The Lord is amazing! He's not like anyone else!

































The Lord created everything--the mountains, the wind, and even us. He's the one who declares to us what His thoughts are. That means He shows us what He's like!

God also shows us what He's like as we look at everything in this huge, wonderful universe He's made.


The Bible, God's perfect Word, tells us a lot more about God. It's full of His mighty deeds and His amazing promises to His people.

But most of all, God shows us what He's like as we learn about His Son, Jesus, and come to know Him in our heart, ourselves.




Dear PFI,

Everything else in the world may come and go, but God's Word, the Bible, will last forever, fulfilling all of God's good plans.

















We're all sinners who've rebelled against God and His good ways. We all deserve death--God's just, eternal punishment for our sins. That's the very bad news!


But the very good news is the gospel. God loved us and sent His only Son to save us!

Then on the third day, Jesus rose up from the dead in victory. He had fully paid for the sins of God's people so they wouldn't have to!



So we've just described some of who the Lord is,



Tess, tell us more about what God made! Kids, who were all things made through? Why did God create everything?


Track 7: Big Question 5: Can You Tell Me What God Made?
















God's love for His people is steadfast. It goes on and on without changing.


God knew and loved His people before the world began. He planned for them to be from every people on earth. He would be known and praised everywhere!

Best of all, God planned to bring His people home to live with Him forever. Not a one of them would be lost!


God's love for His people began before He made the world; and, it will never end! It's truly more than they could ever deserve!








God's Love for His People Like?











Jesus is the Christ: the special, Chosen One sent from God to save God's people.


Jesus was the holy Son of God, yet He chose to leave His home in heaven and come to earth as a man. How amazing!

Yes, Jesus suffered and died for unrighteous sinners so they could become God's holy people. Then, on the third day, He rose from the dead and went to reign in heaven.


Jesus had really done it! He had made the way for us to come to God.








The Holy Spirit Do in God's People?

Death isn't just about our bodies dying. It's also about us being punished for our


sins and separated from God forever. There's nothing worse than that!

Forgiveness of sins! Eternal life! Salvation! These are the free gifts that God offers you and me!








Only in heaven will God's people love perfectly like Jesus; but, God's Holy Spirit lives and works inside of them here, each day, helping them love God and others more.







How Should God's People Live?


Nothing will stop God from making sure that His people persevere. They will keep on believing in Him to the very end!









We can always pray to God. He's always at hand. That's why God's people know they don't need to be anxious about anything. God is right nearby. He hears their prayers and promises to answer them.


Sometimes God answers with a "yes;" and sometimes, with a "no."

That's why God's people can thank God for His answers, even before He's given them. They know He'll be just as faithful to answer these requests as He's been the past.


God wants us to pray to Him anytime, anywhere... about anything. There's nothing too big or too small for us to talk with Him about!






God's people look forward to the great Day when Jesus will come back. On that day, the whole church--all of God's people--will at last praise God together before His throne.


