The kids knew what to do next! They opened up their Bible to Philippians 4:5,6, and read: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer... let your requests be known to God."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Do you have the answer to my Big Question?" he asked. "We think so! Sometimes, we are afraid, but God wants us to pray about everything, anytime, all the time, day or night!"



"Our Big Question is: How Does God Want Us to Pray? And the answer is: Every Night and Day... Always!" "Great job, kids! You did it!"



"Prayer is talking and listening to God. God's people have so much to talk to God about. They tell God how wonderful He is. They say sorry to Him for how they have disobeyed Him. They thank Him for all He's done for them and others. And, they ask Him to do great things and help them live for Him. God's people are so happy that God is always near to listen and to help them. We can be God's people, too, when we trust in Jesus as our Savior and live for Him."

Something to Grow Into



I. Daniel loved to pray to the LORD, especially in Jerusalem at the Temple in Jerusalem. He prayed things like: "LORD, You are the one, true God, I praise You! Help me to love You and live for You!"



2. But one, sad day, enemies came and broke down Jerusalem and its beautiful Temple. They took Daniel and many others to a land called Babylon. They made them work hard as slaves.




3. The people in Babylon worshipped fake gods. Would Daniel worship these fake gods, too? No, he would not! He would live for the LORD, and pray to Him, every night and day, even in Babylon.



4. The king called Daniel his BEST worker, and the other workers became jealous. They tricked the king into making a bad rule: everyone must worship the king as God, or be thrown to the lions!



5. The bad rule and the hungry lions wouldn't stop Daniel from worshipping the LORD. Daniel would keep on praying to the LORD, every night and day.



6. The bad helpers' plan worked. They threw Daniel into a big, dark pit, full of snarling lions. "Roar! Roar! Let's gobble up this man! Yum, yum, yummy in our tummies!"



7. But even there, in the middle of those lions, Daniel knew what to do. He prayed to the LORD. Daniel knew the LORD could help him.



8. The next morning, the king went to the lion pit. He looked down into the pit to check on Daniel. Was he alive? Had Daniel's God rescued him?



9. Sure enough, the LORD answered Daniel's prayers! He had sent an angel to shut the mouths of those snarly lions. Daniel wouldn't be their breakfast, lunch, or dinner!



10. The king was so happy! He got rid of the bad workers and made a new rule. "Everyone, worship the LORD! Who is God like Him? He rescued Daniel from the lions! He's the One, True God!"

Something to Grow Into





Daniel was a man who loved God and prayed to Him every night and day. God heard Daniel's prayers and answered him! God wants us to love Him and pray to Him, too. We can pray to God about everything, like Daniel did. But did you know, there is something God especially wants us to pray about? He wants us to ask Him to help us turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. That is how we can become God's people!

You see, all of us were created to love God and others, but none of us do. We all have sinful hearts and have chosen to live our own way, instead of God's good way. And for this, we deserve God's punishment.

Yet God is so merciful that He chose to send His Son, Jesus, to be our Savior. Jesus lived a perfect life and offered it up on the cross, as the full payment for the sins of God's people. Jesus died and was buried, but on the third day, He rose up from the dead. He had beaten sin and death for God's people. This proved it!

We can become God's people when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. We can know God in our hearts now. Then one day, we can go to live with God forever in heaven. That will be best of all!




