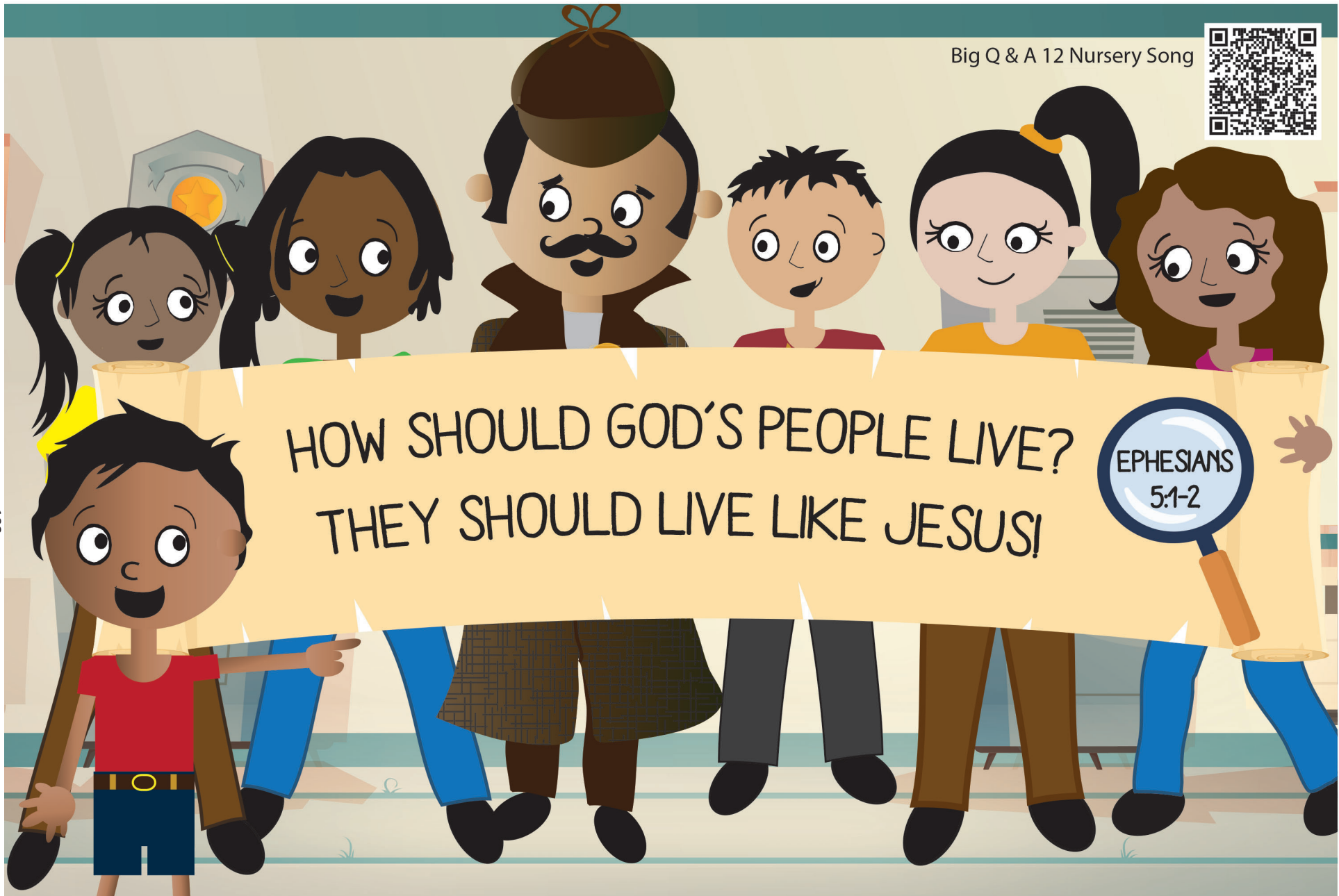


Walk in Love

Something to Grow Into



1. Philemon was a rich man with a family, a big house, and lots of workers. But most important of all, Philemon heard the good news of Jesus and believed. Here's how it happened..



2. Philemon travelled to a faraway city where he met Paul. Philemon heard Paul share the good news of Jesus. The Holy Spirit worked in his heart, and he believed. Now, he would live for God..



3. Philemon did things differently when he went home. "God, help me to live for You," he prayed. Soon, a little church of people gathered at Philemon's house to worship God and live for God.



4. Now, Philemon had a workers named Onesimus. He was so unhappy that he decided to run away from Philemon. Onesimus knew it was wrong to run away, but he did it anyway.



5. Onesimus ran away to Rome. Paul was in Rome, too. Paul shared the good news of Jesus with Onesimus. The Holy Spirit worked in his heart, and he believed in Jesus. Now, he would live for God.



6. Living for God was not always easy. "You must go back and make things right with Philemon. This is what pleases God," Paul told Onesimus. "Ask God to help you."



7. "I will help you, too," Paul told Onesimus. "I will write a letter to Philemon. Both of you love God and want to live for Him. That means loving and forgiving each other, too," Paul told him.



8. Onesimus knew Paul was right. Onesimus was scared to go home, but he loved God and wanted to live like Jesus. He took Paul's letter and headed home, trusting God to help him. And God did!

Onesimus ran away from working for Philemon.

2. Why did he run back?
When Onesimus believed in Jesus, his life changed. Now he lived for Jesus. That even meant going back to Philemon and asking his forgiveness for running away.

For You and Me:
Believing in Jesus means we should live for Jesus, too. God tells us in His Word, the Bible, how He wants us to live. Sometimes it means doing things we don't like to do, but that we know God wants us to do, just like Onesimus did when he went back to Philemon. And just like God helped Onesimus, He will help us to live for Him, too. It's His promise to all who turn away from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior. Ask Him to help you! He loves to answer prayers like this.

The Gospel

All of us were created to love God and others like Jesus did. But the sad news is that none of us do. We all have sinful hearts and choose to live our own way, instead of God's good way. That's why we all deserve God's punishment.

But even though we all deserve God's punishment, God is so merciful that He chose to send His Son, Jesus, to become a man and to be our Savior. Jesus lived a perfect life, and offered it up on the cross as the full payment for the sins of God's people.

Jesus died and was buried, but on the third day, He rose up from the dead. He had beaten sin and death for God's people.

We can become God's people when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. And if we do, God's Holy Spirit will come live inside us, helping us love God and live for Him. HE will help us live like Jesus! Then one day, we will go to live happily with God forever. That will be best of all!
