2. Naomi was right to be sad, but she did NOT have to be scared. Naomi was one of God's people. She knew God's promises to always take care of His people. She could trust Him to take care of her. But Naomi chose to forget all of that. She decided God didn't care for her anymore.



3. Naomi was wrong to stop trusting God, but God is so kind to His people. He treats them better than they deserve. He would treat Naomi better than she deserved, too. He would most certainly keep taking care of her. Let's find out how.



4. It came time for Naomi, Orpah, and Ruth to say goodbye. They kissed each other and cried. Orpah and Ruth would go home to live with their parents. Naomi would make the long walk back home to Bethlehem by herself.



5. "Wait," said Orpah and Ruth. "We'll go to Bethlehem and take care of you." But Naomi said no. "There will be no one to take care of me or you in Bethlehem. Not even God," she said. Oh, Naomi! God promises to always take care of His people. Keep trusting in Him! He will take care of you.
