








The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to Luke 24:5-6, and read: "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here; He has risen!"



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this fifth truth about what Jesus came to do?" he asked. "We think so! Jesus died on the cross and was buried in a grave. But on the third day, the grave was empty. Jesus wasn't there. He had risen from the dead."



"Our Big Question is: What Did Jesus Come to Do? And the answer is: Jesus Came to Bring Us to God... He Rose from the <u>DEAD</u>. "Great job, kids! You did it!"



"Jesus died on the cross for the sins of God's people. He took their punishment so they might become God's people forever. Jesus died that day, but death couldn't keep Him that way! On Day Three, God raised Jesus from the dead to live forevermore. He had beaten sin and death for God's people. Now, all who turn from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior can know God in their hearts by God's Holy Spirit. And when they die, they will go to live with God forever."

I. Soldiers led Jesus and two robbers outside of Jerusalem and put them on crosses. The robbers were there as punishment for bad things they had done. But Jesus was there to take God's punishment for the bad things God's people had done.




2. From noon to three, Jesus hung on that cross. The sun stopped shining, and the land went dark. "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" Jesus cried out, as the punishment for the sins of God's people bore down upon Him.




3. At last, Jesus said, "It is finished," and died. The ground shook and the curtain in the Temple that separated God from the people tore in two. "Surely, this was the Son of God," exclaimed one soldier, who watched it all.



4. Jesus' followers buried His body in a cave-grave and rolled the huge stone in place. Jesus' enemies sent soldiers to make sure no one took Jesus' body. "It is finished," Jesus' enemies happily thought. "Jesus is dead. His life is over. That fake is gone for good."



5. "It is finished," Jesus' friends sadly thought, too. "Jesus is dead. His life is over. The Messiah King is gone for good." It certainly looked like Jesus' enemies and friends were right. Jesus' life seemed finished.



6. But they were WRONG! Jesus didn't mean His LIFE was finished. He meant His JOB was finished. He had finished suffering and dying for the sins of God's people. He had beaten sin and death for them. Jesus was NOT gone, only the sins of God's people were.



7. On Sunday, Day Three, a mighty change happened in that grave. Jesus had beaten death, and death could no longer hold Him. God raised Him to life with a new resurrection body, especially made to live forever in heaven. Jesus was alive forevermore! It was time to tell the world!



8. The ground shook as an angel came down and rolled away the stone from the cave-grave. The soldiers were terrified. Jesus' friends were excited, but scared, too. "He's not here, He's risen! Look for yourselves," the angel told them. Yes, the grave was empty! Jesus was alive!



9. Jesus appeared to many of His followers on that wonderful Sunday. "It is I. I am alive. I've risen from the dead. Go and tell the others," Jesus said to the women who had come to his cave-grave early that morning. And the women rejoiced, then hurried to tell the good news.




10. Later that day, Jesus explained God's plan to two of His disciples as they walked to Emmaus. "God's Word promised I would suffer and die for God's people. Now, it is finished," Jesus told them.



II. And last of all, Jesus appeared to His closest followers on that wonderful Sunday, "Peace be with you!" He said, then showed them his hands and side. They were overjoyed. Jesus really was alive and had beaten sin and death for God's people.


Some women who were Jesus' friends went to the cave-grave to tend to His dead body. They didn't find His body. Instead, they found an angel and an empty cave-grave.


