






A New Commandment John 13:34-35

The kids knew what to do next. They opened their Bible to John 13:34-35, and read: "Love one another: just as I have loved you... By this all people will know that you are my disciples."

Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this third truth about why God's people go to church?" he asked. "We think so! When God's people gather together, they love one another, like Jesus loved them. They care for each other's needs."



"Our Big Question is: Why Do God's People Go to Church? And the answer is: To Worship God and Love One Another... By Caring for Each Other's <u>NEEDS.</u>" "Great job, kids! You did it!"

"Jesus told God's people to love and take care of each other, just as He has loved and taken care of them. So, when God's people gather together, that's what they do. They help each other love God and live for Him. They pray for each other and remind each other of the truths in God's Word. They care for each other's needs. They share their money and care for the sick. We can become God's people, too, when we turn from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior."

Something to Grow Into



I. Jesus gathered his disciples for their last meal together. Soon, enemies would take Jesus away to die on the cross. With only a little time left, what did Jesus want His disciples to remember? How would He tell them? Jesus would use FEET and FOOD, there at the table, to teach them.



2. Jesus got up and began to wash His disciples' feet. They were horrified! Jesus was God's Son. He shouldn't use His holy, perfect life to clean their dirty, yucky feet! But Jesus just kept washing. This was a picture of what He would do on the cross to take away the sin from their hearts.




3. Then, Jesus took the Passover bread and wine and used them as two more pictures of what He was about to do on the cross. "This is My body, broken for you. This is My blood, poured out for you," He said, as He gave the bread and the wine to them.



4. "I'm going to make the way for God's people to come to God," Jesus told His disciples. "But I'm not leaving you alone. The Holy Spirit will come live in your hearts. He'll help you do what God wants you to do," He promised. And what DID God want them to do? To live and love like Jesus!



5. "Do what I've taught you. Love one another as I have loved You," Jesus told them. I have loved you so much that I'm going to die for your sins. There's no greater love than that. Now, I want you to love each other that much, too. This is how people will know you're God's people, My disciples."



6. Soon, everything happened as Jesus said it would, both the sad and the happy. Enemies came and took Jesus. The next day, He suffered and died on the cross for the sins of God's people. Friends buried Him in a cave-grave.



7. But on happy Day Three, Jesus rose from the dead in victory. He appeared to His disciples, then went to rule in heaven. Jesus was gone, but not His help. He sent the Holy Spirit to live in the hearts of His disciples. And with the Holy Spirit's help, they lived out what Jesus told them to do: LOVE!




8. "Love Me by obeying My commands. Love one another as I have loved you," Jesus had told His disciples. So, that's what they did. They loved by telling others the good news of Jesus, and thousands of people believed. The little church had grown to over 3000 people in just a few weeks!



9. And they loved by gathering together to worship God. They sang His praises and learned from His Word. They prayed together and remembered Jesus' love in the Lord's Supper. They helped each other to keep on loving God and living for Him.




10. And, they loved by caring for each other's needs. They shared everything they had with one another-food, clothes, houses, money... EVERYTHING! And if anyone needed anything, they would sell their things and buy whatever else was needed.




