How Are They Used?



The Deep Down Detectives Visual Aids book is a companion resource to be used alongside the Deep Down Detectives Core Curriculum book for each unit. These colorful pictures are used in presenting the key concepts; telling the Bible stories; and, in playing the Bible Story Review games.

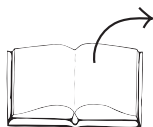
What Do They Include?



There are four different resources included in this book:

- 1. Key Concept Visual Aids**-- colorful signs of the Big Question and Answer, the Bible Truth, the Bible verse, and the Listening Assignments to use with the 3 lessons for each Bible Truth.
- 2. The Story Scenes, themselves.** Notice that each scene is numbered and that there is a brief summary of the story that corresponds to the picture. You can actually just tell the story in a simple way by using only the text at the bottom of each Story Scene.
- 3. Directions** for making the Deep Down Detectives "Bible" Folder and the **back/front images** to paste in place when making it. (Larger back/front images are found online with the curriculum.)
- 4. Directions** for how to make a homemade flannelgraph storyboard and sturdy Story Scene pictures are found in the back of this book.

Ready, Set, Rip It Out!



This book is meant to be ripped up and made into your visual aids. The key concept signs can be cut out and laminated or slipped into sheet protectors. The Story Scenes can be put in sheet protectors or laminated, too.

Store It!



Deep Down Detectives is a curriculum that can be used over and over. Store your visual aids and storyboard pictures after using them and they will serve you for many years. We store ours in manilla envelopes and then put them (along with all the rest of the curriculum) in magazine files, labelled by Bible Truth. If you have multiple classes using the curriculum, store each set of resources in separate manilla envelopes. This will make prep much simpler, second time around.

You can always purchase this book again or simply go online and print out any scenes that go missing.

Other Options



You can also choose to tell the story in a more traditional flannelgraph way by using your own flannelgraph figures or by purchasing/free downloading the Storyboard Pictures (large and small format size available). This is more complex and requires more preparation, but some love it. And, it does allow for kids to interact more by helping to place pictures up on the board as you tell the story.

Unit Big Question (and Answer): Can You Tell Me What God Made? God Made All Things Good!

Unit Bible Verse: “In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth...God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good.” Genesis 1:1,31

Bible Truth 2 Concept: God Made All Things Good... God Made People in a Special Way!

When God made people, He made them good, just like everything else that He made. But God made them good in a special way—in a way that was DIFFERENT from everything else He created. God gave people a living spirit, a bit like His.

It is with this special spirit that all people—even you and I—can enjoy God in a way no other creature can. With our spirit we can look at what God made and see how wonderful He is. With our spirit we can know and love God, and go on knowing and loving Him forever and ever, because this spirit will never die. Everyone who turns away from their sins and trusts in Jesus as their Savior, gets to have special closeness with God in their spirit right now. And one day, they will go to live with Him, loving and knowing Him forever. What an amazing gift God gave us when He made us with a spirit!

Learn a Little: God created man in his own image... male and female he created them.”

Meaning

Man, male and female: those are all words for men and women, boys and girls. The Bible tells us that God made people in the beginning. He made them in His image. That means that they reflect Him in a very special way. Of all the earthly creatures, they alone were created with a spirit, like God’s Spirit, that can know and love God. God created people to be able to see God’s glory in everything He made. And, He created them to care for the world He created as caretakers under Him.

Story-telling Tips

Ahead of time:

1. Read the Bible verses and story. Pray!
2. Choose story action cues and/or prepare storyboard figures, if using. (Included in Visual Aids book)
3. Practice telling story with the storyboard pictures, timing your presentation. Shorten, if necessary.

During your presentation:

1. Maintain as much eye contact as possible as you tell the story.
2. Put up storyboard figures/add story action cues as you tell the story. Allow the children to help you put them on the board, if desired.
3. Include the children in your story with a few questions about what they think will happen or words/concepts that might be new to them.
4. Watch the kids for signs that their attention span has been reached. Shorten, if necessary.

INTRODUCTION/ LISTENING ASSIGNMENTS

Hold each of them up for the children to see as you identify them.

I need to know:

- 1. Which four belong in the story and which two don't?**
- 2. Who did God create with a special ability to praise Him, know Him and love Him?**

Read the assignment questions, THEN SAY,

"Ok, Deep Down Detectives! Put on your best listening ears and see if you can hear the answers to Detective Dan's questions. When I finish telling the story, we will see if we can answer all the questions."

Read the Bible Truth story, answer questions, present the gospel and lead in prayer.

Answers to questions; the gospel; and, ACTS prayer are included with the story text.

The Case of the Clay Creation *Genesis 1,2*

What a lot happened in the first, six days of the world!

God made the heavens and the earth. He made light and darkness, sun, moon and stars. He made the seas filled with fish, the skies filled with soaring birds, and the land filled with every plant and animal you can think of. What a very busy place earth had become!

But someone was missing. Someone very special. Someone who was at the very center of all God's plan for the world. Do you know who it was?

Can you tell me?

Why, it was people, of course!

God's plan for the beautiful world He made would never be complete without people. THEY were whom He planned it for, that they might know and enjoy it, and Him, the God who made it all!

So, God made people. He took some of the clay dirt from the ground and He formed it into a man. Adam! Then, God breathed into Adam's nose the breath of life, and the man became alive.

Now, God made cats, and dogs, and kangaroos, and all the other animals, living creatures with bodies. He made all the birds, fish, and creepy-crawly creatures living creatures with bodies, too. That's why they could meow, and woof, and leap, and fly, and swim, and wriggle, right?

God made Adam a living creature in this way, too. He gave Adam a body that could jump, and run, and dance, and do so many other wonderful things.

But, God put something INSIDE Adam's body that made him alive in another, very special way. Alive in a way unlike any other creature. Alive in a way that made people (and only people) a bit like God, Himself.

Do you know what the something special God would put inside of people?

God made Adam with a living spirit: a special heart that could know and love God, and know and love other people. A special heart that could SEE the greatness and goodness of God in everything God had made. Can you guess how long this special spirit would live?

Can you guess?

Forever and ever! Yes, that's right! This spirit would never die, no matter what! This spirit God gave people was very special, indeed. It's how God made people in His image. God is spirit, and He gave people a spirit, too. This is what makes us a one-of-a-kind picture of God. And, it's why we can know and love God in a way no other creature on earth can.

So, when God made Adam, Adam opened his eyes, and he saw the beautiful things God had made, and he was AMAZED!

He was amazed at all the furry animals, the chirping birds, the buzzing insects, and the flopping fish. Amazed at the lovely, green trees with delicious fruit, and the wonderful smell of the colorful flowers. Amazed at the warm sun that shone brightly at day; and, the soft light of the moon and twinkling stars at night. What beautiful things God had made! And most amazing of all, was knowing God inside his special heart. Adam talked with God. He loved God and obeyed Him. And Adam was so very, very happy.

Adam was happy, but something wasn't quite right. He was all alone. He wanted another creature to live with him. So, God brought all the creatures to Adam to name them and let him see if one of these creatures was what he wanted. Animals like lions, dogs, monkeys, lizards, horses, and cats; bears, chickens, kangaroos, ladybugs, and many more, were paraded in front of him. They all came to Adam, and he named them all.

But one after one, Adam looked at them and shook his head. None of them was right to be a special someone for him. Did God forget something? Had He made a mistake?

What do you think?

No, God didn't make a mistake. He didn't forget anything. God knew Adam would long for someone else. God had even made Adam this way. God knew just exactly whom Adam needed, and He was about to give him that special creature.

God took Adam and put him into a very deep sleep. And while Adam was sleeping, God took a rib from Adam's side and formed it into a woman--Eve. God gave her the same, special heart that He had given Adam.

When Adam woke up, there the woman stood in front of him. Adam was so pleased! Here was just the right helper and friend for him! She was like him, yet different, too. They could love each other and love God together. They could talk together and share all the wonderful things God had created.

God gave the happy man and woman jobs made just for them: "Have a family and fill the earth with people," God commanded. "Take care of all the creatures. Rule over all the earth. Explore it and make it all into your home."

"Obey Me and love Me," God told them. "If you do, you will always have wonderful, special closeness together, with Me and with each other, and you shall live happy in this beautiful place forever," He told them.

How wonderful that first day together must have been for Adam and his wife, Eve! They could enjoy everything together: God's creation around them; the love they had for each other; and best of all, that wonderful, special closeness with God, deep in their hearts.

Even from before the beginning, even when there was only a BIG NOTHING, God knew what would happen and He planned to save sinful people! And so, He did. At just the right time, God sent Jesus, His very own, dear Son, to suffer and die on the cross, taking their punishment for sins. On the third day, Jesus rose from the dead, showing He had beaten sin and death. Now, all who would turn away from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior, will be forgiven their sins. God will give them new hearts to know and love Him. And one day, when they die, they will get to live with Him. And that new place where they will live with Him will be even more wonderful than the beautiful heaven and earth God made in the beginning! We can live there with God, too, if we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Ask God to help you. He loves to answer this prayer.

This Unit's Bible Truths
