


What's so special about the Bible?

# Unit 2 Bible Verse

"Who would like to get our Bible verse out of the Big Question Briefcase for me?"

Choose a child to open the briefcase, take out the "Bible" with the Bible Verse in it and hand it to you. Remove the Bible Verse Picture from the "Bible" (held in place by velcro) and hold it up for all the children to see, then say:

#### Psalm 18:30,46, ESV

"This God--His ways are perfect. The word of the LORD proves true. The Lord lives, and blessed be my rock, and exalted be the God of my salvation."

## **Meaning:**

The LORD is like no one else. He is the one, true God. Everything He does is absolutely perfect! Everything God says is perfect, too. It is flawless. Flawless is a big word that means perfect--without even a single mistake. No, not one! God always tells us what is right and true. His Word always proves true!

Where can we read God's Word? In the Bible! It alone is God's Word. That's why we take time each day to learn from the Bible. We want to hear from God--all the wonderful things about Him; what He has done for us through Jesus, His Son; and, what good things are in store for those who love Him and live for Him. Oh, how we want to praise the LORD when we read His Word! He is the living God. He is our Savior!



2. Mother Eunice had a little boy named Timothy. Grandma Lois and Mother Eunice loved Timothy and took good care of him. They gave him good things, like food, clothes, a bed, and even chores to do.





3. Most of all, Grandma Lois and Mother Eunice wanted Timothy to know and love God. They wanted Timothy to turn away from his sins and trust in Jesus as his Savior. So, they taught Timothy about God and the good news of Jesus from the the book like NONE OTHER---the Blble!



4. From the Bible, Grandma Lois and Mother Eunice taught Timothy: "Long ago, God created the whole world. God gave us His good laws to live by, but we have all chosen to disobey them. We need a Savior to save us from our sins. God sent that Savior—it's Jesus! Timothy, we hope you will ask Jesus to forgive your sins. 
