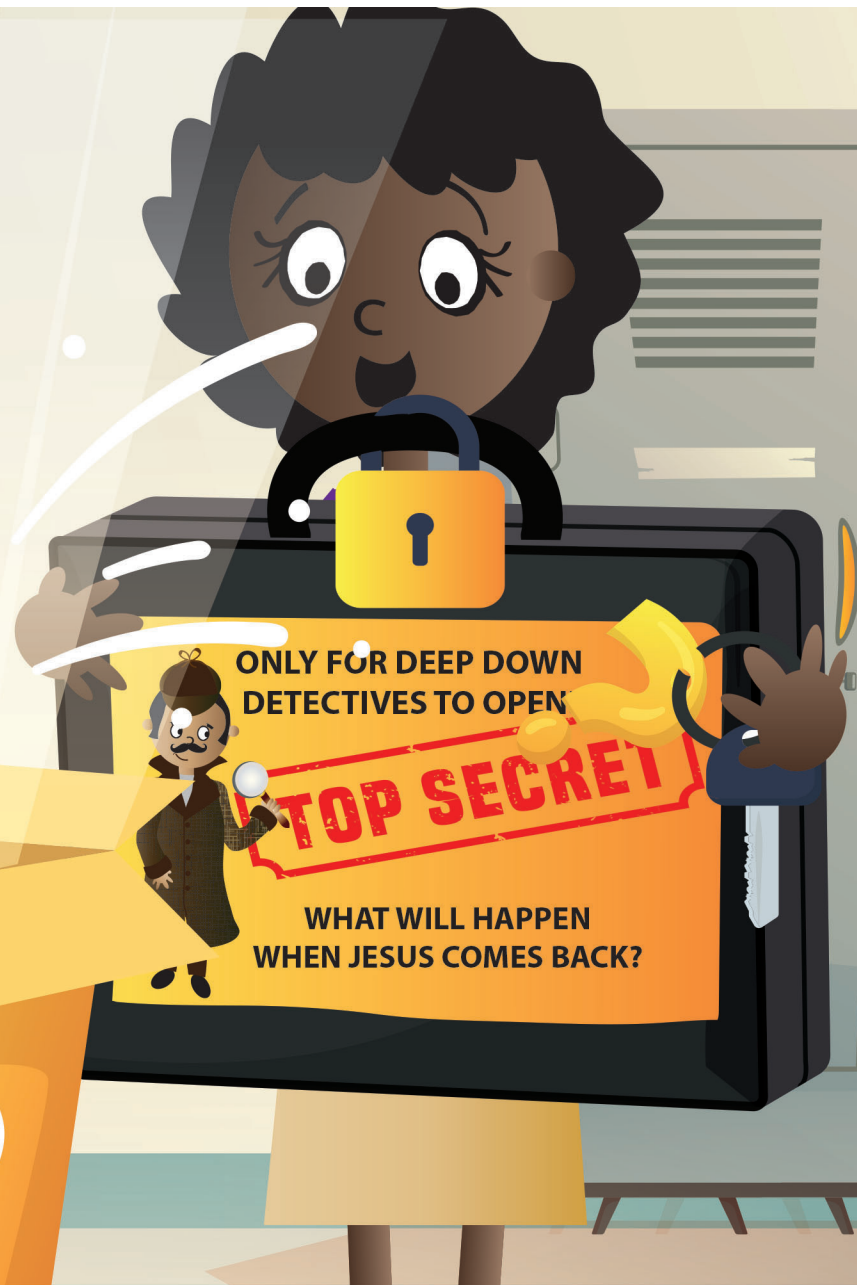

I. "When will the LORD give us what He promised?" the people of Israel wondered. The LORD had promised to bless all peoples through a son of Abraham. He would be from King David's family, too, and rule as God's Forever King. Life would be good with Him in charge! When would He come?



2. No wonder the people wanted this King to come! They were so unhappy, and it was their fault. They chose to worship fake gods and disobey God's good laws over and over. So, instead of blessing them, the LORD disciplined them. Their enemies took them away to be their slaves.





3. NOW the people wanted to turn back to the LORD, but was it too late? No, it wasn't. "Though your sins are so many, I will provide the way for you to be forgiven," the LORD told them through Isaiah and Daniel. "And when seventy years have passed, I will bring you back home," He promised.

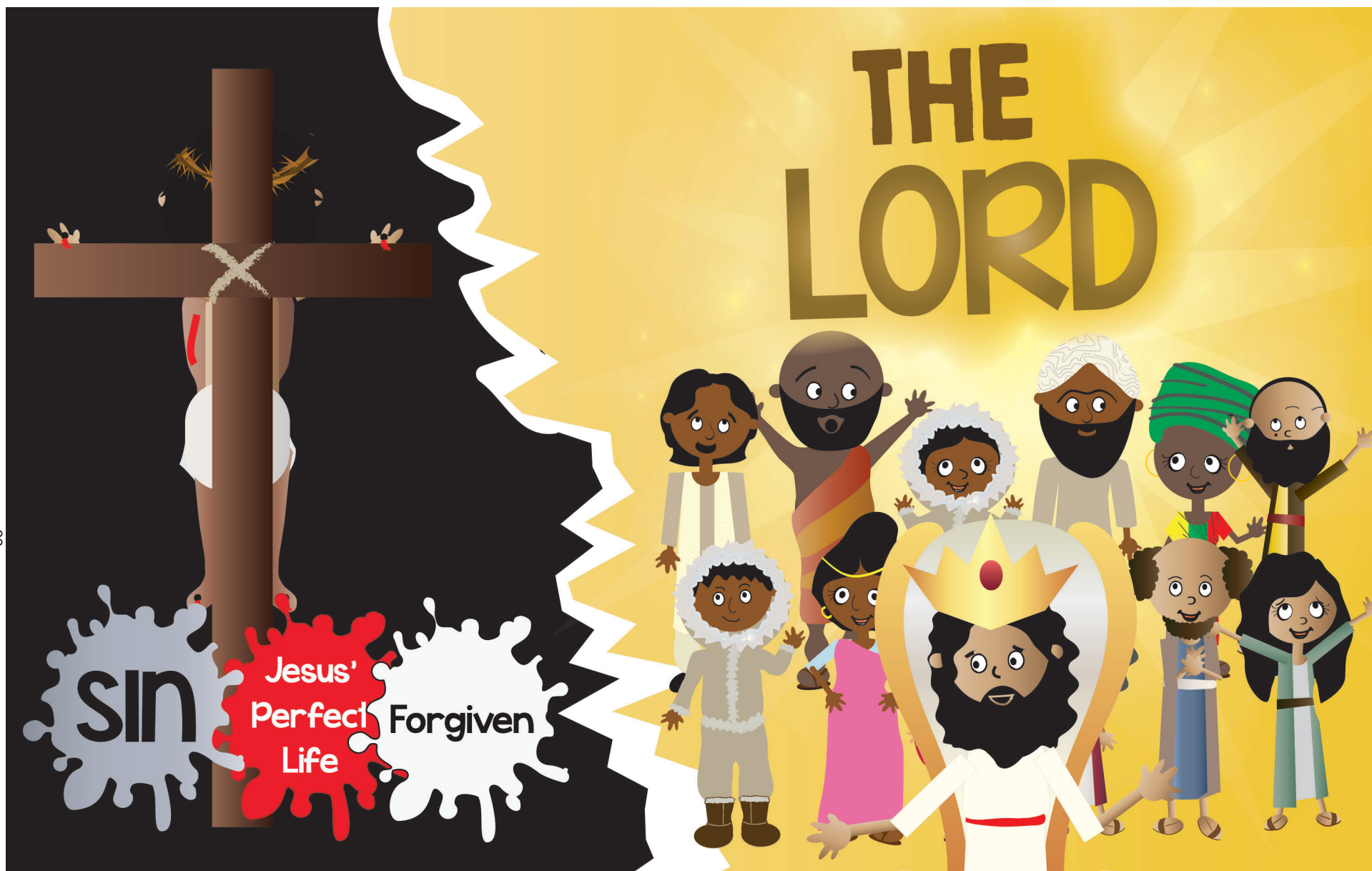




4. "The special Son you're waiting for will still come," the LORD promised. "He won't just be Abraham's and David's son. He will be MY Son, the Son of God. He will die for the sins of My people. Then, He will rise from the dead, in victory over sin and death," the LORD comforted them.



5. "At the end of time, My Son will return as the Forever King," the LORD promised. "He will judge all people fairly. Those who have NOT turned from their sins will be separated from Me forever. The time of forgiveness will be passed for them. It will be a very sad day for those people."



6. "But how wonderful it will be for God's people, all who turned away from their sins and trusted in Him as their Savior. They have been forgiven their sins, and they will live with Me forever," the LORD said through His prophets.





7. "NEVER will there be sadness or death. NEVER will anyone disobey Me anymore. They will delight to worship Me," the LORD told the people of Israel. "The Forever King will rule on and on, and God's people will live in the bright light of His glory forever," the LORD promised the people.





8. God kept all His promises. After seventy years, He brought the people back home to Jerusalem. And, then, at just the right time, God sent the special Son --Abraham's son, David's son, GOD'S Son, JESUS! Jesus came to bless all the peoples of the world, and to save God's people from their sins.



9. Jesus came as a baby, but grew up to be a man, a perfect man --the only person who never disobeyed God. On the cross, Jesus gave His perfect life as full payment for God's people sins. On Day Three, He rose from the dead in victory. He had beaten sin and death for God's people!



10. For forty days, Jesus spent time with His disciples, teaching them many things. Then, up to heaven Jesus went, and He is there now, ruling as the Forever King.





II. Promises, promises. One day, God will keep the last of His promises. On that wonderful day, Jesus will return to this world. Everyone will see Him as He comes through the clouds. Then, He will judge all people fairly; and this old, broken world will be finished.
