


The Deep Down Detectives found the clue, and read: "Can Anybody Tell Me What the LORD Is Like? He's Not Like Anyone Else... He Is a Glorious ?????. John 4:24." Hint: "What does God's glory shine out from? It starts with an "s" and it rhymes with "hear it."



The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to John 4:24, and read: "God is spirit."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this first truth about what the LORD is like?" he asked. "We think so! God is spirit."



"Our Big Question is: Can Anybody Tell Me What the LORD Is Like? And the answer is: He's Not Like Anyone Else... He Is a Glorious <u>SPIRIT!</u>" "Great job, kids! You did it!"



"God is a spirit, great and glorious. We can't see God's Spirit with our eyes or touch His Spirit with our hands. God made each of us with a spirit, a bit like His great and glorious Spirit, so we might know and love Him in our hearts. One day, God's people will see Jesus in heaven. shining brightly with the beautiful glory of God's Spirit. How amazing that will be!"

Something to Grow Into



I. King David lived in a big, beautiful palace. But the Ark of the Covenant --the special, golden box where God met with His people-- was only in a tent. "I want to build a Temple, a fine, worship place for the LORD," David told Nathan, God's messenger.



2. "Not you, but your son, Solomon, will build the new worship place," the LORD told David. So, when Solomon became king, he chose Hiram, the best builder, to build the Temple.




3. Hiram used pure, white limestone on the outside of the Temple. It glistened in the sun. It reminded the people of the LORD's glory -- the beautiful, shiny, brightness that shines out from His Spirit.



4. Inside, Hiram covered the floors and walls with gold, angels, trees, and sparkly jewels. A beautiful curtain hid a special room called the Holy of Holies. That's where the Ark of the Covenant would be. God would meet with His people there.



5. When everything was done, the people gathered with the king outside the Temple. They came with thousands of worship gifts, ready to worship the LORD.



6. As King Solomon and the people gave their gifts to the LORD, the priests and Levites put the Ark and other worship things inside the Temple.



7. Everyone praised the LORD; then, King Solomon prayed: "LORD, You are too great to live in this Temple. The whole world isn't even big enough to hold You. But please, make this a special place where all people can come worship You and meet with You," he asked.



8. Suddenly, there was a bright flash of light and a big wave of heat, as the LORD sent down a great fire from heaven. "Whoosh!" It burnt up the huge pile of worship gifts. This was the LORD's mighty "yes!" to King Solomon's prayer.




9. Then, the LORD did something even more amazing. He showed the people some of the beautiful, shiny glory that shines out from His Spirit. It came down from heaven like a great, sparkly cloud over the Temple.



10. And inside, the Temple was filled so full of God's glory that none of the priests or Levites could even go in!



II. Then, everyone bowed down and worshipped the LORD. "Praise the LORD, for He is good! His love goes on forever," they exclaimed. And they all stayed there, worshipping and celebrating for a whole week.

He let them see the blazing brightness from the glory of His Spirit as it came down and filled the new Worship House.


2. What did the people do that showed they wanted to worship the LORD in spirit and truth?


