

# Session Prep (especially good for newbies!)



Pray for the Holy Spirit to be at work in your and the children's hearts.

#### Review



If new to the curriculum, look at the **Getting Started with Deep Down Detectives section of the Core Curriculum book.** (p.5) It will be especially helpful to read through the Deep Down Detectives section of **The Praise Factory Tour: Extended Version Book.** This is a visual way to understand what goes on in the classroom. (A pdf of the book is found in the samples section on the website.)

### Look through and Learn the Lesson



Read over **lesson plan**. Practice any **songs or action rhymes** you are using. Choose/make up motions to go with these. Choose less with younger children and more with older preschoolers. **Practice the lesson with the visual aids** and using the Big Question Box/Briefcase.

### **Read and Rehearse the Bible Story with Pictures**



Read the Bible story from the Bible. Read the curriculum version. Practice telling it with the storyboard pictures. (If you have not previously laminated the story pictures, do that now.) Or, rehearse it from the Simple Story Scenes, if you are using those.

### Let There Be Music



Download the music and listen to the songs. Choose which of the songs you will use with the children. If using live musicians, make sure they have the sheet music (Appendix A, Core Curriculum book).

### **Put the Props in Place**



1. Prepare your Visual Aids. Put the Big Question, Unit Bible Truths, Bible Truth, Bible Verse, and Listening Assignment signs, as well as the Bible Story script in one side of the Bible folder.

2. Get out your storyboard. If using Simple Story Scenes, put these in your Blble Folder. Or, if using the individual storyboard figures, put all background pictures in place (they have a BG by the number). Put the rest of the storyboard pictures (these have a SB by the number) in order of use in the other side of the Bible folder.

3. Put the DDD Bible Folder as well as the Big Question sign in the Big Question Box/Briefcase and shut it. If your box/briefcase has locks and you want to use the unlocking the box as part of your session, lock it now....but make sure you have the key or know the code first.

4. Prepare the music CD or sheet music or mp3 device for use in your session.

## **Set Out Free Play Activities**



Choose and set up free time activities you will use with the children. Choose a variety of different activities that will be enjoyed by different types of children. Rotate the activities you provide to keep them interesting and fresh to your children. (Suggestions in Appendix D, Core Curriculum books.)

### **Prepare Any Activities**



Choose which (if any) of the Bible Truth games and crafts activities you want to use in the session. Bear in mind your time frame as well as the developmental abilities and attention span of your children as you decide which/how many to prepare. **Look over the Discussion Sheet** and choose a few questions you might use to spark discussion with the children as they do their activities (especially good for ages 3's+). Pray for God to give you opportunities to talk about these things with the children.

## Let Them Take It with Them



Make copies of the craft/take home sheets, if you are not already using them as one of your activities. You may also want to make copies of the story (see take-home version of each story included in Appendix C with the other take home resources) to have for parents to use with their children at home. There's a link on each craft/take home sheet to the story, if you don't make hard copies.

#### Store It



After your session is over, collect the resources and store them for future use. This curriculum can be used over and over for years to come.

## Unit 7: The Law-Giving God

Unit Big Question (and Answer): What Are God's Laws Like? God's Laws Are Perfect!

Unit Bible Verse: "The law of the LORD is perfect." Psalm 19:7

#### Bible Truth 1 Concept: God's Laws Are Perfect... They Are Written in the Bible, God's Word

A law is big rule that we are supposed to obey. God told His laws to godly people long ago. These people wrote them down in the Bible, God's Word, so everyone can know them. God's Holy Spirit helped them write them down just right. God's laws are the most important laws of all. They are rules that God wants everyone to keep. That's why God's people take time to learn God's laws and ask Him to help them obey them. They love God and want to please Him. They want to show the world what God is like by living the way He wants us to live.

#### Bible Truth 1 Bible Verse: Deuteronomy 5:1,7-21

"Hear, O Israel, the decrees and laws I declare... Learn them and be sure to follow them. You shall have no gods before me. You shall not make an idol in the form of anything. You shall not misuse the name of the LORD. Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy... Honor your father and your mother. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery... You shall not steal... You shall not give false testimony... You shall not covet... anything."

Learn a Little: "Hear...the laws...Learn them and be sure to follow them."

#### Meaning

Long ago, the LORD gave the 10 Commandments and many other good laws to the people of Israel. The Israelites promised to keep them. He would be their God; they would be His people. He would bless them and take care of them. These verses are the Ten Commandments (laws) that God gave them. But even though God gave these laws to the people of Israel that day, they are laws for all of us to keep. They tell us how God wants us all to live.

#### **Bible Truth 1 ACTS Prayer**

- **A** We praise You, God, for being the Giver of Your perfectly good laws.
- **C** God, we confess that we break Your good laws. Sometimes, we do not obey our parents. Sometimes, we lie. Sometimes, we want things that belong to others. You made us to be law keepers, but we are all lawbreakers. We need a Savior!
- **T** Thank You for giving us Your good laws, so we know how to love and obey You. Thank You for making sure they were written down just right in Your Word, the Bible. Thank You for sending Jesus to keep Your laws perfectly and make the way for people like us to be forgiven.
- **S** God, work in our hearts. Help us to turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Help us to learn Your good laws and obey them. Help us to love You by living for You and keeping Your good laws.

"Praise the LORD! He is the great, one, true God," the Israelites shouted. They had so much to celebrate! God had freed us from their enemies, the Egyptians. He was taking them to a new home, a very special place called the Promised Land. Moses would lead them there. How happy the Israelites were! Life would be good in God's Promised Land.

But before they could go to their new, beautiful home, there was somewhere else they had to go: to great Mt. Sinai, out in the desert. It was there the LORD would meet with them.

Can you guess what He wanted to do?

The LORD was going to make them His people. The LORD would promise to always take care of them and give them everything they needed. The people would promise to love and obey Him. This is how the people would become God's people. This is how they could live happily with the LORD and each other in the Promised Land. First, must come the promises; then, the Promised Land.

So tramp, tramp, tramp, they went, across the dry, dusty wilderness. How very hot the sun was, as it beat down on them! There was hardly a cloud in the sky, or a tree on the ground, to give them any shade. Day after day they traveled until at last, they reached Mt. Sinai --the very mountain where Moses had first met with the LORD.

And in the shadow of that mountain, they set up their camp. As they worked, Moses headed to the mountain. What was he going to do?

What do you think he was going to do?

Moses was climbing up to meet with the LORD.

"It's time to get the people ready to meet Me," the LORD told Moses. "I am holy, and the people are not. I can only meet with them if they are very, very careful. Tell them to set up fences around the bottom of this mountain, so that no animal or person will step foot on it. Have everyone take a bath and wash their clothes. Tell them to prepare their hearts for My coming," the LORD told Moses. "And tell them to do this in the next two days. On the third day, I will come to them."

Moses went back down the mountain and told the people what the LORD had said. There was much to do in two days! All that fence had to be put in place! All those people needed to take baths and wash their clothes! All those hearts must be made ready for the LORD!

Day One passed, then Day Two. Everything was completed. How exciting it must have been as everyone went to bed that second night! The LORD would meet with them the very next day. What would it be like?

What do you think it would be like?

#### Soon they would know!

Yes, sure enough, the next morning they found out. Sinai was usually a land of bright sunshine and cloudless days, but not this day. The people awoke to the sound of loud rumbles of thunder and a blaring trumpet blast. They peered out of their tents to find Mt. Sinai covered in thick clouds with great flashes of lightning. Everyone trembled with fear.

# Bible Story for Big Question 7, Bible Truth 1

Moses led the people out of the camp to the very foot of Mt. Sinai. They watched great, billowing clouds of smoke rise as the LORD descended on the top of the mountain in fire. They could feel the ground under their feet move as the whole mountain shook. The LORD, the one, true God, had come to meet with them! Moses went up the mountain to talk with the LORD.

The trumpet blasted louder and louder, as the LORD and Moses spoke together on the mountain. Then, after making sure the people stayed off the mountain one last time, the LORD spoke in a loud voice for all the people to hear. This is what He said to them:

"I am the LORD your God who rescued you from your enemies, the Egyptians. I want to make special promises to you. I will love you and take care of you. You will be My people. But you must make special promises to Me, too. You must keep My laws if you are to be My people. Here are My laws:

Worship Me alone. Don't make gods out of anything you see, in the sky or on the earth around you. Worship Me alone. I am the LORD. Honor My name. Don't misuse it. Keep one day a week (the Sabbath day) a day of worship and rest. Honor your father and mother. Listen to them and obey them. Don't murder anyone. Don't treat someone else's husband or wife as if they are yours. Don't steal and don't lie. Don't covet. Don't keep longing after something someone else has that you want. Be happy with what I give you."

Do you know what we call these Ten, Big Laws of the LORD?

### Can you tell me?

They are called the Ten Commandments.

When the people they saw the lightning and the whole mountain in smoke and fire, and they heard the crashing thunder, the loud, heavenly trumpet, and the voice of God, Himself, how do you think they felt?

### What do you think?

They trembled with fear! They stayed away from the mountain and said to Moses, "Speak to us yourself and we will listen. We will do whatever the LORD wants us to do. We want to be His people. But do not have Him speak to us. We are afraid we will die, we are so scared by His mightiness and holiness," they exclaimed.

"Don't be afraid," Moses told them. "The LORD hasn't come to hurt you. He has come in this mighty way so you will know what He is like and so you will not want to break the good laws He is giving you," he explained. "But I will go and meet with God for you, then I will come back down and tell you what He says."

Away went Moses once more. The people watched as he climbed up Mt. Sinai and disappeared in the thick, dark cloud to meet with the LORD. Up on the mountain, the LORD, Himself, wrote His 10 Big, Laws into pieces of stone and gave them to Moses. Then, the LORD told Moses many other laws to teach the people, so they could know how to love Him and love each other. "Write down all these laws, so the people will always know how to love and obey Me," the LORD said.

And that was what Moses did. He wrote down all of the LORD's good laws in Bible. God had Moses write them down, so that not just the Israelites, but all peoples, in all times, could know God's laws and how God's people should live. And so by those laws, we could get ready for the Savior. How? By showing us that none of us live as God requires. We all need a Savior, if we are to be God's people. That Savior was Jesus, God's very own Son! Jesus came and lived a perfect life. Only He obeyed all of God's laws. He gave His life as the full payment for the sins of all who turn away from their sin and trust in Him as their Savior. He died on the cross for them and rose from the dead in victory! 
