



I. There was big trouble in Thessalonica for followers of Jesus. The trouble began when Paul went there to share the good news of Jesus, and many trusted in Him as their Savior.



2. This made some people very angry. "Stop telling about Jesus. or you're going to be in big trouble!" they warned. This was scary, but the Holy Spirit helped Paul to keep telling about Jesus..



3. Paul's enemies didn't like this! They paid some bad men to lie about Paul. "Get people angry at Paul. Get them to shout: 'Get rid of Paul! He says we shoud disobey the king," they told bad men.



4. The bad men's lies worked. Soon, the whole city was angry. "Find Paul and get rid of him!" the crowd shouted. Oh, what big trouble those enemies had stirred up for Paul in Thessalonica!




5. "Bang, bang," the crowd beat on Jason's door. "Give us Paul! He needs to be punished," they demanded. But Paul and his friends, Timothy and Silas, weren't there.



6. Jason was a new believer and Paul's friend. The angry crowd took him instead. The city leaders made Jason and the others pay lots of money. What a lot of trouble they had that day!




7. That night, the believers told Paul, "Go to tell more people about Jesus. We will keep on sharing the good news of Jesus here. God will help us." So, Paul, Silas, and Timothy said goodbye and left.



8. They left Thessalonica, but Paul kept thinking about the new believers who lived there. "Would you go back to Thessalonica and check up on Jason and the others?" Paul asked Timothy.



9. Timothy went back, and what did he find? Enemies were still causing trouble for the believers, but God was helping them, by His Holy Spirit and His Word. Praise God for His sustaining grace!

I. Who cast their cares on the LORD? Paul and the new believers in Thessalonica.


2. How did the LORD sustain them through their troubles? The LORD helped them to keep on believing in Him and to keep on living for Him through all their troubles.

We praise You, LORD. You are always helping Your people!


God, we disobey You and deserve Your punishment, yet You offer us Your love through Jesus. Thank You!

God, You promise to sustain all who trust in You, but too many times we complain and whine when we have to go through something hard. We don't trust You to take care of us. Please forgive us!


T Thank You for promising to always take care of Your people. Thank You that they never have to worry. You love them so much.


