

"Deep Down Detectives! This is your first of three missions in this Big Question. Look for your clue in my glasses. See if you can find the answer in God's Word. See you soon, Detective Dan!"



The Deep Down Detectives found the clue and read: "What Are God's Laws Like? God's Laws Are Perfect... They Are Written in the ????, God's Word." Deuteronomy 5:1. Hint: The name of God's Word. It starts with a "B."



The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to Deuteronomy 5:1, and read: "Hear the rules I speak... learn them and be careful to do them."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out the first way God's Laws Are Perfect?" he asked. "We think so! 'God speaks to us in His perfect Word, the Bible. That's where His laws are written down for us to learn and obey."



"Our Big Question is: What Are God's Laws Like? And the answer is: God's Laws Are Perfect... They Are Written in the Bible, God's Word!" "Great job, kids! You did it!"



Laws are big rules. God's laws are big rules that God wants everyone to obey. They are the most important laws of all. Long ago, God had godly people write down His laws in the Bible. God's Holy Spirit helped these people write down His laws just right. God's people learn God's laws and ask God to help them obey them. They love God and want to please Him. They want to show the world what God is like by living the way He wants us to live.

Something to Grow Into



I. "Praise the LORD," the Israelites shouted. They had so much to celebrate! God had freed them from their enemies, the Egyptians. He was taking them to a new home --a very special place called the Promised Land. Moses would lead them there.



2. But before they went to the Promised Land, they had to make promises with the LORD at Mt. Sinai. As the people set up camp, Moses climbed up the mountain to meet with the LORD.



3. "In 3 days, I'll meet with the people," the LORD told Moses. "But because I'm holy, and the people aren't, I can only meet with them if they do everything just right. Have them take baths and wash their clothes. Fence off Mt. Sinai. Prepare their hearts to meet with Me." Everyone obeyed.



4. On Day Three, the people awoke to rumbling thunder and loud trumpet blasts. Mt. Sinai was covered in clouds and flashed with lightning. Fire and smoke came down on the mountain, and the ground shook. Everyone was so afraid. The LORD was coming to meet with them!




5. Then, the LORD spoke to them in a big voice: "I am the LORD. I rescued you from your enemies. Let's make special promises together. I will be your God. You will be My special people. I will love you and take care of you, and you must keep My laws. Here are My Ten Commandments:



I. Love Me most of all.



3. Love Me by how you talk about Me and how you live.



2. Don't worship fake gods. Worship only Me.



4. Keep a special day to rest and to worship Me.

6. "Love Me most of all. Don't make gods out of anything you see, in the sky or on the earth around you. Worship Me alone. I am the LORD. Honor My name. Don't misuse it. Keep one day a week (the Sabbath day) a day of worship and rest," the LORD told them.



5. Love and obey your mother and father.



6. Don't murder people.



7. Keep your promise to love only your husband/wife.



8. Don't take other people's things.



9. Don't lie.



10. Don't be greedy for what others have.


7. "Honor your father and mother. Listen to them and obey them. Don't murder anyone. Don't treat someone else's husband or wife as if they are yours. Don't steal and don't lie. Don't covet -- don't keep longing for something someone else has. Be happy with what I give you."



8. The people trembled with fear when they heard the LORD's voice. "Moses, speak to us, yourself. We'll do whatever the LORD wants us to do. We want to be His people. But don't have Him speak to us anymore. His holiness scares us. We're afraid we'll die," they exclaimed.



9. "The LORD hasn't come to hurt you," Moses told them. "He's come in this mighty way to show you what He's like and to warn you not to break your promises to Him," Moses said. "But I'll go and meet with Him for you." So, Moses went up the mountain to meet with the LORD.



10. On Mt. Sinai, Moses watched as the LORD, Himself, wrote His Big Ten Laws into stone. Then, the LORD gave Moses more laws, saying, "Write all of My good laws down in the Bible. Teach the people to obey them. This is how they will stay My people, and I will stay their God."



II. Sadly, the people had sinful hearts and soon broke God's laws. They didn't deserve to be God's people. But the LORD is merciful! He would send a Savior. Jesus would do for God's people what they couldn't do for themselves: obey all of God's laws and make them God's forever.



12. So, Jesus came and kept God's laws perfectly. Then, on the cross, He gave His life as the full payment for God's people's sins. On Day Three, Jesus rose from the dead in victory! We can become God's people, too, when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior.

Detective Dan's Listening Assignment #1

I. What were the "Big Ten"? What made them so big? The "Big Ten" were the Ten Commandments that the LORD gave the people of Israel at Mt. Sinai that day. 
