"Gospel means "good news." In the Bible, the gospel is the good news that God sent His Son, Jesus, to save sinners like you and me from the punishment we deserve for our sins. Jesus did this when He suffered and died on the cross, giving His perfect life as the full payment for our sins. This salvation is for all who turn away from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior. It is a gift God offers to us, too. Now that is good news, indeed!"

I. "Run away from Jerusalem!" the church leaders told the believers. "Jesus' enemies are after you! They will hurt you and put you in jail,". So, many Christians packed their bags and ran away.

4. Some went up to the tall mountains and made their home there. And what did they tell the people they met there? The gospel--the good news of Jesus!



5. Some even went to live in enemy lands. Philip went to the land of Samaria. And what did he tell the people? You guessed it! The gospel, the good news of Jesus.



6. Philip shared this good news: "We all disobey God's good ways. That's sin. We deserve God's punishment, but God sent His Son, Jesus, to save God's people. Jesus suffered and died on the cross to pay for their sins. Then, He rose from the dead. He beat sin and death for them. Trust in Jesus as your Savior, and live for Him! Become one of God's people, too." Philip urged them.



7. God did amazing things as Philip shared about Jesus. Sick people were healed by God's power. But best of all, the Holy Spirit helped many trust in Jesus as their Savior and live for Him. Philip and these new believers were so happy! The gospel was such good news!

In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.




T Thank You for sending Your dear Son, Jesus to be that Savior. Thank You for making the way for our sins to be forgiven.


