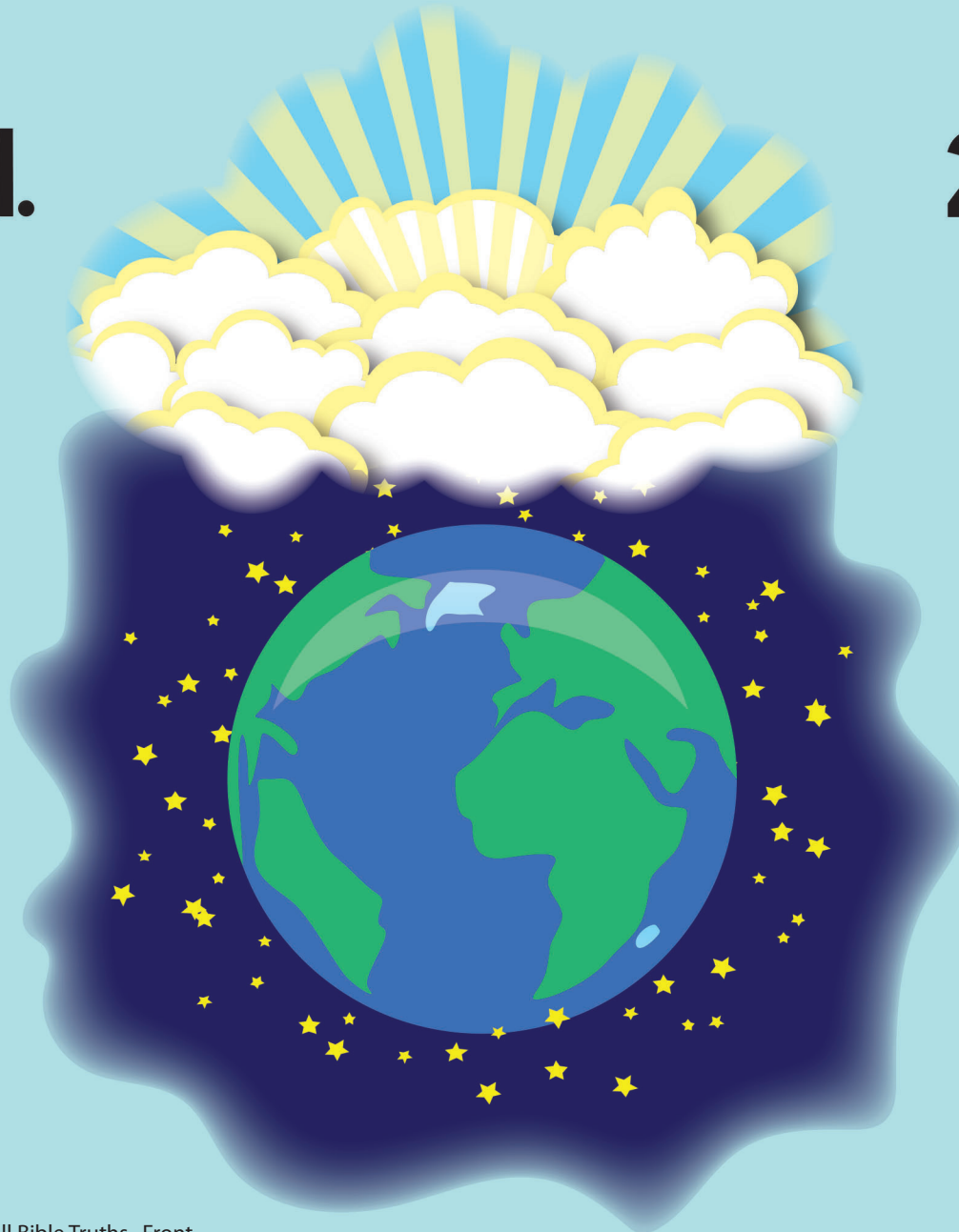

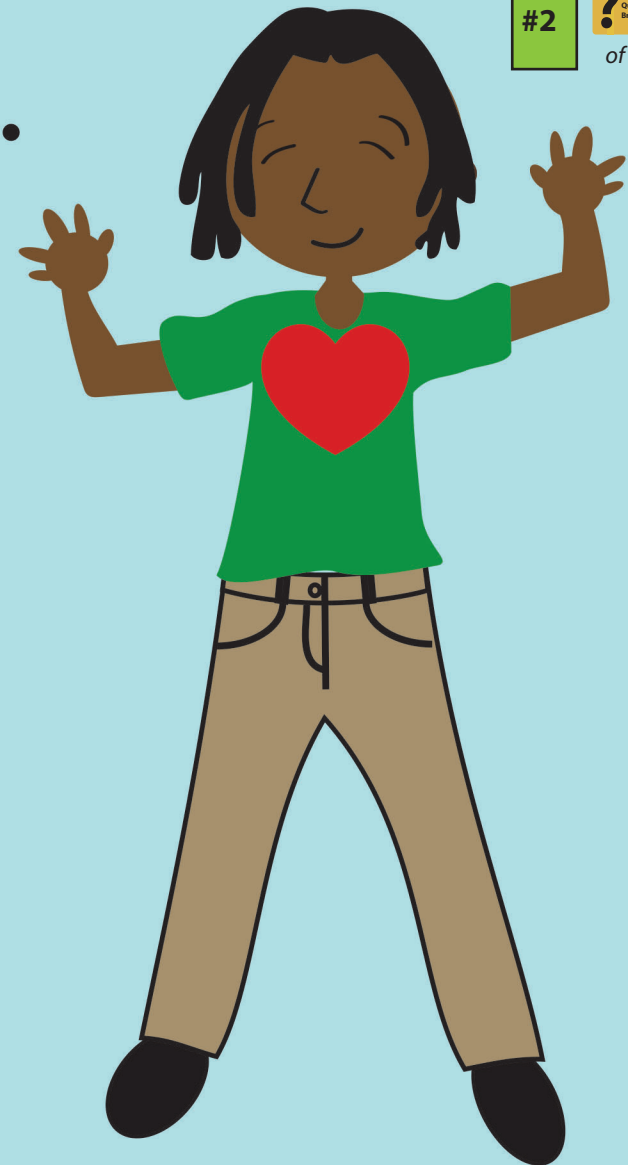
BIG QUESTION 5: Two truths about what the LORD made

This Unit's Bible Truths

"God made all things good" is a good beginning, but there's so more to learn. So it's time for us to dig down even deeper for more answers to our Big Question about God. We're going to be learning TWO Bible truths that all tell us more about the good things that God made.

Who would like to hand me the picture with our four Bible truths on it? It's in the Big Question Box/Briefcase."

Choose a child to get it and hand it to you, then hold it up and show them the pictures of the four truths they will be learning.

After everyone has had a good look say...

"Ok, we've learned one truth about the LORD. It's this one: "He Made Everything Good in Heaven and Earth" (point to pictures as you identify each Bible Truth). Now let's look at our Bible Truth Clue sign and see if we can figure out which of these four truths we will be learning about today. Who would like to get it out of the Big Question Briefcase for me?"

Choose a child to open the briefcase, take out the Bible Truth Clue sign and hand it to you.

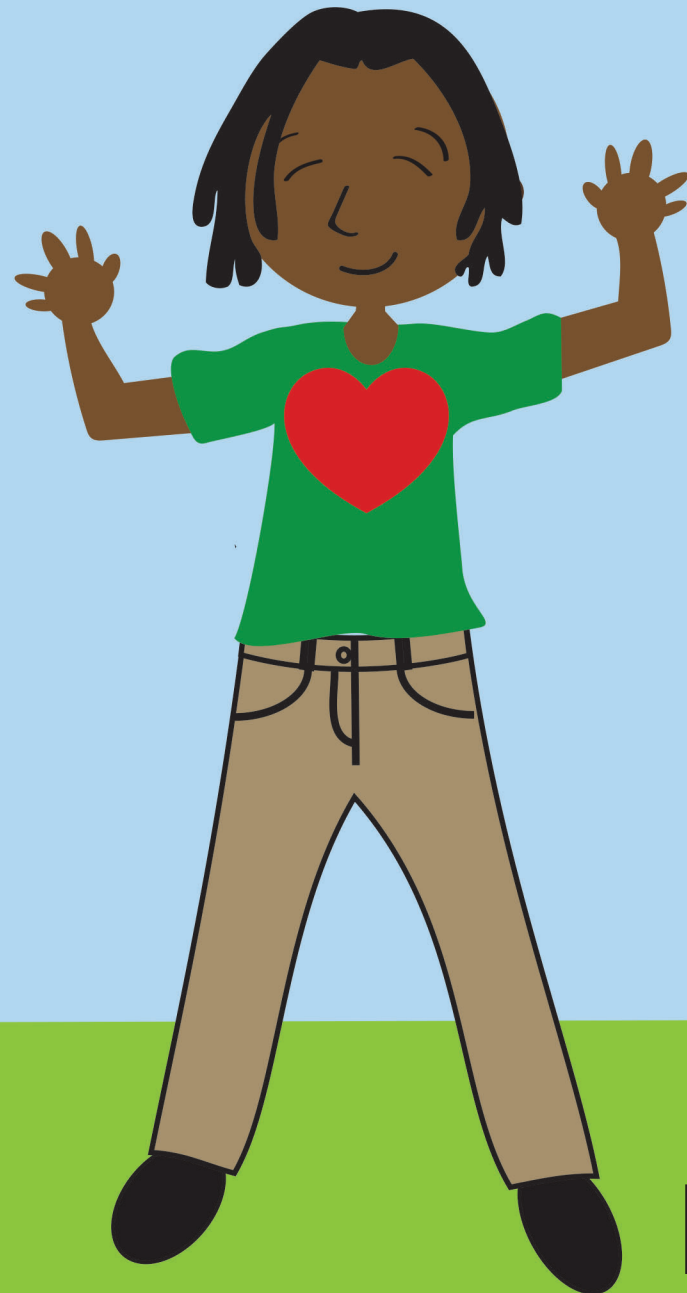

Revealing the Bible Truth We Are Learning

Hold up the front side for the children to see. Cover up the answer, written along the bottom, and say:

**“Can You Tell Me What God Made?
God Made All Things Good!
He Made ???? in a Special Way!”**

We’re missing one word. Here’s the hint to what the missing word is. It says: “What are we called? It starts with an “p” and it rhymes with “steeple.”

Can you guess? It’s “People.”

So the Bible Truth we are learning today is:

(uncover answer from bottom of sign, show it to them and say:)

**“Can You Tell Me What God Made?
God Made All Things Good!
He Made PEOPLE in a Special Way!”**

And here is what this Bible Truth means:
(read the meaning off of the back of the sign, say:)

When God made people, He made them good, just like everything else that He made. But God made them good in a special way—in a way that was DIFFERENT from everything else He created. God gave people a living spirit, a bit like His.

It is with this special spirit that all people—even you and I—can enjoy God in a way no other creature can. With our spirit we can look at what God made and see how wonderful He is. With our spirit we can know and love God, and go on knowing and loving Him forever and ever, because this spirit will never die. Everyone who turns away from their sins and trusts in Jesus as their Savior, gets to have special closeness with God in their spirit right now. And one day, they will go to live with Him, loving and knowing Him forever. What an amazing gift God gave us when He made us with a spirit!

Bible Truth 2 Bible Verse

What does that mean?

Man, male and female: those are all words for men and women, boys and girls. The Bible tells us that God made people in the beginning. He made them in His image. That means that they reflect Him in a very special way. Of all the earthly creatures, they alone were created with a spirit, like God's Spirit, that can know and love God. God created people to be able to see God's glory in everything He made. And, He created them to care for the world He created as caretakers under Him.

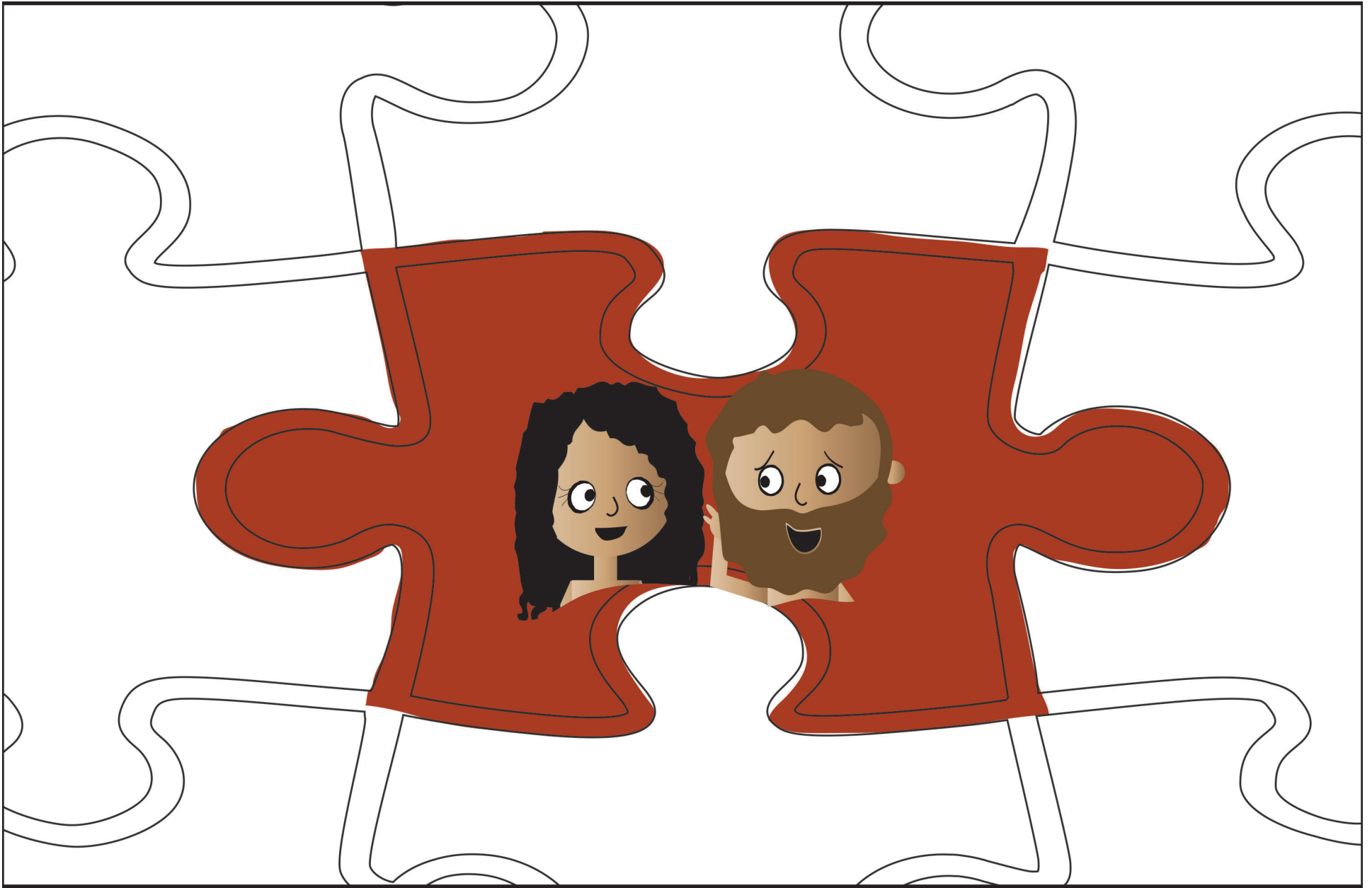

1. What a lot happened in the first, six days of the world! God made the heavens and the earth. He made light and darkness, and sun, moon, and stars. He made the seas filled with fish, the skies filled with soaring birds, and the land filled with every plant and animal you can think of. What a very busy place earth had become!



2. But Day Six wasn't over, and someone was missing. Someone very special. Someone who was at the very center of all God's plan for the world. Do you know who it was?



3. Why, it was people, of course! God's plan for the beautiful world He made would never be complete without people. **THEY** were whom He planned it for, that they might know and enjoy it, and Him, the God who made it all!



4. So, God made people. He took some of the clay dirt from the ground and He formed it into a man. Adam! Then, God breathed into Adam's nose the breath of life, and the man became alive.



5. Now, God made cats, and dogs, and kangaroos, and all the other animals, living creatures with bodies. He made all the birds, fish, and creepy-crawly bugs, living creatures with bodies, too. That's how they could meow and woof, leap and fly, swim and crawl, right? God made Adam a living creature in this way, too. He gave Adam a body that could climb, and swim, and crawl and do so many other wonderful things.



6. But, God put something **INSIDE** Adam's body that made him alive in another, very special way. Alive in a way unlike any other creature. Alive in a way that made people (and only people) a bit like God, Himself. God made Adam with a living spirit: a special heart that could know and love God, and know and love other people. And with this heart, Adam could **SEE** the greatness and goodness of God in everything God had made. And, guess how long this spirit would live...

7. Forever and ever! Yes, that's right! This spirit would never die, no matter what! This spirit God gave people was very special, indeed. It's how God made people in His image. God is spirit, and He gave people a spirit, too. This is what makes us a one-of-a-kind picture of God. And, it's why we can know and love God in a way no other creature on earth can.



8. So, when God made Adam, Adam opened his eyes and he saw the beautiful things God had made, and he was **AMAZED!** Amazed at all the furry animals, the chirping birds, the buzzing insects, and the flopping fish. Amazed at the lovely, green trees with delicious fruit, and the wonderful smell of the colorful flowers. Amazed at the warm sun that shone brightly at day; and, the soft light of the moon and twinkling stars at night. What beautiful things God had made! And most amazing of all, was knowing God with the spirit God gave him. Adam talked with God. He loved God and obeyed Him. And Adam was so very, happy.



9. Adam was happy, but something wasn't quite right. He was all alone. He wanted another creature to live with him. So, God brought all the creatures to Adam to name them and let him see if one of these creatures was what he wanted. Animals like lions, dogs, monkeys, lizards, horses, and cats; bears, chickens, kangaroos, ladybugs, and many more, paraded in front of Adam. They all came to him, and he named them all.



10. But one after one, Adam looked at them and shook his head. None of them was right to be a special someone for him. Did God forget something? Had He made a mistake? No, God didn't forget anything. He hadn't made a mistake. God knew Adam would long for someone else. God had even made Adam this way. God knew just exactly whom Adam needed, and He was about to give him that special creature.



II. God took Adam and put him into a very deep sleep. And while Adam was sleeping, God took a rib from Adam's side and formed it into a woman --Eve. God gave her the same, special heart that He had given Adam.



12. When Adam woke up, there the woman stood in front of him. Adam was so pleased! Here was just the right helper and friend for him! She was like him, yet different, too. They could love each other and love God together. They could talk together and share all the wonderful things God had created.

13. God gave the happy man and woman jobs made just for them: "Have a family and fill the earth with people," God commanded them. "Take care of all the creatures. Rule over all the earth. Explore it and make it all into your home," He told them.



14. Then, the LORD put Adam and Eve in a beautiful, garden home, filled with good fruit to eat. "Obey Me and love Me," God told them. "If you do, you will always have wonderful, special closeness together, with Me and with each other; and, you shall live happily in this beautiful place forever," He told them.

15. How wonderful that first day together must have been for Adam and his wife, Eve! They could enjoy everything together: God's creation around them; the love they had for each other; and best of all, that wonderful, special closeness with God, deep in their hearts.
