The Case of the One-of-a-Kind Man**



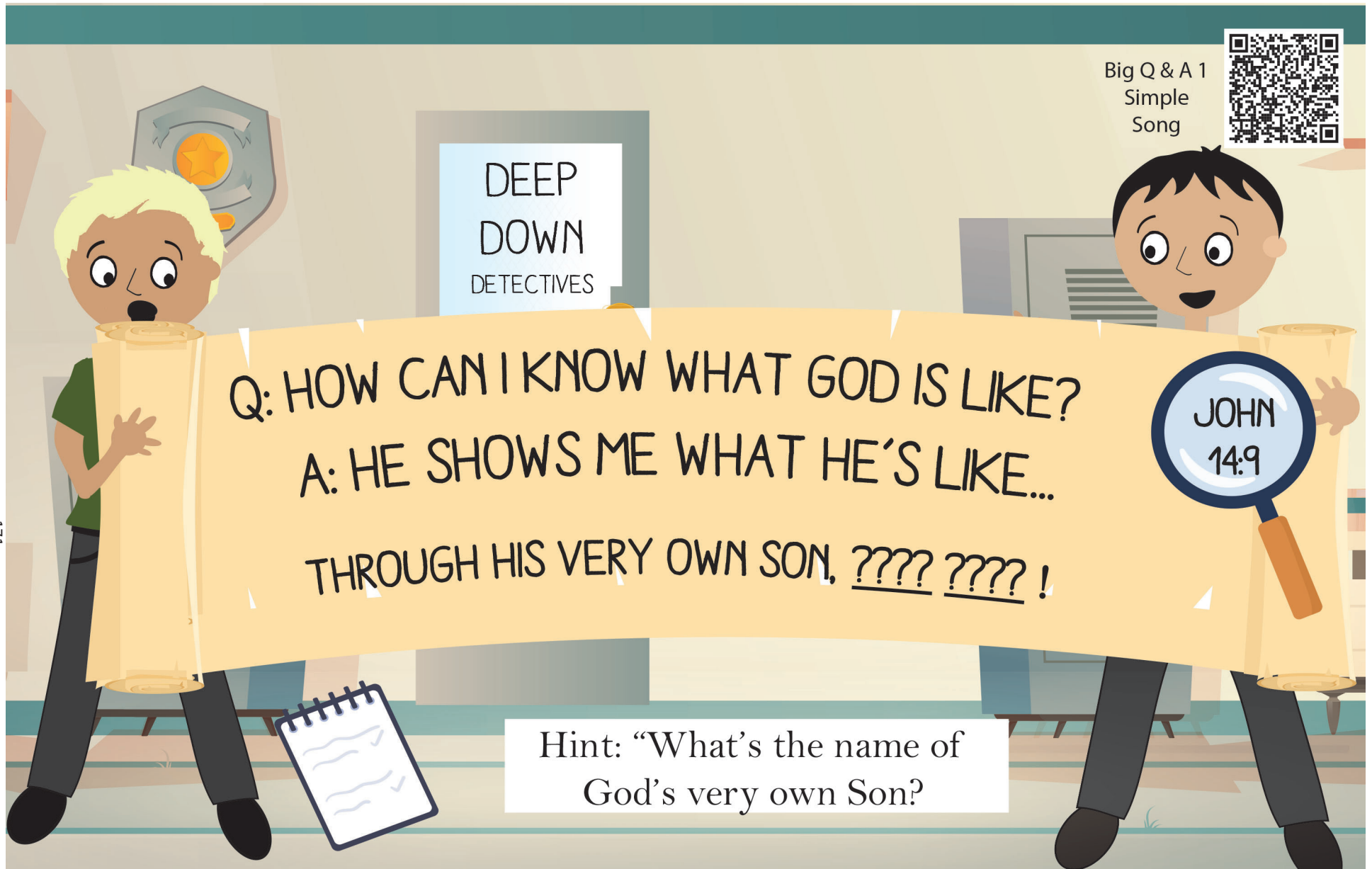

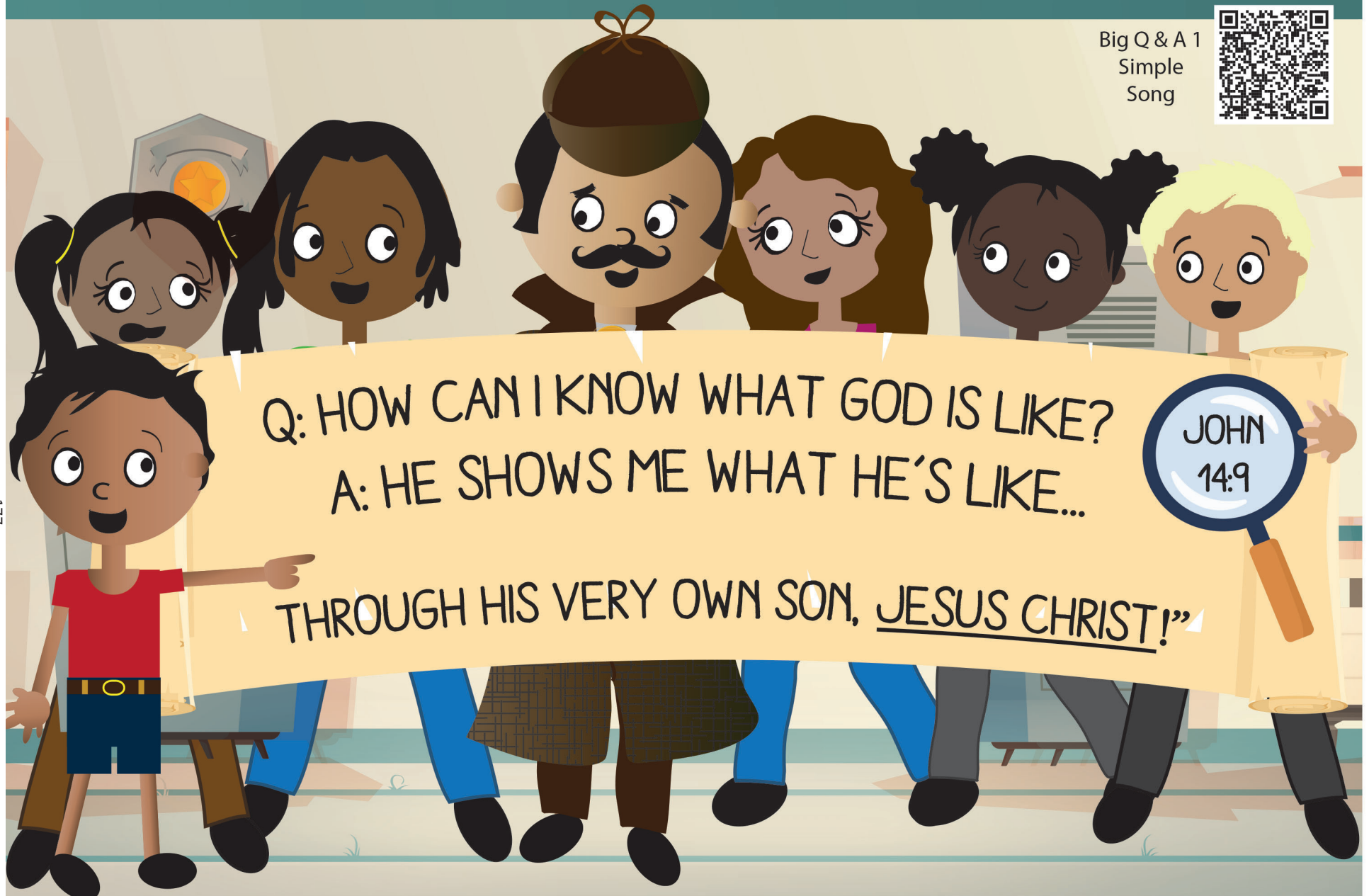


Whoever Has Seen Me
John 14:9

The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to John 14:9, and read: "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this way God shows us what He's like?" he asked. "We think so. This Bible verse is about Jesus. He is telling us that God shows us what He's like through Jesus, because Jesus is God's Son. He IS God!"



"Our Big Question is: How Can I Know What God Is Like? And the answer is: He Shows Me What He's Like... through His Very Own Son, JESUS CHRIST" "Great job, kids! You did it!"



"Jesus shows us what God is like. He never disobeyed God --He showed that God is perfectly good. He always told what was true and right - He showed that God is perfectly wise. He could heal people and calm big storms by just His word --He showed us that God is all-powerful. He suffered and died on the cross for the sins of God's people --He showed that God hates sin, but is full of love and mercy. Jesus shows us what God is like most of all because Jesus is God."

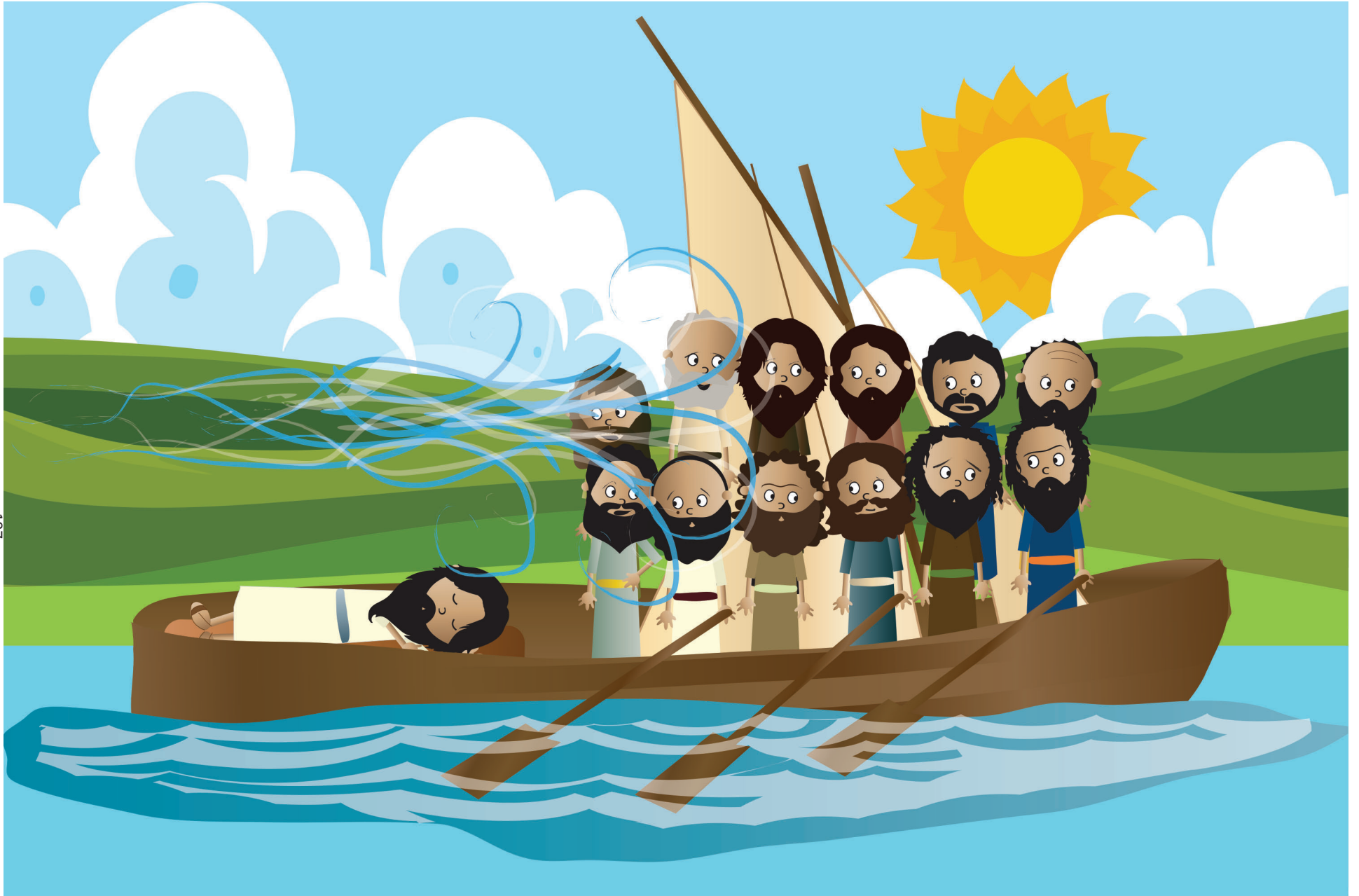
Something to Grow Into



1. Jesus' disciples and many others went to hear Jesus teach by the Sea of Galilee. Jesus sat in a boat out on the water, so everyone could see and hear Him. All day long, Jesus taught them.



2. They listened to Jesus because He was a One-of-a-Kind Man. He told them about God and did amazing things by God's power. He even forgave sins. Jesus was God's Son, perfect and powerful!



3. At the end of the day, Jesus and His disciples went sailing in the boat. The wind blew gently, and the water was calm. Jesus was very tired after all His work. He lay down and went to sleep.



4. Suddenly, a strong wind began to blow. "Whoosh!" It stirred up big waves. "Crash!" went the strong waves against the boat. Soon, water started splashing into the boat. Oh, no! Would it sink?



5. The scared disciples woke up Jesus, and shouted, "Do something, or we will drown!" Jesus stood up, and did something unbelievable. He simply spoke to the storm, saying, "Peace, be still."



6. And right then, the storm stopped. "Who is this that the wind and waves obey His word?" the disciples asked. But they knew: only God could do this. Jesus really was a One-of-a-Kind Man. He really was the Son of God.

The Gospel

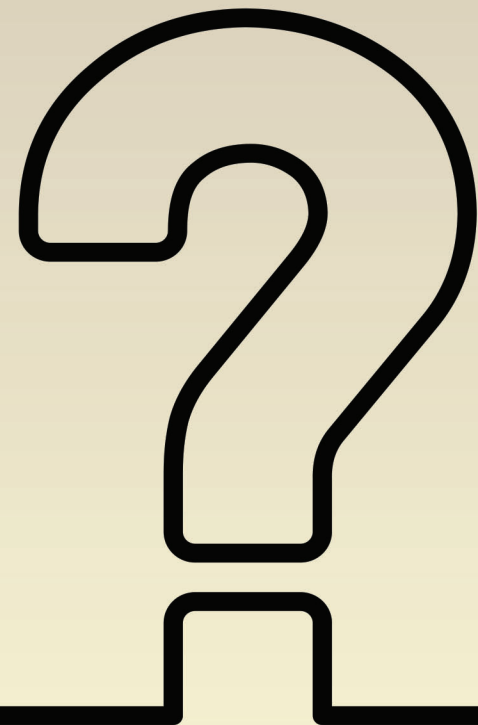

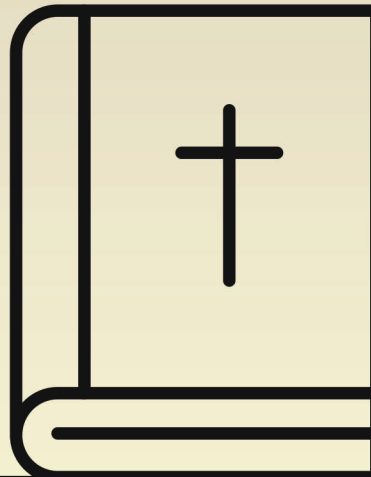

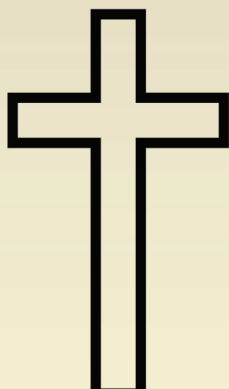
