








The Deep Down Detectives found the clue, and read: "Why Do God's People Keep Believing in Him? It Is God's Sustaining Grace... God ???? Sustains His People. Jude I:24, 25 Hint: "This word means God only sustains His people. It starts with an "A" and rhymes with "atone."



The kids knew what to do next. They opened their Bible to Jude I:24,25, and read: "Now to [God] who is able to keep you and to present you blameless be glory forever. Amen."



Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this first truth about why God's people keep believing in Him?" he asked. "We think so! God is the one who keeps God's people believing in Him. They can always count on Him."



"Our Big Question is: Why Do God's People Keep Believing in Him? And the answer is: It Is God's Sustaining Grace... God <u>ALONE</u> Sustains His People." "Great job, kids! You did it!"



"God alone is the sustainer of His people. He's why they keep believing in Him. Without His sustaining power, God's people would never be able to know Him or keep following Him. Something to Grow Into



I. Bad news, bad news! There was impossible, big, bad scary news in Canaan for Jacob's family! No rain fell from the sky. The rivers dried up. Their animals and crops were dying. If they didn't find food and water soon, they would die, too. They needed big help!



2. This was impossible, big, bad, SCARY news, but Jacob's family didn't need to fear. The LORD was their God. They were His people. He will always save and sustain them. He could make amazing, good news from impossible, big, bad, SCARY news, and that's just what He was about to do.




3. Good news! There was food in Egypt. And God had sent Joseph, one of Jacob's sons, to be in charge of giving it out. Jacob went to Egypt to live. Joseph and Pharoah welcomed them. Jacob praised the LORD for turning their impossible, bad news into amazing, good news.



4. Life was happy in Egypt, so Jacob's family decided to stay. Many years passed, and Jacob's family grew from just a little family to a whole people of thousands and thousands. Now, they were called the people of Israel. (Israel was a special name God gave Jacob).



5. A new Pharaoh became king in Egypt. He had big plans to make big buildings, and he would make the people of Israel build them. He made them his slaves and worked them cruelly. Oh, no! More impossible, big, bad, SCARY news! Would the LORD save and sustain His people through this?



6. Yes, He would! The LORD sent frogs and gnats, hail, sicknesses and other sadnesses upon the king and his people. "Go away! Leave us alone," Pharaoh ordered. "Praise the LORD!" Moses and the people shouted. They packed their things and marched out of Egypt.



7. Across the desert, Moses led the people. They camped by the Red Sea. How good it was to be free and going home! The LORD had taken their impossible, big, bad, SCARY news and made it into amazing, good news. He always sustains His people. He, alone!



8. Then suddenly in the night, there was the sound of thundering wheels, neighing horses, and shouting soldiers. It was Pharaoh's army! The king had changed his mind. He wanted his slaves back, and had sent his soldiers bring the people of Israel back to Egypt.



9. With the Red Sea on one side, and the soldiers on the other, the people of Israel were stuck. This was more impossible, big, bad, scary news. But Moses told the people, "Don't be afraid. The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still and watch."








