The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to Psalm 119:18, and read: “Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law.”



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this way God shows us what He's like?" he asked. "We think so. Only the Bible is God's Word. We can ask God to show us what He's like as we read about Him and His good rules (laws.)"

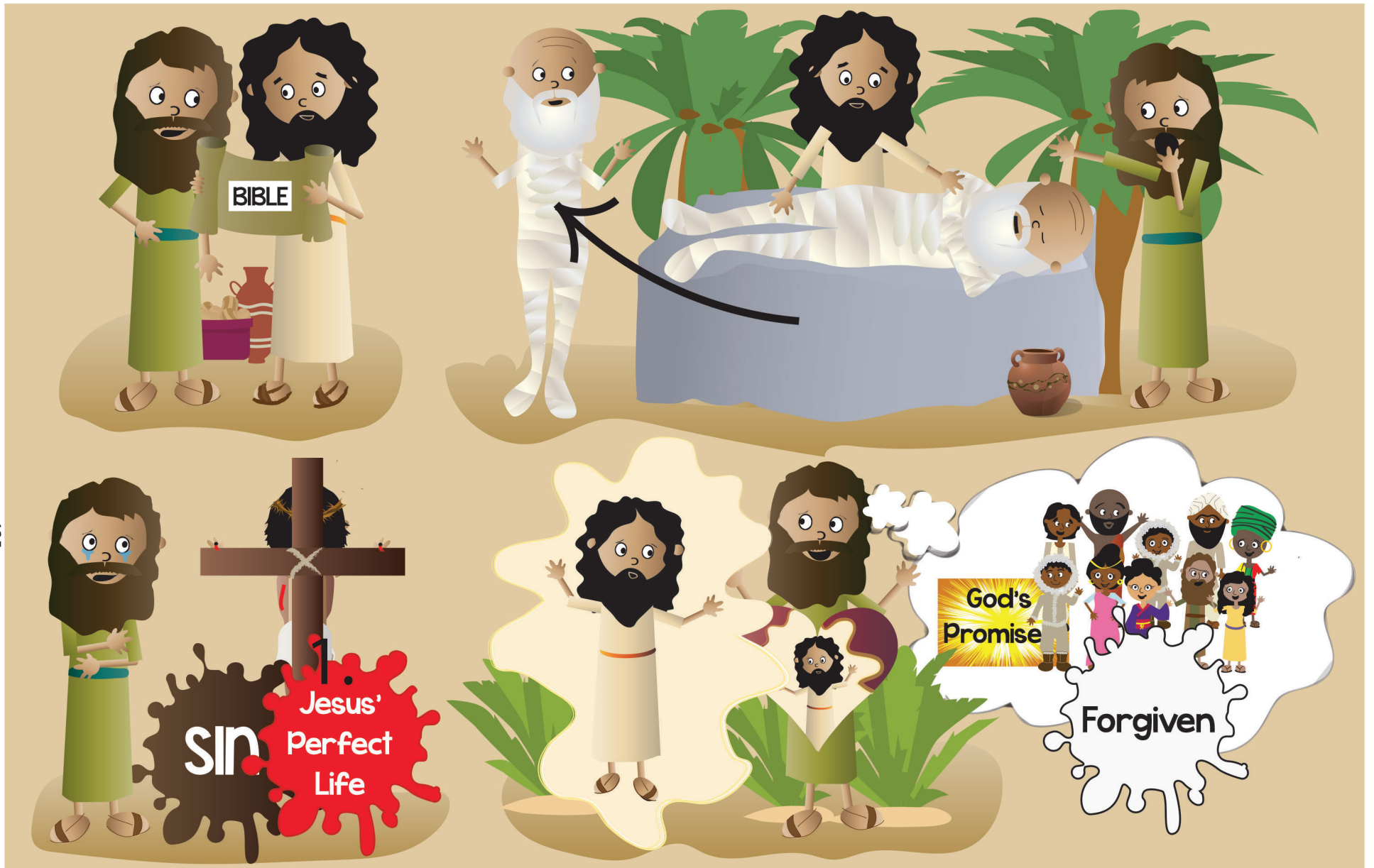

Something to Grow Into



I. God's Holy Spirit helped people write down His promises and laws and good works in the Bible. This is where we read the good news that Jesus came to pay for God's people's sins, so they could know God, and one day, live with Him in heaven forever.



2. Philip heard Jesus teach from the Bible, and saw the amazing things He did. When Jesus died on the cross, and rose from the dead, Philip believed Jesus was God's Son, the Savior God promised in the Bible to send.



3. Now, it was time to share the gospel of Jesus with everyone. Philip and Jesus' other followers started telling the good news to the people in Jerusalem; but, they didn't stop there.



4. Many went to faraway places to share the gospel. Philip went to a land called Samaria.



5. God sent an angel to give Philip a special job: "Go down the old road to Gaza." Philip obeyed. Soon, he saw a chariot with an important, African man in it. He was reading the Bible!



6. "Go talk to that man," the Holy Spirit told Philip. The man was reading one of God's promises about Jesus, but he didn't understand it. So, Philip got in the chariot and told him about Jesus. The Holy Spirit worked in the man's heart as he listened, and he believed.



7. "Here's water," the man said as they passed a stream. "Please baptize me! I choose to live a new life for God," the man said. Philip and the man waded into the water and Philip baptized him.



8. The African man was so happy! He understood the promises of God's Word. He believed in Jesus and had become one of God's people. He would go home and tell others about Jesus, too.

He was reading God's Word, the Bible. He didn't understand who the promises were about until God sent Philip to help him understand. The Holy Spirit worked in his heart and he was saved.

For You and Me:
Like the African man, God has given us His Word, the Bible. We can read it and learn about God's promises about Jesus in it. We can ask our teachers and our parents to help us understand what we hear. We can ask God to send His Holy Spirit to work in our hearts and help us to trust in Jesus as our Savior.

The Gospel

The man from Africa was so excited to hear about Jesus from God's Word, the Bible! He rejoiced to hear that God sent His Son, Jesus, to live a perfect life, and offer it as the full payment for the sins of God's people. Jesus did this as He suffered and died on the cross. On Day Three, Jesus rose from the dead, proving He had really beaten sin and death for God's people.

The African man turned away from his sins and trusted in Jesus as his Savior that day. He became one of God's people. This is how we can become one of God's people, too. And if we do, God will forgive our sins and we can know God in our hearts now. And one day, we will go to live with Him in heaven forever.

That will be best of all! Ask God to help you trust in Jesus. He loves to do this.

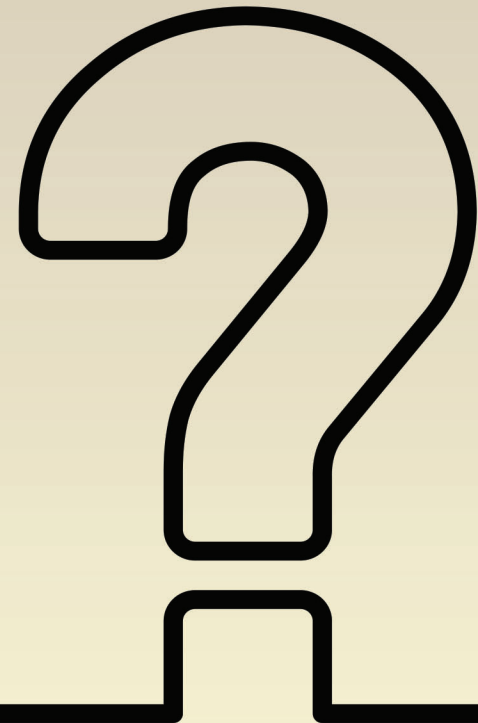

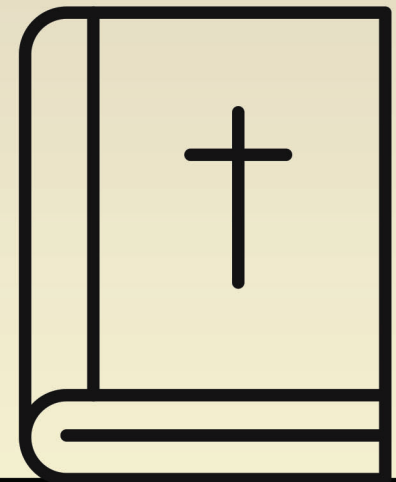

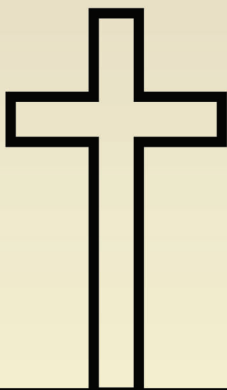
