Stir Up Hebrews 10:24-25

The kids knew what to do next! They opened up their Bible to Hebrews 10:24-25, and read: "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Do you have the answer to my Big Question?" he asked. "We think so! It's not easy to live for God. God's people need to meet together to help each other worship God and love others, as God wants them to."



"Our Big Question is: Why Do God's People Go to Church? And the answer is: To Worship God and Love One Another!" "Great job, kids! You did it!"

"A church is God's people gathering together. God's people gather to worship God and love one another. They sing songs and pray to God. They learn from God's Word, the Bible. They care and pray for each other. The Bible tells us that God's people are to meet together often. Usually, this is on Sundays, the day that Jesus rose from the dead. Jesus promised that when God's people gather together, He will be there with them in a special way."



"Tell us a Bible story, Detective Dan, we want to dig deeper into God's Word."

"Sure, kids! I know just the story. It's called 'The Case of the People Who Loved a Lot.' Listen for who God's people want to come to church with them and why."


Something to Grow Into



I. Look at all the people walking! Where are they going? These are God's people, the people who love Jesus. They are gathering together as a church.



2. They gather together to worship the LORD. They sing and pray to Him: "Praise God! Praise God! Thank you for sending Jesus. Help us live like Him by loving You and loving others."




3. They listen to teaching from the Bible. They eat a special meal to remember Jesus died to save them. These are things God's people do when they gather together.



4. God's people also gather together to love one another. They care for each other and share what they have. They pray for one another, and help each other know God's Word and live it out.



5. And Who is working inside their hearts, helping them to worship God and love one another like this? God's Holy Spirit! He is changing God's people to love and live like Jesus did.



6. Some sleep late or work on Sundays, like any other day, but not God's people. They gather together to remember how Jesus rose from the dead on a Sunday, long ago.



7. Other people watch God's people, and say, "Look at God's people as they gather together. See how much they love God and love each other. We want to know about Jesus, too!" they exclaim.



8. "Come, gather together with us," God's people invite everyone. "Come, hear the good news of Jesus. You can become one of God's people, too!" they exclaim.

A: "They wanted everyone to come, so they could all hear about Jesus and be saved."

Detective Dan's Listening Assignment #1

I. Who were the people who loved a lot? Who was it that they loved this way?

You and me, we have disobeyed God, too. We deserve God's punishment, too! But we can praise God for Jesus, too. Do you know why? Because if we turn away from disobeying God and trust in Jesus as OUR Savior, He will forgive us and save us, too!




