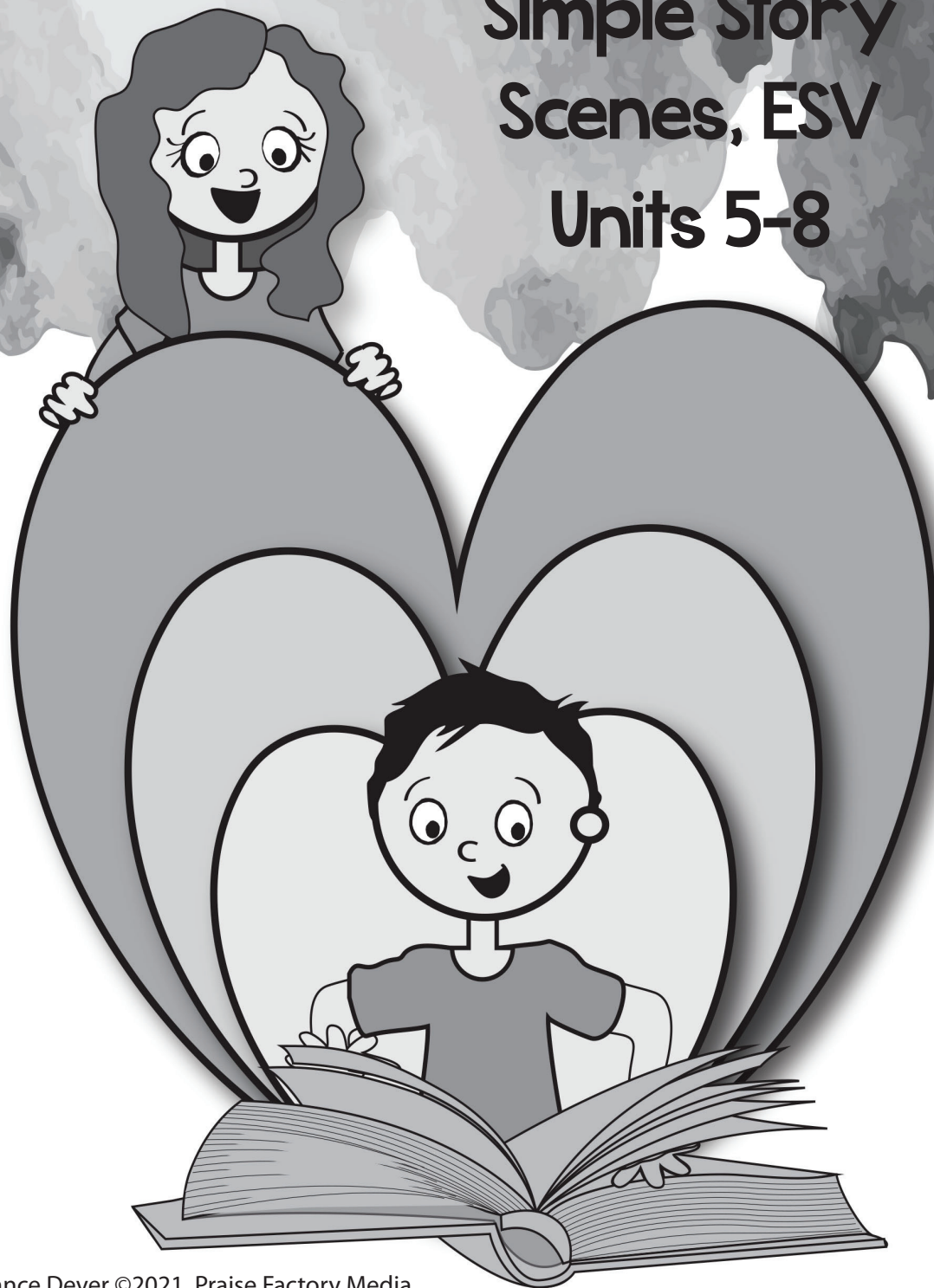

Introduce the Key Concept and Bible Verse

Give the Case Assignment

Give the children a Detective Dan listening assignment. Two are provided in this book. The full curriculum actually includes three more, with corresponding take-home sheets, if desired. using the ideas on the bonus, third take-home sheet, if desired. Each listening assignment, let's you teach the story with a different learning emphasis.

Show & Tell the Story

Hold up the pictures and tell the story from the story scenes. Alternatively, you can find in the and Pieces section for this unit at praisefactory.org, these same listening assignments and story scenes, gospel and ACTS prayer modified for view on a screen. Simply download them or open them online and show through your own monitor (tablet, big screen, whatever).

Solve the Case

Repeat Detective Dan's listening assignment question and discuss the answer.

Share the Gospel

Share the gospel tie-in with the kids.

Close in ACTS Prayer

Pray the ACTS prayer with the kids. If using the curriculum with older children, give them a chance to think up their own ACTS tie-ins to the story, using the one provided as cues/ideas for you.

Review Time

UNIT 5: God, the Good Creator

Unit Big Question (and Answer): “Can You Tell Me What God Made? God Made All Things Good!”

Meaning:

Did you ever wonder where everything in this world came from? All of the plants, animals and insects...the fish and birds...the sun, moon, stars and planets...the tall mountains and the beautiful oceans...the people here around us and the angels up in heaven? Did they just get here on their own? No, they did not! God made them. And when God made them, He made them good—perfect and without sin. He made them just right for His good plan for the world.

What was God’s good plan for the world? He planned for everything He made to show us what He’s like, so we could know how wonderful He is.

Unit 5 Bible Verse: Genesis 1:1,31, ESV

“In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth...God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good.”

Meaning:

Long, long ago, God made everything. He made everything in the heavens up above us--all the twinkly stars, the sun and moon and everything else.
