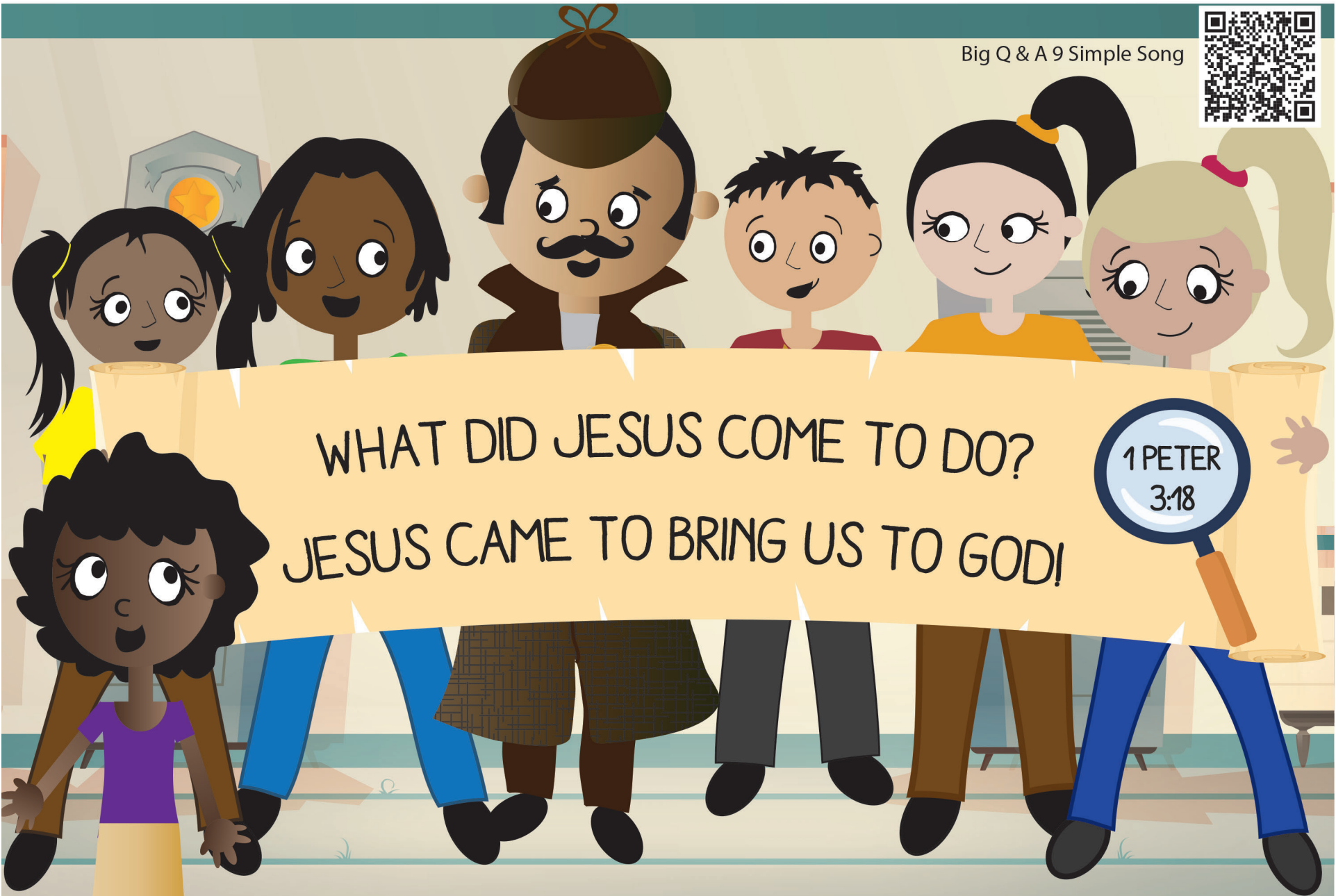


Christ Suffered

I. This story starts in heaven, where God is in all His glory. Heaven is filled with God's love and goodness, beauty and light. It is so perfectly wonderful that you never want to leave.



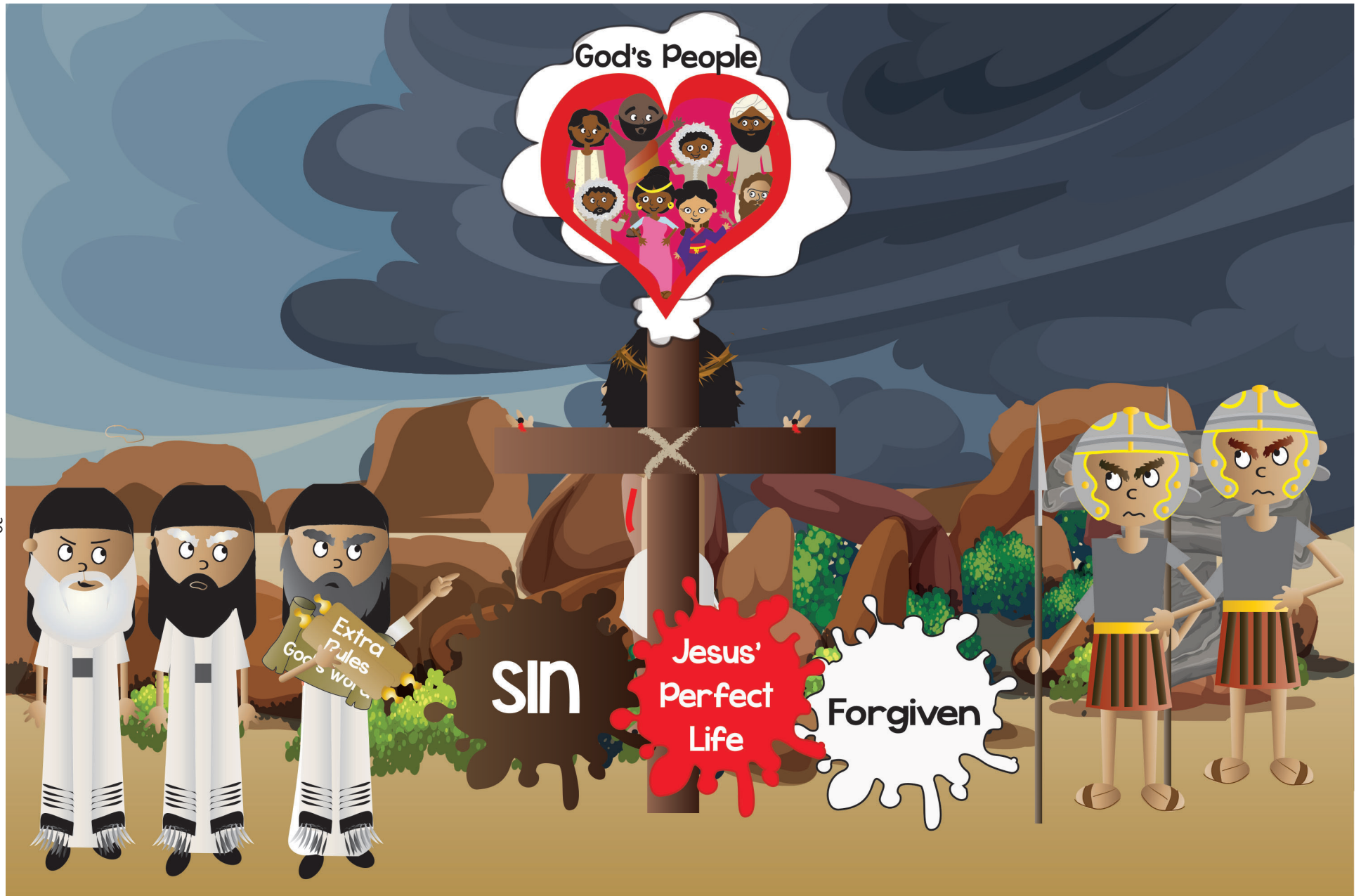
2. But Jesus, God's Son, chose to leave heaven. He loved the full closeness of God He enjoyed there. But because of God's great love for sinners, Jesus left His home. Only He could bring us to God.



3. Jesus was born a baby. He was still fully God, but now He was fully human, too --like us. But, **UNLIKE** us, Jesus had no sin in His heart. Jesus' first bed was just a dirty, animal food holder. How much God loved us to send His Son **HERE** to be our Savior!



4. When Jesus grew up, He taught people about God. and did amazing things by God's power. People began to think: "Jesus is God's Son! He has come to bring us to God!"



5. One day, Jesus' enemies put Jesus on a cross to suffer and die. But this was God's plan. Jesus was paying the sins of God's people, so they wouldn't have to. This was the only way.



6. Jesus' friends buried His body. Jesus' friends were so sad. They thought Jesus was dead and gone. forever.



7. Jesus stayed dead on Day One and Two, but not on Day Three! The earth rumbled as an angel came down from heaven. "Don't be afraid. Jesus is risen from the dead, as He said He would. Go tell the others," he told Jesus' friends.



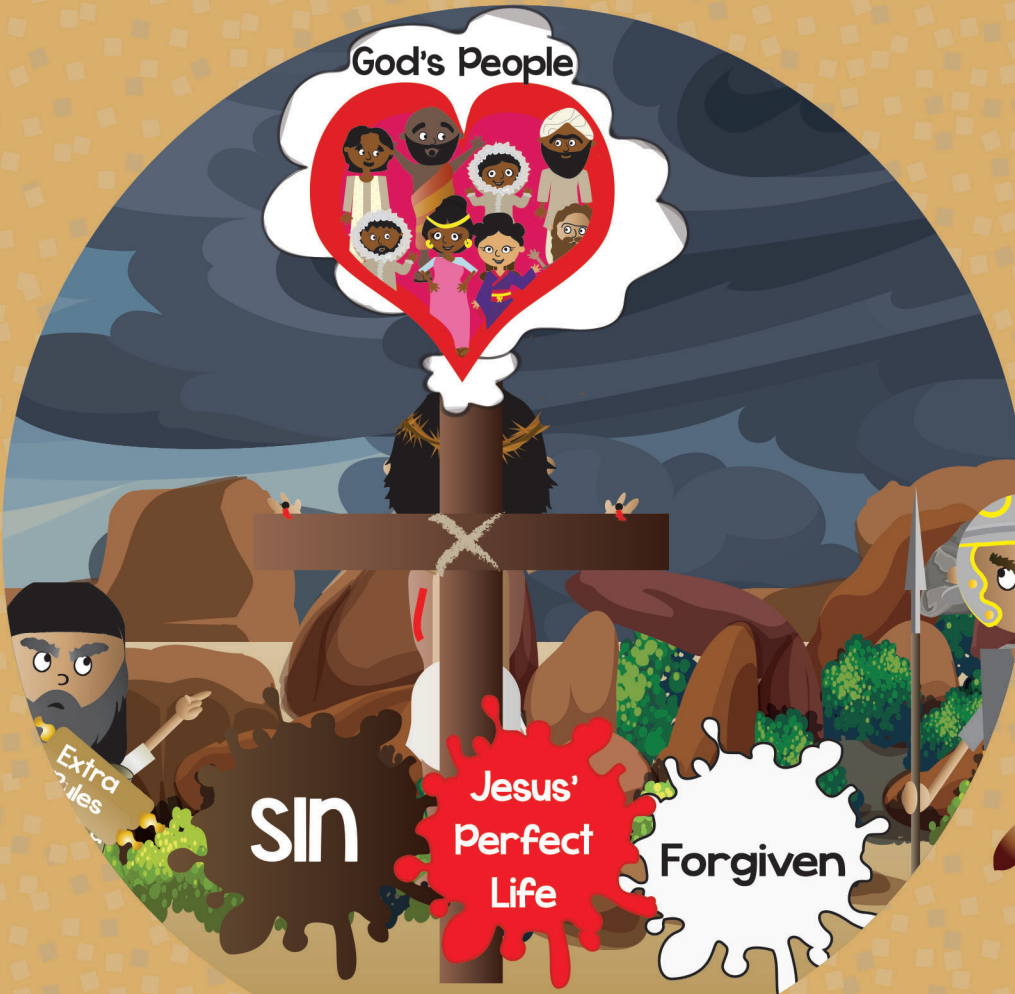
8. Jesus' friends told the others: Jesus had beaten sin and death! God had completely forgiven His people for disobeying Him. Jesus had made the way for them to come to God!

2. Who did Jesus bring us to?
To God. We can know God and live as His people because of Jesus!

For You and Me:
Only Jesus lived a perfect life that pleased God. He was perfectly good (righteous). But Jesus didn't just come to live a perfect life. He came to give up that perfect life as the full payment for the sins of God's people. Yes! Jesus gave up His life, so that we could be forgiven for all the bad things we do and could be God's people. You and I can become God's people, when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. Ask Him to help you. He loves to answer this prayer!

Our Bible Truth is:
What Did Jesus Come to Do?

The Gospel

The gospel is the good news that Jesus came to bring us to God. And oh, how we need this good news! You see, we all are unrighteous. That is, we have chosen to rebel against God, our good king. And for this, we deserve God's punishment.

But God chose to send Jesus to live a perfect life and offer it up on the cross, as the full payment for the punishment we deserve. He died that we might know God and live with Him forever.

Jesus suffered and died on the cross. He was buried in a grave, but that wasn't the end of the story. He rose up in victory on Day Three. He had beat sin and death for God's people.

How can we become one of God's people, those who Jesus brings to God? By turning away from our sins and trusting in Jesus as our Savior. And what a wonderful beginning that will be, if we do.
