"Our Big Question is: How Can I Know What God Is Like? And the answer is: He Shows Me What He's Like!"

I. Simeon was a very old man. He knew and loved God in his heart. But, oh, how he wanted to know more about God and what He is like.



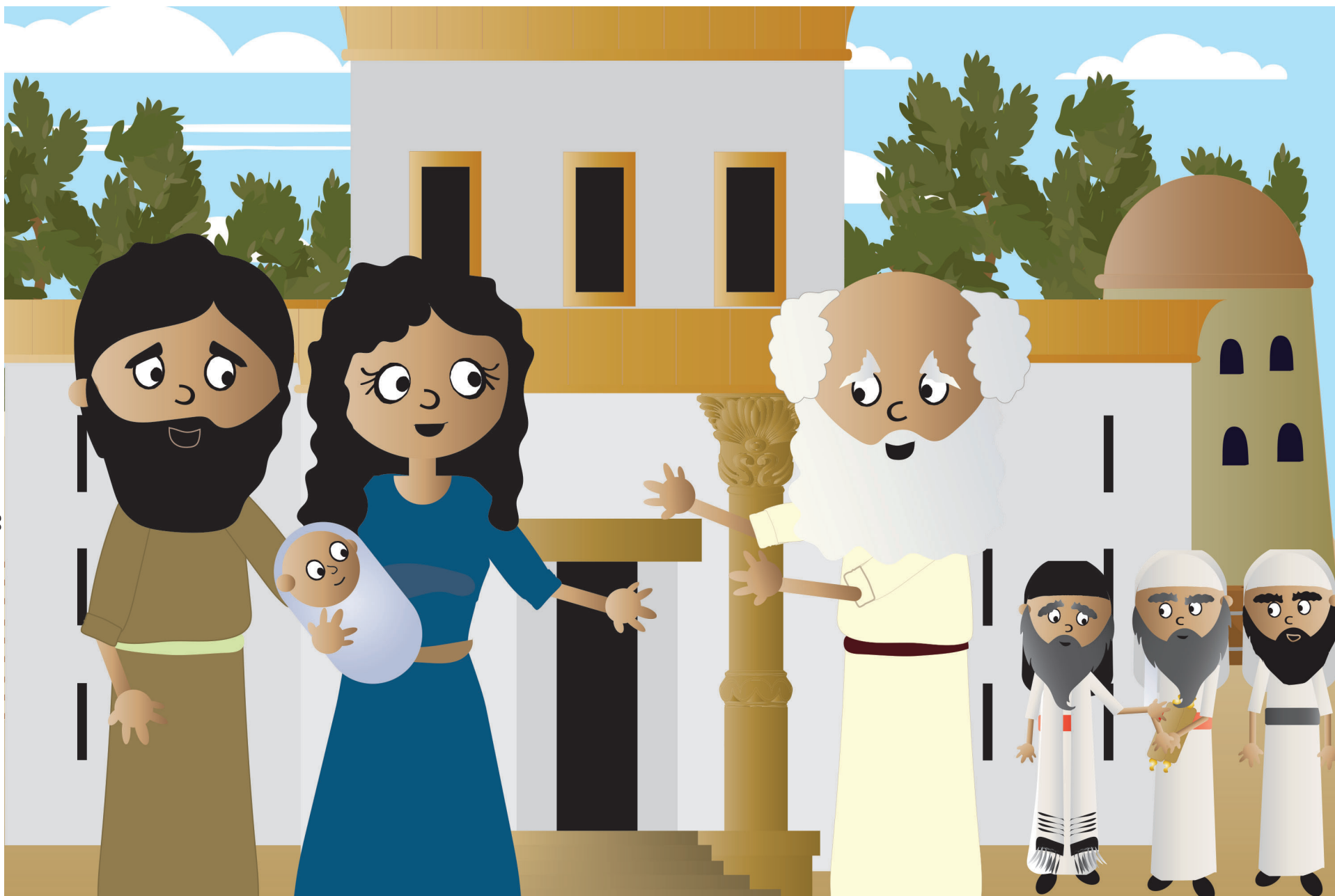
2. Simeon knew God created the whole world. He could learn more about God as he looked at all that God had made. But oh, how Simeon wanted to know more about God and what He is like!
