Something to Grow Into



I. What a lot happened in the first six days of the world! God made everything in the heavens and the earth, and He filled it FULL of amazing, wonderful busy-ness! Seas, skies, and land were swarming with creatures, enjoying the world God had made.



2. But before sunset on Day Six, God still had someone else to make. People! God's beautiful world wouldn't be complete without them. After all, He planned it for them, that they might know and enjoy it, and Him, the God who made it all!



3. God used clay from the ground to create the first man. He called him Adam. Then, God breathed into Adam's nose the breath of life, and he became alive.



4. Adam's body that could do all sorts of wonderful things. But God put something even more amazing INSIDE Adam's body: a spirit! With this spirit, Adam could know and love God, and could SEE God's greatness and goodness in everything God made.

9. When Adam woke up, he was so pleased. Here was just the right helper and friend for him. She was like him, yet different, too. Together, they would enjoy God and share all the wonderful things God had created.
