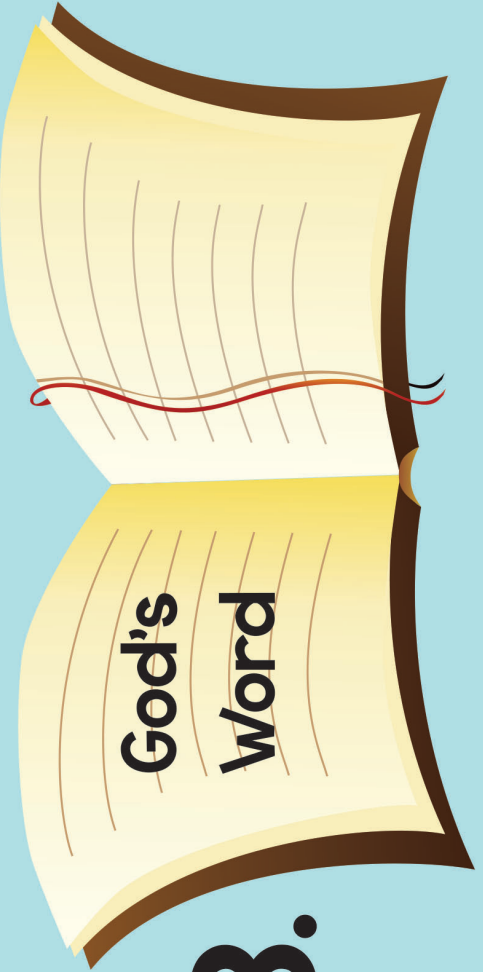

This Unit's Bible Truths

"God shows me what He's like" is a good beginning, but there's so more to learn. So it's time for us to dig down even deeper for more answers to our Big Question about God. We're going to be learning **FOUR** Bible truths that all tell us something about how God shows us what He's like.

Who would like to hand me the picture with our four Bible truths on it? It's in the Big Question Box/ Briefcase?" *Choose a child to get it out and hand it to you, then hold it up and show them the pictures with the four truths they will be learning.*

After everyone has had a good look, say...

"Ok, we've learned three ways God shows us what He's like already. They are: God shows me what He's like through the heart He gave me to know and love Him; God shows me what He's like in everything I see all around me; and, God shows me what He's like in the Bible, the perfect Word of God (point to pictures as you identify each Bible Truth).

Now let's look at our Bible Truth Clue and see if we can figure out which of these four truths we will be learning about today. Who would like to get it out of the Big Question Briefcase for me?"

Choose a child to open the briefcase, take out the Bible Truth Clue and hand it to you.

Revealing the Bible Truth

We Are Learning

Hold up the front side for the children to see. Cover up the answer, written along the bottom, and say:

**“How Do I Know What God Is Like?
He Shows Me What He’s Like...
through His very own Son, ?????!”**

We’re missing one word. Here’s the hint to what the missing word is. It says: “What do we love with?”

Can you guess? It’s our heart.

So the Bible Truth we are learning today is:

(uncover answer from bottom of sign, show it to them and say:)

**“How Do I Know What God Is Like?
He Shows Me What He’s Like...
through His very own Son, JESUS CHRIST!”**

(read the meaning off of the back of the sign, say:)

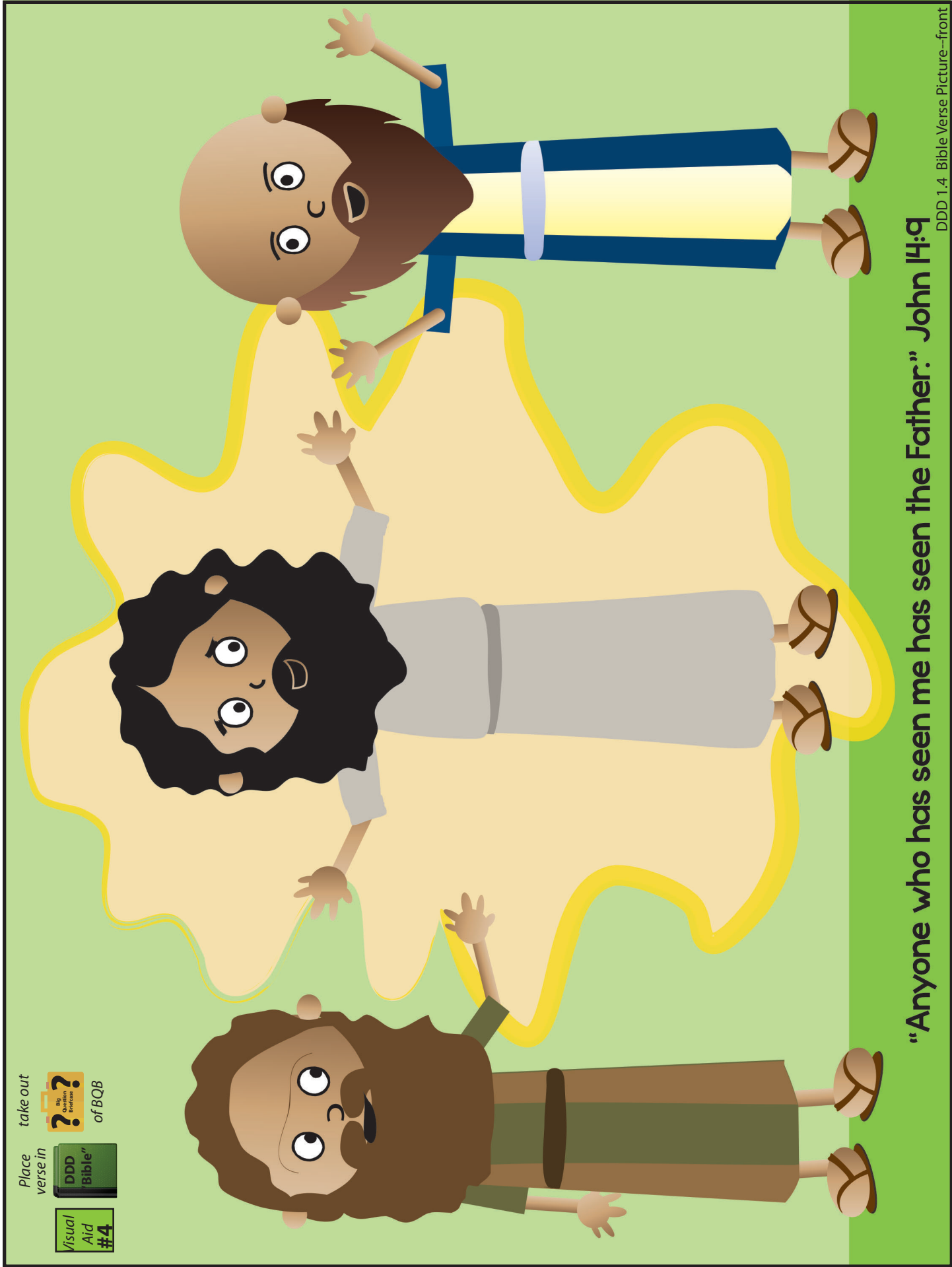

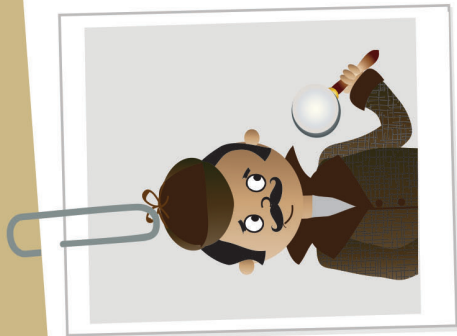

I. Jesus' disciples and many others gathered by the Sea of Galilee to hear Jesus teach. Jesus sat out in a boat on the bouncy water, so everyone could see Him and hear Him. All day long, Jesus taught them.



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2. All day was a time to listen, but Jesus was worth it! He was a One-of-a-Kind Man. No one had ever taught what He taught, or done what He did.

Jesus healed the sick and brought the dead back to life! He even forgave sins. Jesus could do these things because He wasn't just a man. He was God's Son, perfect and power-Full!

When you were with Jesus, you knew what God was like.

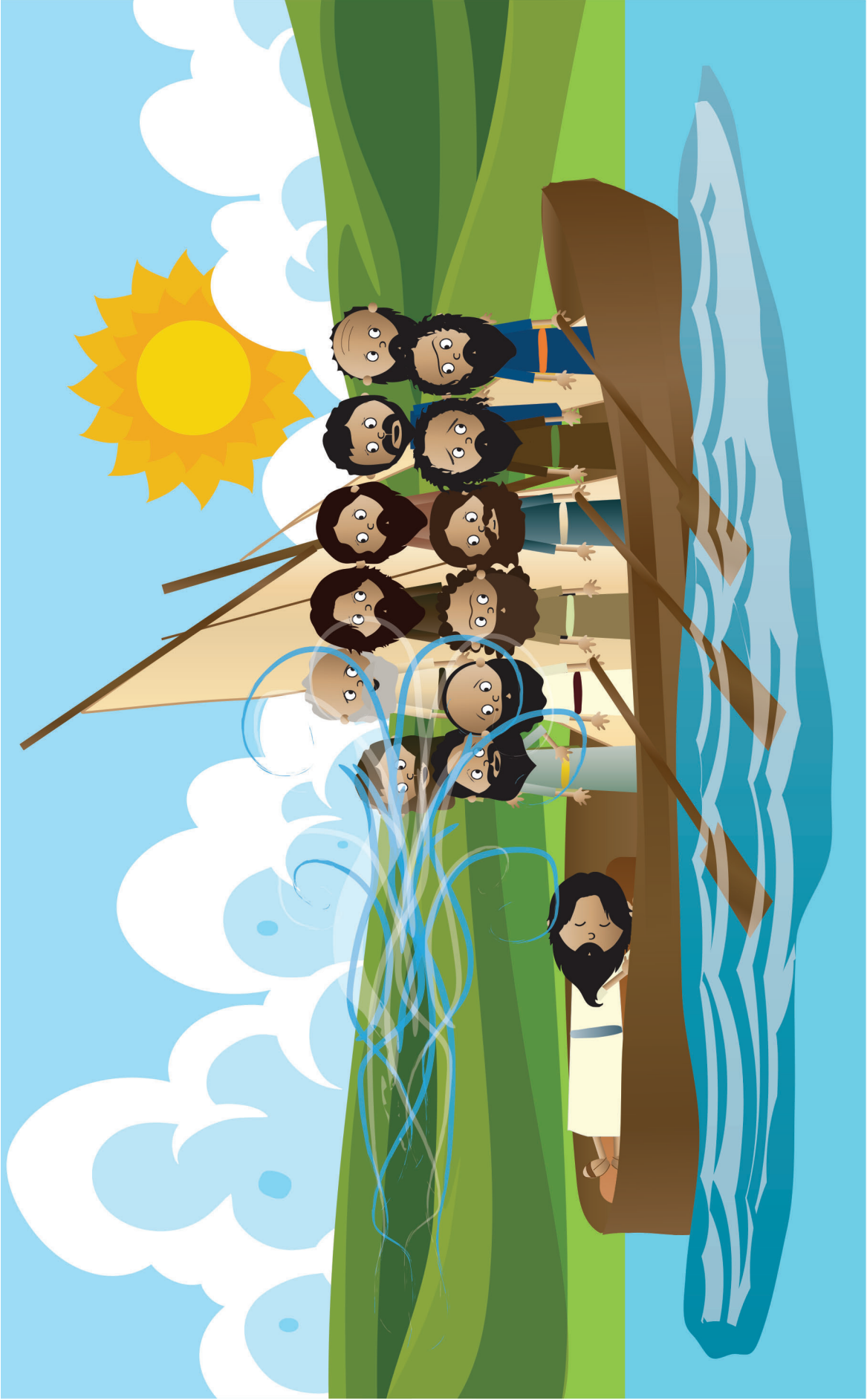


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3. At the end of that long day, Jesus said to His disciples, “Let’s sail to the other side of the lake.”

The disciples raised the sails and rowed the boat. A sweet wind was in the air and the water was calm. It must have felt good to move after standing and listening all day.

But Jesus was very tired after all His work. He lay down in the back of the boat and soon fell asleep.



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4. Suddenly everything changed! Down from the hills, a big, powerful wind began to blow. “Whoosh!,” it went across the lake and tossed up the water.

The little waves became bigger and bigger. “Crash!” went the strong waves on the side of the boat. “Whoosh!” went the strong wind in the sails. The waves weren’t just hitting the boat, they were coming in the boat! Would it sink?



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5. Everyone was so scared! Well, not EVERYONE! Jesus just kept sleeping right through the big storm. He wasn't worried. God, His Father, would take care of them. He planned to use this big storm to show the disciples that Jesus really was His Son.

"Do something! or we will drown!" Jesus' disciples shouted to Jesus.

Jesus did something. He stood up and said, "Peace, be still."



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6. What happened next was simply amazing. The wind stopped its whooshing and the waves stopped their crashing. Everything was quiet and still as it could be.

“Who is this Jesus, that the wind and waves obey His word?” asked the disciples.

But even as they asked, they knew. Only God could do this. Jesus really was a One-of-a-Kind Man. He really was the Son of God.

Because Jesus is God! Yes, Jesus is God's Only Son.


For You and Me:
