#### Something to Grow Into



I. Long ago, before the beginning, everything was a BIG NOTHING! Nothing, that is, except the LORD. He's always lived, and always been perfectly happy in Himself, as God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Always, Perfect Wonderfulness!



2. The LORD didn't NEED anything else, but He CHOSE to make this world as an amazing display of Himself. Would He make it using paint or scissors like we do when we're making something? No! He would use NOTHING but His powerful words. Here's what He did...



3. On Day One, God's Spirit hovered over the waters of the shapeless, empty, dark world. "Come, light!" God said, and a beautiful light began to shine. The light, He called "Day." The darkness, He called "Night." And it was good.



4. On Day Two, the LORD separated the earth's watery emptiness into two parts -Sky and Seas. The sky would be where rain and clouds would come from. The seas covered the earth. And it was good.

5. On Day Three, the LORD said, "Waters on the earth, gather together! Dry land, appear!" God looked at the wild, splashing waves, and the rich, dark ground, and it was good.



6. Now the LORD began to fill the spaces He made. "Trees and plants, sprout up on the earth!" Up popped leafy plants and trees. God looked at the beautiful, green world, and it was good.

But bad things DID come into God's good world. People have not kept on loving or obeying God, have they? Why, even you and me, we disobey God. We do bad things. And now, we all deserve God's punishment. This is such sad news.

But there's good news, too. God loved us so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, to suffer and die on the cross, taking all the punishment for the sins of God's people. On Day Three, Jesus rose from the dead, proving He had really beaten sin and death for them. Now, God will forgive all who turn away from their sins, and trust in Jesus as their Savior. That's how we can become God's people.
