I. One night in Troas, Jesus spoke to Paul in a dream, "Go tell the Greek people about Me."



2. Paul obeyed Jesus. He and Silas sailed across the Mediterranean Sea to the big city of Philippi.



3. Many people went to Philippi to get rich from the nearby gold mines, but God wanted to give them another kind of riches.



4. God wanted them to hear the good news of Jesus that they might trust in Jesus their Savior and live for Him. They could become God's people, and THAT is FAR better than gold!



5. Paul and Silas shared the good news of Jesus with the people who gathered by the river. Some, like Lydia, listened and believed.



6. But back in town, others were angry. They didn't think Paul's gospel was good news at all! They hit Paul and Silas with big sticks and took them to jail.



7. Paul and Silas praised God that night. "We're happy we get to tell others about Jesus, even if we get hurt, We want people to hear how they can be saved. God will take care of us, even in jail."



8. Suddenly, everything began to shake. God had sent a HUGE earthquake. The walls of the jail tumbled down, the chains on Paul and Silas broke, and **THEY WERE FREE!**

"What must I do to be saved?" is the question, and it is so important because we all need to be saved.

For You and Me:

The jailer's question is the most important question for us, too. We all need to know how we can be saved. What was the answer Paul gave the jailer? Paul told him to turn away from disobeying God and to ask God to forgive his sins. He told the man to trust in Jesus as his Savior. This is called repenting and believing. The man did this, and he was saved! God will save us, too, if we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Ask Him to help you.
