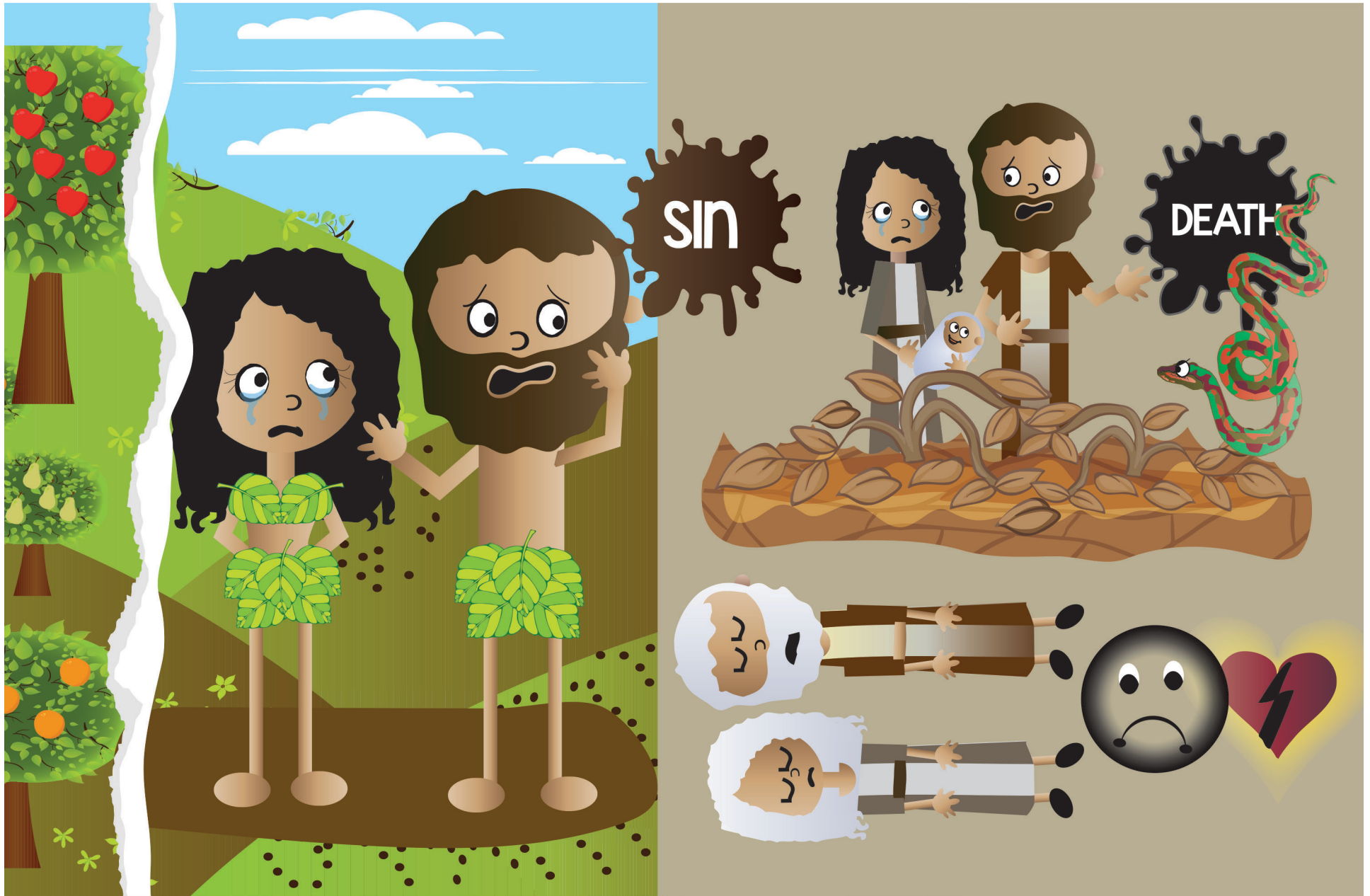

2. But then, Satan --God's enemy-- came. He wanted to spoil God's world, especially God's friendship with people. Satan came up with a tricky trick.



3. Satan used the serpent to trick Adam and Eve into disobeying God. Adam and Eve ate fruit from the one tree in the garden God told them NOT to eat. Oh, no!



4. Sin brought disobeying and hurting, crying and dying to everyone and everything else in God's good world. Worst of all, God's perfect friendship with people was broken.



5. But God gave Adam and Eve a wonderful promise that day: "I will send a Savior to beat Satan. He will save God's people from their sins and bring them back to friendship with Me forever!"



6. That Savior was God's Son, Jesus. He came to earth and lived a perfect life. He suffered and died on a cross to take all the punishment that God's people deserved for their sins, so they wouldn't have to. Then on Day Three, He rose from the dead in victory!



7. Jesus had really done it! He beat Satan. and sin, and even death. Because of Jesus, God's people can know and love God in their hearts now. But the best is yet to come...

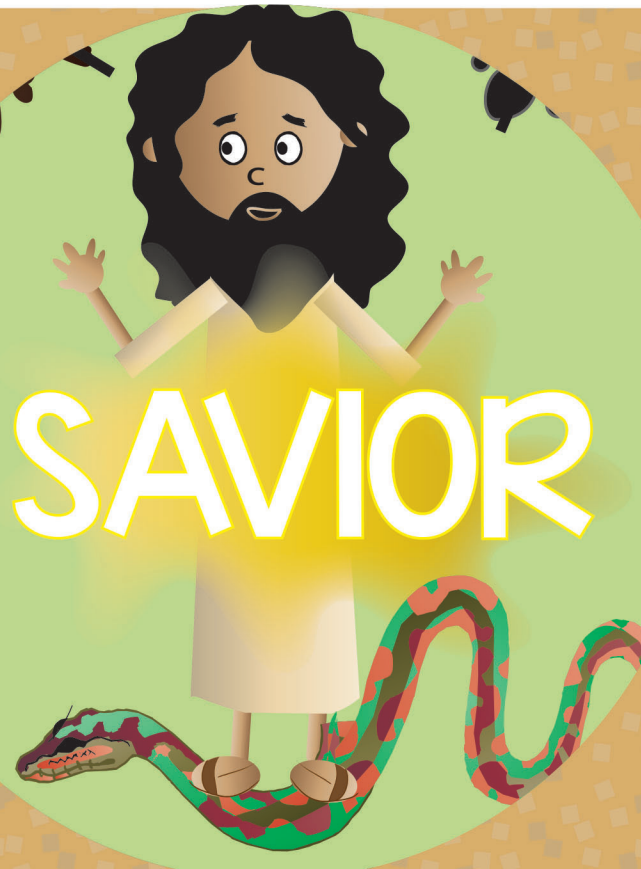

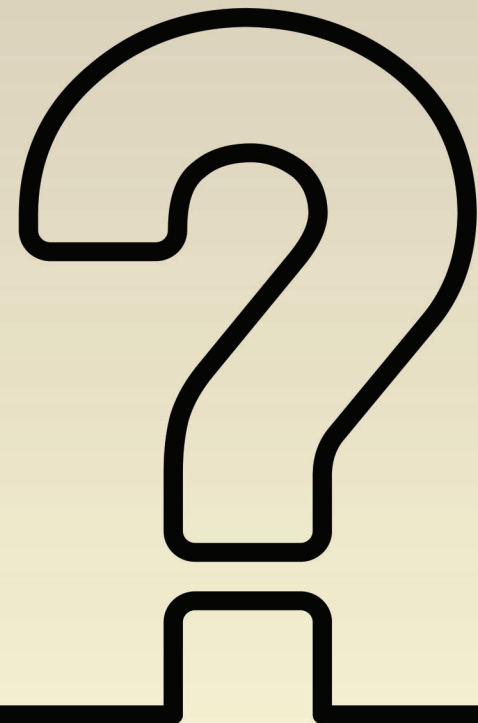

And so began the me-ee-me-ee-ess.

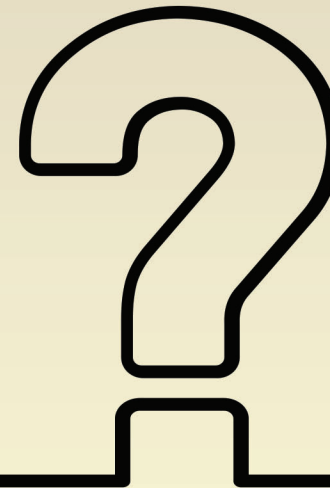

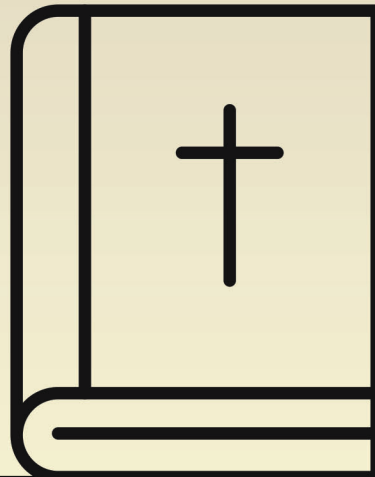


Here are two songs that help us dig even deeper into our Big Question.

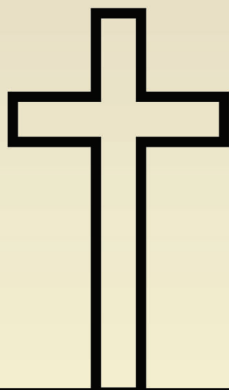
