How Are They Used?



The Deep Down Detectives Visual Aids book is a companion resource to be used alongside the Deep Down Detectives Core Curriculum book for each unit. These colorful pictures are used in presenting the key concepts; telling the Bible stories; and, in playing the Bible Story Review games.

What Do They Include?

There are four different resources included in this book:



1. Key Concept Visual Aids-- colorful signs of the Big Question and Answer, the Bible Truth, the Bible verse, and the Listening Assignments to use with the 3 lessons for each Bible Truth.

2. The Story Scenes Placement Page--where to place the pictures on your storyboard.

3. The Story Scenes, themselves. Notice that each scene is numbered and that there is a brief summary of the story that corresponds to the picture. You can actually just tell the story in a simple way by using only the text at the bottom of each Story Scene.



5. Directions for making the Deep Down Detectives "Bible" Folder and the **back/front images** to paste in place when making it. (Larger back/front images are found online with the curriculum.) **Directions** for how to make a homemade flannelgraph storyboard and sturdy Story Scene pictures are found in the back of this book.

Ready, Set, Rip It Out!



This book is meant to be ripped up and made into your visual aids. The key concept signs can be cut out and laminated or slipped into sheet protectors. The Story Scenes can be put in sheet protectors or laminated, too.

Store It!



Deep Down Detectives is a curriculum that can be used over and over. Store your visual aids and storyboard pictures after using them and they will serve you for many years. We store ours in manilla envelopes and then put them (along with all the rest of the curriculum) in magazine files, labelled by Bible Truth. If you have multiple classes using the curriculum, store each set of resources in separate manilla envelopes. This will make prep much simpler, second time around.

Replacement Story Scene Pictures



You can always purchase this book again or simply go online and print out any scenes that go missing.

Other Options



You can also choose to tell the story in a more traditional flannelgraph way by using your own flannelgraph figures or by purchasing/free downloading the Storyboard Pictures (large and small format size avaiable). This is more complex and requires more preparation, but some love it. And, it does allow for kids to interact more by helping to place pictures up on the board as you tell the story.

Unit Bible Verse: "The law of the LORD is perfect." Psalm 19:7

Bible Truth 3 Concept: God's Laws Are Perfect... They Tell Us How to Love God and Others!

The LORD is the one, true God. He deserves our love. He made us to love Him more than anything else. Loving God is the most delightful thing we can do. God gave us His laws so we can know how to love Him. When we obey His laws, we are living out our love for Him.

God made us not just to love Him, but also to love each other. He gave His laws so we can know how to love each other. He tells us to treat others in the same loving way we want others to treat us. When we obey God's laws, we are living out God's love for others. And, we are showing them a little bit of what God is like, that they might seek to know and love Him, too.

Obeying God's laws is not just the right way to live. It is also the happiest way to live with God and with other people. God can help us obey His laws and live in love when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. He gives us a new heart filled with His Holy Spirit and helps us to live in love as He wants us to.

Meaning

Story-telling Tips Ahead of time:

- 1. Read the Bible verses and story. Pray!
- 2. Choose story action cues and/or prepare storyboard figures, if using. (Included in Visual Aids book)
- 3. Practice telling story with the storyboard pictures, timing your presentation. Shorten, if necessary.

During your presentation:

- 1. Maintain as much eye contact as possible as you tell the story.
- 2. Put up storyboard figures/add story action cues as you tell the story. Allow the children to help you put them on the board, if desired.
- 3. Include the children in your story with a few questions about what they think will happen or words/concepts that might be new to them.

4. Watch the kids for signs that their attention span has been reached. Shorten, if necessary.

INTRODUCTION/ LISTENING ASSIGNMENTS

"Our story is called: The Case of the Do's and Don'ts. Here is your listening assignment." Read from Detec-

tive Dan's Listening Assignment signs, but questions are summarized below:

Detective Dan's Lesson #1 Listening Assignment:

I need to know:

1. Who made up extra, little rules of do's and don'ts?

2. What did Jesus think of those extra do's and don'ts? What did Jesus say God's real laws help people do?

Detective Dan's Lesson #2 Listening Assignment: Our Bible Verse is Matthew 22:37-40:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

I need to know:

1. Which laws did Jesus tell people to obey?

2. Who is the only person to obey God's laws perfectly? How did He share His perfect life with us?

Detective Dan's Lesson #3 Listening Assignment:

I found six clues, but two of them are **NOT** in the story. They are: a pillow, a cup, two fish, a painter, a heart, and God's Ten, Big Laws. *Hold each of them up for the children to see as you identify them.*

Read the assignment questions, THEN SAY,

"Ok, Deep Down Detectives! Put on your best listening ears and see if you can hear the answers to Detective Dan's questions. When I finish telling the story, we will see if we can answer all the questions."

Read the Bible Truth story, answer questions, present the gospel and lead in prayer. Answers to questions; the gospel; and, ACTS prayer are included with the story text. The Case of the Do's and Don'ts

Rules! Rules! Rules! So many rules for God's people to keep! "Do this! Don't do that!" the teachers in Jesus' day (the Pharisees) taught the people. Of course, there were the Ten, Big Laws (the Ten Commandments) that God had given them through Moses. But there were so many more rules than that. Can you guess how many laws the Pharisees counted in God's Word for everyone to obey? Twenty? Fifty? Surely, not a hundred!

What do you think?

It was more than any of those guesses! It was 613! There were 248 DO laws and 365 DON'T laws.

But soon those 613 laws turned into even more, as the teachers made up extra ways they wanted God's people to live them out. They made up extra "DO's" like: "DO say a special prayer as you wash your hands when you wake up in the morning, or you won't please God." And extra DON'T's" like: "DON'T use the same spoon to stir milk and cook meat, or you won't please God." What a lot of rules! Oh, how they weighed down the people! Who could keep all these rules!

But then, Jesus came. He wasn't like any other teacher. He healed sick people without using any medicine! He brought dead people back to life again! He even forgave people's sins! Jesus simply spoke and God's power did these wonderful things through Him.

Jesus did other amazing things, too, like when He made the strong winds and the big waves of a huge storm at sea suddenly STOP and be calm at His command. And, when He fed a huge, hungry crowd of people with just two fish and five loaves of bread. Wow!

The news about Jesus spread quickly. Soon, many people were coming to Jesus. They came to have Him heal their sick family and friends. They came to see Him do amazing things. And, they came to hear what He had to say about God and His laws. Would Jesus be just like all the other teachers? Would He tell them to keep all those Do's and Don'ts? Would He give them lots of extra rules like the Pharisees did?

What do you think?

Soon, Jesus answered all of their questions.

One day, Jesus and a huge crowd of people climbed up, up, up a grassy mountain above the Sea of Galilee. When they reached the top, Jesus sat down and began to teach them about God's laws.

"God's laws are very important. They will last until the end of time. I have not come to get rid of even one of God's good laws," Jesus told the people. "Your teachers, the Pharisees, try to please God by adding lots of extra, little rules to God's good laws. They think all this rule-keeping will make them right with God, but it's not enough. You need something more than all their extra, little rules to please God. You will need a better righteousness than theirs, if youwant to be God's people," Jesus told them.

Oh, no! This didn't sound good at all! The Pharisees worked so hard to keep all 613 laws in the Bible! And, they made up all those hundreds of extra, little rules, to try to please God, too. How could ANYONE be better than the Pharisees? Was Jesus going to give them even MORE rules to live by? It sure sounded that way.

No, Jesus was not. "Your teachers are wrong about their extra, little rules. They just weigh down people. They don't help anyone live as God wants them to live," Jesus said. "I have come to fulfill God's law. I will teach you how to really live out God's laws to please Him," He told the crowds.

"The Do's and Don'ts in God's Word are about how we show love to God and others. These laws start in the heart with love, and they tell us how God wants us to live out that love with our whole lives," Jesus explained.

"Some people LOOK like they obey God's laws, but really, they are still breaking them," Jesus told the people. "They do the right thing on the outside, but in their hearts, they are angry or jealous or hateful. God doesn't just look on the outside. He sees inside every heart. He knows the sin that is hiding there. He knows when you are angry or jealous or hateful. What goes on inside your heart breaks God's laws, too," Jesus explained.

The people listened to Jesus and were amazed! Jesus wasn't at all like the other teachers they had heard before. He didn't just give them lots of extra, little rules. He helped them see that God's laws show them how to truly love God and others. As Jesus later said: "Love the LORD with all your heart, your mind, and yourstrength. Love others --even your enemies-- as much as you love yourself. Do to them only what you want them to do to you. If you do love the LORD and love others like this, you will be obeying all of God's laws, because that's what God's laws are really all about."

How about that! All of those 10 Commandments, and even all of those 613 laws, really added up to only two: love the LORD and love others. Amazing!

I wonder what people were thinking as they climbed down the mountain at the end of the day. Jesus had given them less rules to follow, but they were much harder than all those 613 Do's and Don'ts in God's Word, and all those extra, little rules of the Pharisees. Anyone could remember to wash their hands when they woke up in the morning or to use a different spoon when they stirred the milk and cooked the meat. But loving God and others from the heart... that was so hard! How could they ever keep their hearts from being angry or jealous or hateful towards others? How could they really love God most of all? Could they ever really keep God's laws? Could they ever please God and really love God's people, if this was how they must live? There seemed to be no hope.

What do you think?

Well, there WAS no hope, if they had to obey God's good laws of love on their own. But praise God, they did NOT! That's why God sent Jesus! Not just to TELL the people what it really means to live out God's laws. But to DO it, HIMSELF! Yes, Jesus lived out God's laws perfectly every day He lived here on earth. He always loved God most of all. He always loved people. In everything He thought, and said, and did, Jesus fulfilled God's law completely. He pleased God with His whole life. Jesus could do this because He was the perfect Son of God. He truly loved God, His Father, and He had come to be our Savior.

And what did the Pharisees think about what Jesus taught? They did NOT like it!

They did not like that Jesus said He was God's Son. They did not like what Jesus said about them and all of their extra, little rules. And so, the Pharisees and other enemies worked together to get rid of Jesus. They nailed Him to a cross to suffer and die, and to get rid of Him, once and for all.

But God was up to good, even in the bad plans of Jesus' enemies. For on that cross, Jesus offered up His perfect life as the full payment for the sins of all who would ever turn away from their sins and trust in Him as their Savior. He took their punishment and gave them His perfect life. Now, they could please God. Not with their own lives, but with His!

Jesus died and was buried in a cave-grave that sad day, but did He stay there?

What do you think?

No, He did not! On the third day, He rose from the dead. Jesus had really beaten sin and death for God's people!

After Jesus rose from the dead, He appeared to His followers and taught them more about God's good plans. Best of all, He told them about God's special gift to help them live out God's law from their hearts. Do you know what that special gift was?

Can you guess?

It was the Holy Spirit!

"I am going back home to heaven, but I will send you the Holy Spirit to live in your hearts," Jesus told His followers. "He will fill your hearts with love. He will help you love God most of all. He will help you love others, too. And He will stay with you your whole lives until the day you come home to live with Me forever," Jesus promised them.

And sure enough, not long after Jesus went up to heaven, He did send the Holy Spirit to live in the hearts of God's people! How they praised God! How happy they were!

God had been so good to them through Jesus! Jesus had lived a perfect life of love and given it to them, so they could be God's people. He had sent the Holy Spirit to live inside their hearts for the rest of their lives. He would change their hearts and help them to obey God's laws and love God and others.

And, how they looked forward to the day when they would go to live with Him forever! Then, God will make all things new, even their hearts. Then, they will love God and each other perfectly. And at last, God's laws will be perfectly fulfilled, even in them! We can become God's people, too, when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Ask Him to help you!


