The Temple of the Holy Spirit 1 Corinthians 6:19

The kids knew what to do next! They opened their Bible to I Corinthians 6:19, and read: "Your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit whom you have from God."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this first truth about what the Holy Spirit does in God's people?" he asked. "We think so! When we become God's people, God fills our hearts with His Holy Spirit. That makes our bodies like a temple: a special place of God's presence."



"Our Big Question is: What Does the Holy Spirit Do in God's People? And the answer is: He Changes Their Hearts to Be Like Jesus... The Holy Spirit <u>LIVES</u> in God's People" "Great job, kids! You did it!"

God made people to know Him, but our sin separates us from God. The Holy Spirit works in people's hearts, helping them turn from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior. This is how we become God's people. The Holy Spirit keeps on living and working in the hearts of God's people their whole lives. He helps them know God and live for Him more and more. This how they become more like Jesus.

Something to Grow Into




I. "I'm going home to heaven now, but I won't leave you alone," Jesus told His disciples, after He died on the cross and rose from the dead. "I will ask the Father and He will send you the gift of the Holy Spirit. It's good that I'm going away, so you can have this gift," Jesus told them.




2. "The Holy Spirit will live inside you," Jesus explained. "He'll give you power to be My witnesses to the whole world. He'll help you, comfort you, guide you, and give you courage," Jesus promised them. "Go to Jerusalem and wait for the gift," He told them.




3. Then, Jesus went through the clouds, and up to heaven to rule as king. The disciples headed to Jerusalem, spreading the news to the other believers. to wait for the gift, as Jesus told them to.



4. The believers gathered together in a house in Jerusalem. They prayed and waited; and, waited and prayed. One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine days passed, but still no Holy Spirit. Had God forgotten? No! He was waiting for Day Ten, as part of His perfect plan.



5. Why Day Ten? Because Day Ten was a special celebration day, called the Day of Pentecost. Every Pentecost, thousands of Jews from all over the world came to Jerusalem to thank God for the Ten Commandments. Now, God was going to use this celebration to tell the world about Jesus!



6. On Day Ten, the gift came. "Whoosh!" A mighty wind came from heaven, filling the house. "Crackle, Sparkle!" Something like fire rested on each of Jesus' followers. Then quietly and powerfully, the Holy Spirit came to live in their hearts, filling them with God's joy, peace, and power.



7. Jesus' followers were so happy! They burst out of the house and ran into the streets full of joy!



8. But that's not all the Holy Spirit did that day. He also helped those disciples speak in languages they had never learned. Suddenly, the Romans, Greeks, Arabs, Africans, and Asians in the Pentecost crowd could hear the wonders of God in their own language. How amazing!



9. "What's going on? How can these people speak in these languages? What gift is this?" many wondered. Others laughed and made fun of the disciples. The Holy Spirit helped Peter stand up and tell the crowd the great things God was doing.




10. "These people are speaking your languages by God's Holy Spirit," Peter explained. "God has sent Him to live inside of all who follow Jesus. Turn away from your sins, trust in Jesus as your Savior, and be baptized. God will send the Holy Spirit to live inside you, too," Peter promised them.



II. Over three thousand people turned away from their sins and trusted in Jesus as their Savior that day. God's Holy Spirit came to live in them, filling them with God's joy, peace, and power. They were so happy! Now, they could know God in their hearts, too.



12. Already, God's Holy Spirit had begun to do amazing things in God's people. God's plan to tell the world the good news of Jesus was happening. And this was only the beginning. How many more wonderful things would God's Holy Spirit do!



A: "Jesus' followers waited eagerly in Jerusalem for God to send to Holy Spirit to live inside them."



In the beginning, people rebelled against God. Sin came into their hearts. They deserved God's punishment and lost the special closeness they knew with God. Since then, we all have sinful hearts and all have chosen to rebel against God.

But even though we all deserve God's punishment, God is so merciful that He chose to send His Son, Jesus, to become a man and to be our Savior. Jesus lived a perfect life and offered it up on the cross as the full payment for the sins of God's people.

Jesus died and was buried, but on the third day, He rose up from the dead. He had beaten sin and death for God's people. Now, we can become God's people when we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. And Who will come to live in our hearts, if we do? You guesed it! God's Holy Spirit. He will live in us and help us our whole lives, to love God and live for Him. Then one day, we will go to live with God in heaven forever. That will be best of all!

We praise You, LORD. You are the One who changes hearts by Your Holy Spirit.




