

The kids knew what to do next. They opened their Bible to Acts 2:38, and read: "Repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ."




Just then, Detective Dan walked in. "Kids! Have you figured out this fifth truth about why God's people go to church?" he asked. "We think so! When God's people gather together, they baptize new believers who have turned from their sins and trust in Jesus as their Savior."



"Our Big Question is: Why Do God's People Go to Church? And the answer is: To Worship God and Love One Another... By Baptizing People Who Trust in and Live for <u>JESUS</u>" "Great job, kids! You did it!"

"Jesus told His disciples to baptize all who turn from their sins and trust in Him as their Savior. Baptism is a picture of the new life that begins when someone becomes a Christian. God has forgiven their sins and made them His people. He's filled their hearts with His Holy Spirit and made them new. They're leaving their old life behind and beginning a new life of living for Jesus. We can become one of God's people, too, when we turn from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior."



Something to Grow Into



I. "WAIT in Jerusalem until you receive the Holy Spirit," Jesus told His disciples. "Then, GO tell the world about Me. Teach them what I've taught you. Baptize these new believers. This tells everyone these are God's people and My disciples," Jesus said. Then, He went up to heaven to rule.



2. The disciples went to Jerusalem and waited ten days, when suddenly "Whoosh," there was a sound like a great wind in the room. Then, "Sparkle, sparkle," something that looked like flames of fire appeared over their heads. Then, Holy Spirit came quietly into the hearts of the believers.



3. Now, it was time to G0 and tell about Jesus. Peter shared the good news with a crowd in Jerusalem. "Turn from your sins. Trust in Jesus as your Savior!" he urged. "Be baptized as a sign that God has forgiven you and your new life in Him." Over 3000 people repented and believed that day.



4. What a happy, new beginning this was for these people. Their old life of sin was gone, and new life in Jesus begun. It was time to be baptized. One by one, Peter led each new believer into the water, saying "I baptize you in the name of God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit."



5. Then, Peter carefully lowered each believer down into the water, and back up again. Down into the water was a picture of their old life gone and their sins forgiven through Jesus. Up out of the water, was a picture of their new life with God begun and would go on forever.



6. Baptism was a big step for these believers. It didn't save them from their sins or make them God's people. But baptism showed everyone: "This person is a follower of Jesus. Watch them! They will show you what Jesus is like and how God wants us to live, loving Him and loving one another."



7. Baptism was a sign of another very happy gift from God, too: the gift of a new family. God had made these new believers a part of His family, the Church. Now, they were God's children, and all the other believers were their new, adopted brothers and sisters through Jesus.



8. Jerusalem was just the beginning of Jesus' "Go." There was the rest of the world to tell. So, Philip went to nearby Samaria. "Turn from your sins! Trust in Jesus as your Savior! Be baptized as a sign that God has forgiven you and you've begun a new life for Him," he urged the people.



9. Many turned from their sins, trusted in Jesus as their Savior, and were baptized. Philip gathered them together into a new, little church of believers. They worshipped God and cared for each other's needs. Oh, how the Church in Samaria was growing and enjoying new life in Jesus!




10. But Samaria wasn't the whole world. So, away went people like Paul, Barnabas, Timothy and Titus to places farther away. "Turn from your sins! Trust in Jesus as your Savior! Be baptized as a sign that God has forgiven you and you are living a new life for Him," they urged everyone.



II. Many turned from their sins, trusted in Jesus as their Savior, and were baptized. Paul, Barnabas, Timothy and Titus gathered these new believers into little churches. They worshipped God and cared for each other's needs. The Church in these faraway places was enjoying new life in Jesus!



12. Even today, God's people are still obeying Jesus' "Go". They'll keep on sharing the good news of Jesus, and keep on baptizing those who believe, until Jesus comes back. Then, God's people will be gathered together as one, big family, to live with God forever. That will be Perfect Wonderfulness!

I. Who repented of their sins? How did their lives look different?




if we turn away from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savion If we do, there will come a special day when we get to be baptized and share the story of how God worked in our lives

A Prayer


We praise You, God, for sending Jesus that we might be Your people.

In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.








Something to Grow Into A Prayer




