The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to Isaiah 46:9,11, and read: "I am God, and there is no other... I have purposed, and I will do it."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out the second way God's Word, the Bible, is so special?" he asked. "We think so! The LORD is the one, true God. Everything He planned to happen, will happen. He has written many of his plans in the Bible, so we can know them."

A plan is thinking about WHAT you want to do before you do it. We all make plans, but they only sometimes work out. God makes plans, too, but His plans ALWAYS work out. They are all good and perfect. We read of His plan to save His people through His Son, Jesus; His plans to use everything for their good and His glory; His plan to take them to live with Him forever. # Something to Grow Into



I. Everyone in Jerusalem was excited. Magi, important men from faraway, had come, saying, "Where is your new king? We saw a bright, new star in the sky. It tells us that he's been born and is very great. We want to worship him."



2. King Herod heard about the Magi, and he was worried. "What if this baby is the Christ, the great King God promised to send? HE would be king instead of me. I must find him and get rid of him!"



3. Herod called in the Bible teachers, and demanded, "Where is the Christ, God's great Savior-King, supposed to be born?" "In Bethlehem," they replied. "That's what God promised in His Word many years ago," the teachers told Herod.

4. Herod called for the Magi, and said, "Go to Bethlehem and search carefully for the young child. When you find him, come back and report to me. I want to go worship him, too," he lied. Herod didn't plan to worship the baby king at all. He planned to get rid of him!



5. The Magi obeyed Herod. The star went before the Magi and led them to a little house in Bethlehem. The door opened, and who did they see?



6. Mary, Joseph, and little Jesus! God's Word had been true. It could be trusted. Here was the great King they had been looking for. The Magi worshipped Jesus, giving him their expensive gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.



7. God warned the Magi, and they never went back to King Herod. God sent an angel in a dream to warn Joseph, too. Herod's plans failed. God's plans came true. They always will. God always wins!



8. Baby Jesus grew up into a man. He showed everyone what God is like. He taught about God and did amazing things by God's power. Jesus lived a perfect life; and then, He did the most amazing thing of all...



9. He died on the cross, giving His life as the perfect payment for the sins of God's people. On Day Three, Jesus rose from the dead, and went to rule in heaven, just as God's Word promised. Yes, God's plans came true. They always do! God always wins!

I. Who was the new king and who was looking for him? Jesus was the new king. The Magi (and King Herod) were looking for him.

2. How did they find him? The Bible, God's Word, told them where He would be born.

For You and Me: The Magi found God's Word to be true. It told them of God's plans to send a Savior; and, it told them where He would be found. But the most wonderful of all God's plans, written down in the Bible, was what God had planned for the Savior to do. This Savior --Jesus-- would choose to suffer and die on the cross to save all who turn from their sins and trust in Him as their Savior. That's a plan that God wants you and me to be a part of, too. Ask Him to help you become one of God's people. He loves to answer this prayer! I. Where did God plan for the new king to be born? Bethlehem.

2. What did God plan for the new king to do? He planned for the new king to save God's people from their sins.

#### For You and Me:

From before the beginning of time, God planned to send Jesus to save His people from their sins. Nothing would ever get in the way of that plan!

God's wonderful plan can be for us, too. How? When we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. This is how we can become God's people, too. Ask Him to help you do this. He loves to answer this prayer!
