








The Hide 'n' Seek Kids took the clue from the magnifying glass, and read: "What's So Special about the Bible? Psalm 18:30."


Something to Grow Into






6. Timothy, the little boy, grew up and up and up until he become Timothy, the man. Now, he had a heart full of love for God, His Word, and His people.

C God, we know You are perfect and everything You say is true, but too many times we still don't trust You or obey Your Word. Please forgive us! We need Jesus to be our Savior!




