The Deep Down Detectives found the clue and read: "What Is the Gospel? It's Salvation through Faith in Jesus... God Saves All Who <u>????</u> of Their Sins and Trust in Jesus as Their Savior! Mark 1:15." Hint: "The Bible word for turning away from disobeying God. It rhymes with 'cement."



The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to Mark 1:15 and read: "Repent and believe in the gospel."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this fourth truth about the gospel?" he asked. "We think so! 'Repent' means turning away from disobeying God and living your life for Him. When we repent and believe in Jesus, God will save us and make us His people."



"Our Big Question is: What Is the Gospel? The answer is: It's Salvation through Faith in Jesus... He Saves All Who REPENT of Their Sins and Trust in Jesus as Their Savior." "Great job, kids! You did it!"



"Who can receive God's gift of forgiveness through Jesus? All who repent of their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior. Trusting in Jesus as your Savior means to depend on Jesus' perfect life given on the cross to pay for your sins to make you right with God. Repenting means to stop living a life full of disobeying God and to start living to please Him, instead. God can help us repent and believe. Ask Him to help you. He loves to answer this prayer!"



"Tell us a Bible story, Detective Dan. We want to dig deeper into God's Word." "Sure, kids! I know just the story. It's called 'The Case of the Changes in Cruddy Crete.' Listen for what happened in the people of Crete when Paul told them the good news of Jesus."

Something to Grow Into



I. This story takes place on the island of Crete. Do you know what an island is? It's a little piece of land stuck out in the middle of a big piece of water, such as a sea or an ocean.



2. Crete was very famous for something: its BAD, island people doing lots of bad things. There were liars and cheaters and lazy over-eaters, just to name a few. And that's why, most people thought of Crete as "Cruddy Crete." (Cruddy is a word that means something is no good.)



3. Most people didn't want to go to Crete, but Paul and Titus did. They wanted to share the good news about Jesus. He could even save these bad people from their sins.



4. So, Paul and Titus sailed over the sea to share the good news of Jesus with the bad people on Cruddy Crete.



5. This is what they shared: "God is the good King and Creator of the world. He made us and gave us His good laws to live by. But we have chosen to disobey Him and deserve His punishment!"



6. "But God sent His Son, Jesus, to be our Savior. Jesus lived a perfect life, then on the cross He suffered and died to pay for the sins of God's people," Paul told them. "On Day Three, Jesus rose from the dead. He had beaten sin and death for God's people."



7. "Now, all who turn from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior will be saved! They become God's special people. Come, repent! Believe in Jesus! Be saved!" Paul told the people of Crete.



8. God worked in the hearts of many as they listened to Paul preach. They could see they were sinners who needed a Savior. They wanted God's forgiveness through Jesus. They BELIEVED!



9. But would they REPENT? Would they turn from their WAY of life and choose to live for God, instead? Yes! God's Holy Spirit helped the believers do that, too. How happy Paul and Titus were!



10. Paul left Crete, but Titus stayed as their pastor. Titus loved them, prayed for them, and taught them the Bible, but it was hard for these new believers to keep on loving God and living for Him. They thought about going back to their bad, old ways.



II. Paul heard about their struggles and wrote them a letter: "Keep repenting and believing! Love God and one another. Hold onto God's Word, the Bible. God will help you keep on believing in and living for Him. Signed, Paul."



12. God is always faithful to His people. He helps them repent, believe, and live for Him their whole lives. He would help these believers, too.

What good news is it to hear that God sent Jesus to be our Savior, too. Jesus died on the cross as the perfect payment for sins. On the third day, He rose from the dead, proving He had really beaten sin and death for God's people!
